DETROIT VS. MINNESOTA: The Twins last series at Comerica Park was a three-gamer from September 30-October 2, 2022 as they lost the series two games to one...

WILL-TY CONSCIOUS: Willi Castro played four seasons for the Tigers from 2019-22, hitting .246 (282-for-1147) with 50 doubles, 11 triples, 29 home runs, 114 RBI, 159 runs scored...

WHEN I'M GONE: Twins have won two of their last three road series, taking two of three at Houston from May 29-31, followed by getting swept in Tampa Bay from June 6-8...

ALL THAT'S LEFT: Tonight marks the 16th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter... Twins are 7-8 when a left-hander is the opposing starter.

LEWIS YOURSELF: Royce Lewis has reached base safely in a career-best seven straight games, hitting .348 (8-for-23) with one double, one home run, three RBI, two walks, a .400 on-base percentage...

CAN BE YOUR SUPERMAN: Twins have stolen 36 bases in 42 attempts this season, for a 85.7 success rate, best in the AL and third best in baseball...

THE MONSTER (BLASTS): The Twins have homered 98 times this season, fifth most in the AL and eighth most in baseball...the Twins have 19 different players with a home run this season...

GAP GOD: The Twins have hit 25 doubles since June 10, third most in the AL since that date, trailing Boston (30) and Texas (27)...their 38 doubles this month are the fourth most in the AL...

BROCK-INGBIRD: Brock Stewart has posted a 0.78 ERA (23.0 IP, 2 ER) in 23 games this season, holding opponents scoreless in 22 of those outings (2 ER on 5/29 at HOU)...Stewart's 0.78 ERA leads all relievers in baseball...

TRULY YOURS, YOUR BIGGEST FAN, THIS IS STAN DURAN: Jhoan Duran has posted a 1.77 ERA (96.2 IP, 19 ER) since the start of 2022, the third best ERA in baseball (minimum of 90.0 IP), trailing only Justin Verlander (1.75) and Emmanuel Clase (1.75)...

- ☞ Making his first start since April 26 vs. New York-AL; missed the Twins' last 51 games on the 15-day Injured List with a right triceps strain.
- ☞ Facing Detroit for the ninth time in his career...last faced the Tigers on July 27, 2021 in a 6-5 Twins loss at Target Field...did not factor into the decision after pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on four hits, issuing two walks and striking out five batters.
- ☞ Seeking his first win since August 14, 2021, when he earned the win against Tampa Bay in a 12-0 Twins victory.
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley in 2020.

**LAST MLB START:** Was dealt the loss in his last major league start on April 26 vs. New York-AL, a 12-6 Twins loss opposite Domingo Germán...pitched 3.0 innings and allowed a career-high 10 runs on 11 hits, walked two batters and struck out two...allowed five runs in the second inning (an RBI single by Willie Calhoun, an RBI single by Anthony Volpe and a bases-clearing RBI double by Aaron Judge)...allowed the first five Yankees to reach base in the top of the fourth inning before being lifted from the game; four runs scored...replaced by Brent Headrick who allowed a two-run home run to Gleyber Torres...Headrick also allowed a sacrifice fly to DJ LeMahieu...Emilio Pagan later entered the game to pitch a scoreless ninth inning.

- ☞ Became the first Twins pitcher to allow 10 earned runs in a start since Joe Ryan on July 29, 2022 at San Diego.
- ☞ Fell to 0-4 on the season, becoming the first Twin to lose his first four starts of the season since Phil Hughes from April 6-24, 2015...has lost his last five starts dating back to August 21, 2021, marking the first time he has taken the loss in five consecutive starts in his career.

**ACROSS THE RIVER, REHAB:** Maeda made four rehab starts with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints dating back to May 30...went 0-0, 2.38 ERA (11.1 IP, 3 ER), with four walks and 13 strikeouts...did not factor into his last start on June 16 at Louisville...pitched 4.1 innings and allowed one run on two hits, issued four walks and struck out four batters...allowed the first three batters to reach base safely in the bottom of the fifth inning...replaced Kody Funderburk after striking out Wil Myers...Funderburk permitted a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch to Joey Votto (run charged to Maeda).

**AGAINST DETROIT:** Maeda is facing the Tigers for the ninth time in his career...is 2-2, 3.69 ERA (46.1 IP, 19 ER) with seven walks and 58 strikeouts in his previous eight appearances...last faced Detroit on July 27, 2021 at Target Field...did not factor into the 11-inning, 6-5 Twins defeat, after pitching 6.1 innings and allowing one run on four hits (1 HR), issuing two walks and striking out five batters...yielded his only on a solo home by Akil Baddoo...relieved by Tyler Duffey in the seventh inning who combined with Danny Coulombe to pitch 1.2 scoreless innings...Hansel Robles entered the game in the ninth inning and allowed a game-tying grand slam to Eric Haase...Jorge Alcala allowed the game winning run on an RBI single to Miguel Cabrera in the 11th inning.

