Baseball managers use Sabermetrics to construct batting order

Rochester Red Wings manager Mike Quade is a middle-aged man of 60 who grew up thinking about baseball in the old-school ways that had been passed down from generation to generation.

“Things weren’t quantified the way they are now,” Quade said of a simpler time when there was more an emphasis on what your eyes told you about a player as opposed to the dizzying menagerie of numbers crawling across a computer screen. “The game has changed.”

That change was Sabermetrics, Bill James’ mind-melting tomes on alternative baseball strategies that were once regarded quizzically but now are considered gospel.

With the addition of a whole new series of three- to four-letter acronyms — WHIP, WAR and many more that come into play — lineup construction is one area effected most by this evolution of the game. For decades, there was a time-tested formula for making the batting order:

Your leadoff man was a speedy slap hitter who could get on base regularly and steal bases; the No. 2 man could get on if the leadoff man didn’t, but he was also would give himself up by bunting or hitting behind the runner to move that leadoff man up a base; the 3-4-5 hitters supplied the power; the No. 6 hitter could be a power or on-base guy who could get a second rally started; and the 7-8-9 men were the worst hitters in descending order, and you just hoped for the best with them, knowing that if nothing else, they’d play good defense.

Like one-admission doubleheaders, knot-hole gangs, and starting pitchers completing what they started, that thinking is long gone, and lineup construction has become almost an art form.

“Absolutely,” Quade said when asked if it takes more thought when making out his lineup, admitting that he can’t deny what the new numbers say.

Casey Stengel

must be rolling in his grave watching some of the things managers do today. Sluggers Kris Bryant of the Cubs, Mike Trout of the Angels, and Josh Donaldson of the Blue Jays — all former MVPs — occupy the two hole; Kyle Schwarber, a bulky catcher by trade, has been batting leadoff for the Cubs, the same place the Twins have slotted Brian Dozier fresh off his 42-homer season.

Armed with advanced metrics, the Ivy League whiz kids who run teams in the 21st century – for instance, general managers Jon Daniels of the Rangers and A.J. Preller of the Padres, both from Cornell – see the game in a different way. Speed is no longer considered critical to a productive offense; on-base percentage and power are all the rage.

The most important thing for the leadoff man is just to get on. . The No. 2 hitter should also be a big-time on-base percentage stud with power, 30- to 40-homer power if possible. Sabermetricians dig the long ball.

Percentages indicate the No. 3 hitter bats with fewer runners on base than the No. 2 and No. 4 guys, and even the No. 5 hitter statistically gets more RBI chances. If you listen to some, the No. 3 hitter doesn’t matter much at all.

Of course, not all teams subscribe to that theory. Four of the best hitters in MLB — Bryce Harper of the Nationals, Paul Goldschmidt of the Diamondbacks, Nolan Arenado of the Rockies, and Manny Machado of the Orioles — all bat third.

The cleanup man, as he always has, should be the player with the highest slugging percentage. Yes, he’ll strike out plenty, but that’s better than hitting into a double play. Just hit the ball out of the park, and the same goes for the No. 5 man, too.

What’s most interesting, though, is the use of the No. 9 hitter. He should actually be a better hitter than 7 and 8 because some teams rely on him to start the wheels rolling as the lineup turns over to the top.

The new-wave philosophies aren’t limited to professional baseball.

Rob Grow, who in 2017 guided RIT to one of its finest seasons that included an NCAA tournament berth, used his best power hitter, Will Gorman, in the No. 2 spot most of the year. The Tigers had a reliable leadoff hitter in Nevada Waterman who could get on base.

"We wanted our best hitter coming up in the first inning so we could make the pitcher work hard right away, make that a taxing inning for him," said Grow, who has coached at RIT for a quarter-century and has won more than 450 games.

Gorman and No. 3 hitter Brett Kajganich were the Tigers best run-producers, and in an interesting twist, cleanup hitter Dan Zeglen had very little power. "No power, but he was a good hitter," said Grow. "We just wanted our 4 hitter to have good at-bats. I think a lot of people are still stuck in the old mindsets."

Not Gorman, though. His No. 9 hitter, usually Jason Schultz, had gap power and a .349 on-base percentage.

"If you don't have a good bottom, that effects how some people think," Grow said.

In high school, the parameters are a little different because there simply isn't enough depth 1 through 9. Coaches almost always bunch their best hitters at the top, but that doesn't mean you can't occasionally go off script.

"I moved my catcher (Ryan Ballard) to the leadoff spot, and we joke about it because of the Cubs (with Schwarber)," said Greece Athena coach Jason Bunting.

It's a bit of an anomaly this year, but typically, Bunting sticks to conventional methods. However, he doesn't "always have pieces (to get too creative)."

One area where Bunting relies on metrics is in at-bat approach. "The most overrated stat is batting average; the thing I look at is on-base percentage," he said. "At the end of the day, are guys getting on base? In high school we're making more errors, so we need to put the ball in play and put pressure on the defense."

Ultimately, no matter what order you write the names down, the players have to perform. That's why Quade, while on board with sabermetrics, still relies on knowing the pulse of his players as much as he does the data.

"I'm old school enough to think that performance matters," he said. "I like facts, I like numbers, so show me why. I'm interested in listening. I'm on board with about 90 percent of it, but I get a little irritated when they take the human element out."
