## Wings wallop Bats 10-1

**Ervin Santana** allowed one run over 5 2/3 innings in his first start of the season, helping the Rochester Red Wings to a 10-1 win over the Louisville Bats Saturday night at Frontier Field.

Twins pitcher Santana, with the Red Wings on a rehab assignment, was making his first start of the 2015 season as he nears the completion of his 80-game suspension. He allowed a one-out triple down the first base line to Irving Fatu, followed by a walk. Santana got a pop out from clean-up hitter Brennan Boesch, then struck out Ramon Cabrera to strand the runners.

Bats starter David Holmberg beat the Wings in Louisville May 9, but came into Saturday night's game with four no decisions and a loss in his previous five starts. Holmberg had allowed 22 hits and 11 runs in the first inning of his starts so far this season (12 starts), and the Wings contributed to the trend in Saturday's first inning. **Danny Santana** led off with a single, but was forced out at second base with **James Beresford** reaching on a fielder's choice. What followed? A single, an RBI sacrifice fly from **Danny Ortiz**, an RBI double by **Rey Rodriguez**, and an RBI single from **Jose Martinez**. The five hits in the inning added up to an early 3-0 lead for the Wings.

The Bats got a run back in the top of the second, on a two-out RBI double by Jose Constanza to make the score 3-1. Santana again ended the inning with a strikeout, his third of the game.

In the top of the fourth inning, Santana allowed a two-out single to right field off the bat of Hernan Iribarren, but the Wings got the force out at second on a ground ball to Danny Santana to leave the score 3-1 Wings.

**Argenis Diaz** recorded his second hit of the night in the bottom of the fourth inning. A few pitches later, **Eric Farris** smoked a line drive to right field to score Diaz from first base and extend the Wings' lead 4-1. Farris was caught in a rundown between second and third after **Doug Bernier** hit a ground ball to Iribarren at shortstop for the Bats. Bernier reached safely at first but was stranded there when Danny Santana struck out to retire the side. The Wings led 4-1 going into the fifth inning.

After a one-two-three fifth inning by the Wings' defense, Beresford led off with a base hit directly down the first base line. Ortiz recorded his second RBI of the game with a double to left center to score Beresford. Up next, Rodriguez came to the plate and laced a 406-foot home run, his third of the season. Collin Balester came to the mound to relieve Holmberg after Diaz lined to left field, his third hit of the night. Farris popped out to end the inning. After the three-run inning, the Wings extended their lead to 7-1.

Holmberg's line: 4 2/3 innings pitched, eleven hits, seven runs, all earned, no walks, one strikeout, and one home run.

**Lester Oliveros** relieved Santana in the top of the sixth inning with runners on first and second and two outs. Oliveros got a pop out to end the inning. Santana's line: 5 2/3 innings pitched, five hits, one earned run, two walks, and three strikeouts. Santana threw 88 pitches, 53 for strikes. It was Oliveros' first outing since returning from his seven-day suspension. Oliveros worked 2+ innings, allowing one walk. **Cole Johnson** relieved Oliveros in the eighth inning.

The Wings picked up another run in the seventh, when Rodriguez scored on a wild pitch. In the eighth, Danny Santana and Beresford each had an RBI extra-base hit, pushing the Wings' lead to 10-1.

Rodriguez had two hits, three runs scored and three RBI. Diaz had three hits. The Red Wings out-hit the Bats 16-6.

Ervin Santana is scheduled to make a start for the Wings on the road next week, then make a third start on the homestand that begins next Friday June 26. He is eligible to start for the Twins on July 5th in Kansas City.

## **Wings send Jason Wheeler to Double-A, Peavey coming up**

The Rochester Red Wings have sent left-handed starting pitcher Jason Wheeler to Double-A Chattanooga. He was told following Saturday's 10-1 victory over the Louisville Bats.

The move comes as no surprise. Wheeler has struggled of late. He is just 1-6 with a 5.90 ERA. Over his past seven starts he has allowed 58 hits. His WHIP (walks plus hits/per inning) is 1.55.

He didn't get out of the third inning in Thursday's 10-7 loss to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre at Frontier Field, allowing six hits, two walks and seven runs. The runs all came in the third inning. While just one of the runs was earned due to his fielding error, he was hit hard, including a grand slam by Austin Romine.

Wheeler, 24, is in just his fourth pro season so he has plenty of time to find his game.

Right-hander Greg Peavey, 26, will come up from Chattanooga to take Wheeler's place in the starting rotation.

Peavey is 6-2 with a 4.66 ERA in 13 starts for the Lookouts. He has a 1.27 WHIP.

Jose Berrios may have seemed like the more obvious choice for promotion. Berrios is 7-3 with a 3.23 ERA and 1.17 WHIP for Chattanooga.

But only 21, it's clear the parent Minnesota Twins don't want to rush their prized young right-hander.

## **Tanner Vavra, with vision in one eye, sees the big picture**

Tanner Vavra lost most of the vision in his right eye at age 3 after a fishing accident with his father and the rest of it at age 10 after a backyard football game collision.

So forget about playing big league baseball for a moment. Doctors told Vavra he would never drive, let alone play high school football, hockey and baseball. But Vavra played all of those sports while growing up in Menomonie, Wis.

High school opponents told him he was wasting his time playing baseball. Some even made fun of him.

But Vavra shrugged that aside. At age 25 and the starting second baseman for the Class A Fort Myers Miracle, the son of the Minnesota Twins bench coach stands three promotions from playing for his father in the majors.