- ☞ Is 2-1, 3.35 ERA (40.1 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 51 strikeouts against the Tigers since joining the Twins...owns the sixth-most strikeouts against the Tigers since 2020 (min. 40 IP).
- ☞ Currently owns a two-game win streak against the Tigers, but has not been handed a decision since April 7, 2021...is 2-0, 2.86 ERA (28.1 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 35 strikeouts in the five-start span.
- ☞ His last start at Comerica Park came on July 17, 2021, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched with eight strikeouts in a Twins 5-4 loss...he is 1-2, 4.70 ERA (23.0 IP, 12 ER) with two walks and 29 strikeouts in four career starts in Detroit...his lone win at Comerica occurred on April 7, 2021, allowing two runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched in a 4-2 victory.

**BACK TO THE ROAD:** Maeda is 0-2, 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in two road starts this season...batters are slashing .160/.192/.400 on the road against Maeda compared to .422/.447/.644 at home...in the 2021 season, Maeda pitched 14 of his 21 starts on the road, going 4-3, 6.06 ERA (68.1 IP, 46 ER) with 22 walks and 76 strikeouts...is 7-6, 5.04 ERA (109.0 IP, 61 ER) with 27 walks and 123 strikeouts in 22 starts on the road since becoming a Twin...has enjoyed more success at home over his career, with batters slashing .217/.272/.352 in home games compared to .240/.304/.424 during road games.

- ☞ Pitching at Comerica Park for the first time since July 17, 2021, when he pitched 5.0 innings, allowed three runs on three hits, issued one walk and struck out eight batters.

**THE RIGHT STUFF:** After his first four starts, Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters...righties are slashing .295/.311/.545 with 10 strikeouts and an .857 OPS compared to left-handed hitters who are slashing .385/.420/.577 with four strikeouts and a 1.005 OPS.

- ☞ Historically Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters, with righties only batting .206/.255/.355 with 310 hits against him, as opposed to left-handed batters slashing .252/.323/.426 with 359 hits...owns the third-lowest opponent batting average vs. righties since 2016 (min 750.0 IP), trailing Max Scherzer (.181) and Jacob DeGrom (.203).

**THE ARSENAL:** In four starts this season, Maeda has used a five-pitch mix, mostly using his split finger and slider at 31.3 percent each...all three of his home runs allowed have come off of a slider...allowed three doubles on sliders in his last start...mostly uses his split finger (50 pitches) and against lefties and his slider (71 pitches) and sinker (24 pitches) against righties...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

## TOMMOROW'S STARTER- RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 3-4, 4.40 ERA // CAREER: 31-35, 4.01 ERA)

Right-hander is Pablo López is scheduled to start in the second game of the three-game series against the Detroit Tigers...took his fourth loss of the season in his last start on June 19 after pitching 5.2 innings and allowing five runs (4 earned) on six hits, issuing three walks and striking out nine batters in a 9-3 Twins defeat against Boston at Target Field...will be facing the Tigers for the first time in his career; Detroit will become the 28th team he has faced in the majors...is 9-8, 3.42 ERA (157.2 IP, 60 ER) in 27 career starts vs. new opponents...the other two opponents he has yet to face are Seattle and Minnesota.

## CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.

- ☞ Became the sixth Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to make an Opening Day start, first for the Twins...the others are: Masahiro Tanaka (4x), Hideo Nomo (3x), Yu Darvish (1x), Hiroki Kuroda (1x) and Daisuke Matsuzaka (1x).
- ☞ Recorded season-high 10 strikeouts on July 4 at Kansas City, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed...marked his seventh career double-digit strikeout total and second as a Twin.
- ☞ Recorded 800th career strikeout in the second game of the doubleheader July 17 at Detroit, fanning Akil Baddoo in the fifth inning.
- ☞ Exited August 21 start at New York-AL after 4.1 innings due to right forearm tightness and was placed on the 10-day Injured List August 23...had Tommy John surgery on right elbow in Dallas, TX September 1.

- No relievers used yesterday vs. BOS as Joe Ryan pitched CG SHO...pen finished homestand going 3-2, 5.49 ERA (39.1 IP, 24 ER) w/ 11 BB & 30 K, including .287 BAA and 5 HR in 9 G.
In 19 games this month, 'pen is 7-3, 3.94 ERA (64.0 IP, 28 ER) w/ 19 BB & 54 K, including 3 SV and 7 HLD...allowed 12 ER on 15 H and 8 BB in last 3 G (11.1 IP) - all vs Boston.
Pen has thrown 821 offspeed pitches. 3rd most in baseball trailing CIN (936) & NYY (839)...they have averaged 90.2 mph on all pitches, 7th-hardest throwing 'pen in MLB (4th in AL).
Pen has 6th-lowest xBA (.228) in MLB, 8th lowest wOBA (.297) and 9th lowest xSLG (.372)...also, they have allowed the 4th-fewest hits among all MLB bullpens (199).
