Curious Twins give ‘bullpenning’ a whirl in their minor league system

KANSAS CITY, Mo. — The Twins have begun experimenting with “bullpenning” in their minor league system.

After journeyman lefty Paco Rodriguez made a pair of brief starts in recent days at Double-A Chattanooga, Trevor May served as “the opener” and was pulled after the first inning Sunday for Triple-A Rochester.

May worked a scoreless first on 22 pitches, then turned things over to right-hander Zack Littell for the next 5 2/3 innings in a 9-5 loss to Norfolk. Pete Maki, the Twins’ first-year minor league pitching coordinator, was on hand to see how it worked.

“I think the logic surrounding it is sound,” May, who has both started and relieved in his career, told reporters. “Facing the best hitters in their lineup three times (as a starter) can be avoided this way.”

The Twins closed out the first half with four games against the Tampa Bay Rays, who have used bullpenning to great effect since taking the plunge in late May. Josh Kalk, hired this offseason as a senior analyst for the Twins, spent his past nine years working with the Rays.

It’s unclear when or if the approach will reach the Twins at the big-league level, but their brain trust at least wanted to get younger starters acclimated to the concept.

“It changes your routine a little bit,” Littell told reporters. “With this you have to wait and see how the first inning goes. If he gets in trouble, you’ve got to get in there.”

DOZIER SQUARED

Brian Dozier and Royals rookie Hunter Dozier have discussed their shared surname and don’t believe they are related, but they still have shared curiosity.

“He said we need to figure that out,” Hunter Dozier said. “He grew up in Mississippi and I grew up in Texas, but you never know.”

Hunter Dozier, the eighth overall pick in 2013 out of Stephen F. Austin University, has seen time at first base, third base and right field this season. In the age of Twitter updates and the ticker scroll at the bottom of the TV screen, there has been confusion over which Dozier was doing big things.

“I get texts and stuff sometimes,” Hunter Dozier said. “When we’re playing against each other, he’ll hit a home run or something and I’ll get a text that says, ‘Hey, that’s awesome. Congrats.’ I’m like, ‘No, that wasn’t me.’ ”

Just five Doziers have played in the majors. In addition to the two American League Central rivals, there was former Penn State running back D.J. Dozier (1992 New York Mets), Oakland A’s pitcher Tom Dozier (1986) and Buzz Dozier, a Washington Senators right-hander in the late ‘40s.

“It’s cool,” Hunter Dozier said of the modern connection. “He’s such a good guy too. It’s fun to play against him.”

SANTANA SET TO RETURN

Velocity issues won’t keep Ervin Santana from returning to the Twins’ rotation. In fact, it’s going to happen on Wednesday in Toronto.

“We thought keeping him on his regular rest would be good,” Twins manager Paul Molitor said. “The guys who have pitched so far would get an extra day and Jose (Berrios) would be on regular rest.”

Santana touched 90 mph only a few times with his fastball in his latest rehab start Friday night for Triple-A Rochester, but the Twins were encouraged by his command and his strike percentage.

HITS FOR EDDIE

Left fielder Eddie Rosario, with two more hits Saturday night, pushed his hit total to 120, third-most in the AL.

Only all-stars Jose Altuve (130) and Jean Segura (122) entered Sunday with more hits than Rosario. Now on pace for 203 hits, Rosario is bidding to post the Twins' first 200-hit season since Molitor had 225 hits in 1996.

Along with Molitor, four other Twins have accounted for the 13 total 200-hit seasons in club history: Cesar Tovar, Tony Oliva (twice), Rod Carew (four times) and Puckett (five times). Carew's 239 hits in 1977 remains the Twins' record.

Rosario's career high for hits is 157, set last season.

BRIEFLY

First baseman Logan Morrison went 0 for 3 with a walk and an RBI groundout in his return to the lineup. He had been on the 10-day disabled list with a hip impingement.

After Sunday's game the Twins optioned reliever Alan Busenitz to Triple-A to make room for left-hander Adalberto Mejia, set to start Monday night in Toronto.
