THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (2-1 vs. the Angels and 2-1 vs. the Athletics), the Twins began their final roadtrip of 2023 with consecutive wins over the Rockies in Colorado over the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale at Coors Field and conclude the 2023 regular season...the Twins have gone 47-34 at home and 40-40 on the road.

The Twins are seeking their seventh sweep of the season today...their previous six sweeps were March 30-April 2 at Kansas City (3 games), June 13-14 vs. Milwaukee (2 games), July 3-5 vs. Kansas City (3 games), July 14-16 at Oakland (3 games), July 21-23 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games) and August 4-6 vs. Arizona (3 games)...last season, they swept opponents eight times, all in three games...the Twins are 6-9 when entering the series finale with the opportunity to sweep...Twins have never swept the Rockies.

A win today and the Twins will finish over .500 on the road for the first time since going 55-26 away from Target Field in 2019.

FARMER AND POLANCO PERFECT MANAGERIAL RECORD: The Twins beat the Rockies last night at Coors Field by a score of 14-6, giving Kyle Farmer and Jorge Polanco their first career managerial victories...Emilio Pagan was the Opener, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning...Chris Paddock (1-0) earned the win in relief, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits and were led by Edouard Julien, who went 3-for-5 with three RBI and his 16th home run of the season...Trevor Larnach hit his first career grand slam, the eighth for the Twins this season, tying the club record for grand slams in a season, previously done in 1961.

ALCALA BACK: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 60-day Injured List...Alcala, who was originally placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 16 with a right forearm extensor muscle strain, appeared in five games on rehab assignment in September with Low-A Fort Myers, Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to allowing two runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched (3.00 ERA) with one walk and 10 strikeouts...prior to landing on the Injured List, the right-hander made 10 relief appearances for the Twins, going 0-1, 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP, 11 ER), with eight walks and 12 strikeouts...to make room for Alcala on the 28-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have placed left-handed pitcher Dallas Keuchel on the 15-day Injured List with a right calf strain...to make room on the 40-man, Gilberto Celestino has been DFA'd.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The Twins will play the winner of the third wild card spot at Target Field on Tuesday (time TBD)...the third wild card spot will go to either Houston or Toronto with both teams currently in a tie at 89-72...Houston plays Arizona today and Toronto plays Tampa Bay...Minnesota won the AL Central for the ninth time in their history on September 22 and clinched a playoff berth for the 15th time...below are the results from previous Postseasons (since 1961):

YEAH! WE'RE IN THE ROCKIES!: The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 21st time in their history today...the Twins have gone 12-8 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-3 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 5-4 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22). Twins are looking to win their fifth straight against the Rockies (dating back to June 25, 2022), which would mark their best over Colorado.

SHERRY ROBERTSON AND JIM RANTZ AWARD WINNERS: The Twins announced today that infielder Brooks Lee has been named the 2023 Sherry Robertson Award winner as the Twins minor league Player of the Year and right-handed pitcher Cory Lewis has been named the 2023 Jim Rantz Award winner as the Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year.

Lee, 22, split the minor league season between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, combining to hit .275 (138-for-501) with 39 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 84 RBI, 83 runs scored and an .808 OPS in 125 games...he began the season with Wichita leading all Double-A hitters with 31 doubles and pacing the Texas League with 42 extra-base hits before being promoted to St. Paul in early August...the 5-foot-11, 205-pound infielder was named Twins minor league Player of the Week two times during the season (May 7 and July 16) and finished the season ranking first among all Twins minor leaguers in doubles (39), tied for second in RBI (81) and second in total bases (231), third in hits (138) and games played (125), and fourth in runs scored (83)...Lee was also one of 10 players in all minor league baseball with 80-plus runs scored, 35-plus doubles, 15-plus home runs, 80-plus RBI and 50-plus walks in the 2023 season...he is ranked by both MLB.com and Baseball America as the second-best prospect in the Twins system.

Lewis, 22, split the 2023 minor league season between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids, combining to go 9-4 with a 2.49 ERA (101.1 IP, 28 ER), 33 walks, 118 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .198 (74-for-373) opponent batting average in 22 starts...the 6-foot-5, 220-pound right-hander was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week one time on the season (June 11) and was tied for first among all Twins minor league pitchers in wins (9), second in strikeouts (118), tied for third in games started (22) and seventh in innings pitched (101.1)...he is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 13 prospect in the Twins organization.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO THE GOAT: Twins legend and Hall of Famer Rod Carew is celebrating his 78th birthday today.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1989, Kirby Puckett and San Diego's Tony Gwynn each won batting titles on the final day of the regular season...Puckett went 2-for-5 to edge Carney Lansford, .339 to .336; Gwynn went 3-for-4 to beat Will Clark, .336 to .333...Puckett led the AL with 215 hits that season and earned the only batting title of his career...in 2002, at Oakland, the Twins played their first playoff game since Game 7 of the 1991 World Series...after falling behind 5-1 after two innings, the Twins rallied to score six runs between the third and seventh innings, highlighted by home runs from Corey Koskie and Doug Mientkiewicz in a 7-5 victory...the Twins went on to win the series 3-2 over the "Moneyball" A's...in 2006, the Twins clinched the AL Central on the final day of the regular season with a 5-1 victory over Chicago-AL...they finished with a record of 96-66, ahead of Detroit, who finished 95-67...the Twins went 71-33 from June 8 through the rest of the season...Joe Mauer went 2-for-4 on the day to finish with a .347 batting average, winning his first career batting title and outlasting Derek Jeter (.343) and Robinson Cano (.342).

Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Making his 12th road start of the season today...is 5-3, 3.82 ERA (61.1 IP, 26 ER) with 12 walks and 66 strikeouts on the road this year...

In 27 career road starts, he is 6-8, 3.79 ERA (137.2 IP, 58 ER) with 25 walks and 136 strikeouts...is 7-4, 3.58 ERA (148.1 IP, 59 ER) with 34 walks and 148 strikeouts in 29 career starts at Target Field.

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota. Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022. Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota. In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season. Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020. Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola. Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961. Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K). In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season. Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston. Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