Vavra's trajectory as a baseball player began rising prior to his high school senior season when he swallowed some pride — he wanted to do everything by himself — and reached out to his father for some extra hitting instruction.

"I underutilized him until going into my senior year," Tanner Vavra said of 2008, when his father was the Minnesota Twins hitting coach. He still works for the team as the big-league bench coach.

"I decided to call him," Tanner Vavra said. "I went home and hit with him over the Christmas break and then all of a sudden, I'm rolling into the season feeling the best I've felt."

Joe Vavra, also father to Twins prospect Trey Vavra and incoming University of Minnesota freshman baseball player Terrin Vavra, said he was thrilled Tanner reached out to him.

"As time evolved, I could see there was more of a serious side to him," Joe Vavra said. "At one point, we didn't think he had a future in professional baseball at all. But he started asking more questions about hitting plans and what to do and all of that stuff. Once he started having some success at a higher level, he just got better and better at it.

"We've always talked baseball. There was never a time that we didn't talk baseball. On the hitting side, things started to get a little more advanced when he got to his senior year."

### **The accident**

The Vavra family was on a fishing trip in Washington. Tanner was 3 and standing next to his father. Trey was an infant and being held by their mother.

"You've got to listen to your parents," Tanner Vavra said. "There's a reason why. I was told to keep my two fingers in my dad's belt loop. My mom and my brother Trey were by the car. I decided that I needed to go back to them. Without telling my dad or even looking at what he was doing, I took off running."

The hook from dad's cast caught Tanner in that right eye.

"You know, my dad saved my eye, too," Tanner Vavra said. "He saved it by stopping the blood and by getting cold water on it and taking me to the hospital. I don't know what would have happened had he not stopped the bleeding."

And so began a series of four surgeries and a protocol of patching the good, left eye in order to strengthen the bad one. Tanner had to leave the patch on for all but one hour a day. He did this for almost seven years. The vision in the right eye improved to 20/25, but almost as soon as doctors told him to abandon the patch, he had the football collision and lost all vision in the right eye. He can sense changes in light in that eye, but he "can't see the big 'E' on the eye chart."

Tanner Vavra cannot remember what it was like to see out of both eyes. He called that a blessing.

"I remember running into a lot of walls when I was patching my good eye," he said. "And I remember what it's like to see out of that other eye. But I don't remember what it was like to see out of both eyes, because I had the patch on. And when I took the patch off, everything was so clear in my other eye.

"It's a blessing that I don't remember what it's like to see with two eyes, probably. Who knows? If I could remember what it was like to see with both eyes, maybe it would be tougher for me."

### **Exceeding expectations**

Through the Florida State League All-Star break, the 5-foot-11, 182-pound Tanner Vavra was hitting .205 (23-for-112) with three extra-base hits, all doubles in 42 games. He has struck out 27 times and walked five times. In three professional seasons, he has a career .244 batting average.

Big league players perform better than that. The Vavra family knows this as well as anyone. Minnesota Twins second baseman Brian Dozier, for example, hit .322 (58-for-180) with 11 doubles, five triples, two home runs and 22 RBI in his first 49 games of the 2011 season for the Fort Myers Miracle, earning a midseason promotion to Double-A that year.

"Anybody that puts on a professional uniform, you have those thoughts," Joe Vavra said of his son playing in the big leagues. "He knows it's all a process. He knows he's a long shot. He knows all of that stuff. But he wants to be the best baseball guy he can be. That's the way he approaches it."

Lesla Vavra, Tanner's mother, said at this point, anything else her oldest son accomplished would go above and beyond any expectations.

"I think Tanner probably would be at a higher level if it hadn't happened, because he has always loved baseball," she said. "He has always wanted to get better. Even when he was little.

"But we definitely think the accident has given him the drive to keep moving on. He was always told that he couldn't play high school sports. And he was always like, 'I don't think so.' If you tell him he can't do something, he's always more driven to do it. To have his eye taken away from him, it just doesn't make any sense other than God having a bigger plan for him."

Trey Vavra, who was teammates with Tanner in high school and in junior college, said he hoped to team with his brother again in the minors or the majors with the Twins.

"He doesn't call it a disability or anything like that," said Trey Vavra, who is 23 and playing first base and the outfield for the Cedar Rapids (Iowa) Kernels, one level below the Miracle. "I think he doesn't want to be thought of that way. He's still competing with those guys. And they don't care if he has one eye or two eyes."

Miracle manager Jeff Smith said Tanner Vavra has played solid defense. His playing time has increased since the season began.

"I think he would get mad at me if I even thought he could see with only one eye," Smith said. "I never take that into account. I view him as any other player, and he can play very well. I couldn't even imagine how hard it is."

Tanner Vavra said he did not know what his baseball future would bring. But he did know that his father helped get him to Madison (Wis.) Area Technical College, Valparaiso University and then to the Twins as a 30<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2013.

"I'm trying to make it for myself and to try and show everybody who told me I wouldn't be able to drive a car, let alone play professional baseball that I can do this," Tanner Vavra said. "I want to show that I'm a great player."

"I'm still here, and I'm still going through this. Hopefully it keeps going."

## **Kernels fall 7-4 in slugfest**

Back-to-back singles by Arby Fields and Martin Peguero gave the LumberKings runners on first and second. Chantz Mack was then hit by a pitch, loading the bases for Clinton. Estarlyn Morales put the LumberKings up 1-0 with an RBI single to left, scoring Fields. Taylor Zeutenhorst extended the Clinton lead to 2-0 with an RBI single to right, plating Peguero.
