Bisons top Wings, who changed on the fly

There are days in professional baseball like the one the Rochester Red Wings had Saturday, and manager Mike Quade knows how the story can go at the Triple-A level.

When Quade arrived at Frontier Field, the veteran skipper of 19 seasons adjusted his lineup in ways he may never had to before.

"It was a strange day when the day started," Quade said. "You get to this situation at this level a lot of times, (but) I was trying to remember if in all my years, if I lost my starting pitcher and starting catcher on the same day."

Turned out the Buffalo Bisons also had to change their starting pitcher, but got by the Wings just fine, 10-2 in front of an announced paid crowd of 4,126.

Tyler Duffey, the scheduled starter for the Wings, was on his way to Washington, D.C. John Hicks, the Wings catcher who delivered hits of late, also was gone. He was off the Twins' 40-man roster and on his way into a new organization. Terry Ryan, the Twins general manager who spent the last few days in Rochester watching the Wings, did give Quade a heads-up.

Duffey, a right-hander who pitched with Rochester and Minnesota last season, was promoted to pitch Sunday against the Washington Nationals in place of Ervin Santana (stiff or sore back). Duffey, a fifth-year pro who was 5-1 with a 3.10 ERA in 10 starts with the Twins in 2015, earned his first promotion of the season to the majors.

Hicks was 5-for-10 with an RBI during the Wings' four-game series against Pawtucket at Frontier last week. When the Twins moved Hicks off their 40-man roster, the Tigers claimed the former 2011 fourth-round draft choice of the Seattle Mariners and sent him to their Double-A team in Erie, Pa. Hicks had a .242 batting average with one home run and 1 RBI in 33 at-bats.

The Wings do have a player coming down from the Twins, 22-year old infielder Jorge Polanco.

"God bless Monday," Quade said. "We have an off day, so we have to get through tomorrow (Sunday) and then that off day is huge. The bullpen today, we would've liked to have gotten more from some guys, but Buddy (Boshers') outing (three innings) and (Dan Runzler) giving us two, we'll see what we look like tomorrow, but I know we got three guys available. (Brandon) Kintzler, (J.R.) Graham and (David) Martinez, and that's a good start."

Loek van Mil, a right-hander who is 7-feet 1-inch tall, retired the Bisons in order during the first inning. He walked three batters and allowed five runs the next inning however. Wings lefty Taylor Rogers put the Bisons down 1-2-3 in the third, but allowed four runs on five hits and a walk in the fourth.

Right-hander Drew Hutchison, Buffalo's scheduled starter, joined the Bisons' parent team in Toronto, to pitch Sunday for the Blue Jays against the Oakland Athletics. Bisons left-hander Dustin Antolin, a reliever with one start in 261 previous appearances, struck out five of the first six Wings he faced. The Wings were hitless for the first 4 $\frac{2}{3}$ innings.

"It was not a good day," Quade said. "We didn't swing the bats, we got behind very early and that made things tough."

Carson Fulmer picks up first Double-A win in defeat of Lookouts

Birmingham Barons starting pitcher Carson Fulmer earned plenty of ESPN face time with Vanderbilt, the College World Series champion in 2014 and runner-up a year ago.

Fulmer even picked up a fan in Doug Mientkiewicz, whose Chattanooga Lookouts faced the former Commodores ace Saturday night at AT&T Field.

"I watched him on TV when he pitched in college," the Lookouts manager said before the game. "I'm looking forward to watching him tonight, because I like the way he works fast, and he has electric stuff. We'll see what we can do."

The 6-foot, 200-pound Fulmer was roughed up during his first three Double-A starts but was impressive against the Lookouts, pitching six scoreless innings and getting the win in Birmingham's 6-0 victory before a crowd of 4,419. Fulmer allowed four hits while striking out six and not allowing a walk.

Birmingham broke a scoreless tie with two runs in the seventh inning, getting doubles by Nicky Delmonico and Joey DeMichele and singles by Trey Michalczewski and Jake Peter.

Fulmer was selected by the Boston Red Sox in the 15th round of the 2012 draft out of All Saints Academy in Winter Haven, Fla., but opted to delay his professional career by enrolling at Vanderbilt. He began his career as a reliever with the Commodores before moving into the rotation during the 2014 season, when the Commodores won their first national championship in any men's sport.

In three seasons in Nashville, the right-hander racked up a 24-3 record, which was highlighted by a junior year in which he went 14-2 with a 1.83 ERA in 19 starts. His 19th start came against Virginia in the opening game of last year's College World Series, when he struck out eight and allowed just two hits in a 5-1 Commodores triumph.

The Cavaliers denied Vanderbilt a second straight CWS title by winning the next two games.

Fulmer was drafted last June by the Chicago White Sox as the eighth overall selection. He received a signing bonus of \$3.47 million.

"I know who he is, but it's really the same plan for us no matter who we face," said Lookouts right fielder Daniel Palka, who did not cross paths with Fulmer several months ago in the Arizona Fall League.

Fulmer entered Saturday night with an 0-3 record and an 8.53 ERA. His toughest outing was his first, when the 22-year-old failed to last three innings at Jacksonville on April 8 before giving up five runs.

Several Lookouts admitted they didn't know much about Fulmer's background, so there wasn't an added excitement level as a result.

"There shouldn't be, because he's a Double-A player now," Mientkiewicz said. "The Double-A level is a tough year to start. We really couldn't scout him from what he did at Vanderbilt, because your hitters are better one through nine than the college players. We watched a little bit of film, but until you get in the box, you don't really know.

"We try to tell our guys to stick with their strengths regardless of who's throwing."

David Hurlbut (1-1, 5.84) is scheduled to start today's 2:15 p.m. game for the Lookouts, with Jordan Guerrero (0-0, 4.85) scheduled for the Barons.
