THE TWINS: Opened their 63rd season in Minnesota and 14th at Target Field with a three-game series win against the Astros over the weekend, winning the first two and losing the finale yesterday afternoon...today they will begin a three-game series against the White Sox through Wednesday afternoon.

EASTER SUNDAY, NOT SO FUNDAY: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-1...Tyler Mahle (1-1) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded just two hits, one being a single from Byron Buxton and one being an RBI-double from Donovan Solano...the Twins are now 2-1-0 in series play this season, 1-0-0 at home and 1-1-0 on the road.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the first of 13 meetings this season...after this three-game series, their next series will be in three games from May 2-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins went 10-9 against Chicago in 2022, going 6-4 at Target Field and 4-5 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Twins went 1-3 in their final four games of last season.

Twins pitchers posted a 2.66 ERA (61.0 IP, 18 ER) with a slashline of .204/.246/.302 in their last seven games against the White Sox.

Joey Gallo is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with four home runs, seven walks, and a 1.115 OPS in his last nine games vs. the Sox.

MEN IN THE MIDDLE: Through nine games, Twins starting pitchers have combined to post a 2.24 ERA (52.1 IP, 13 ER), with 14 walks, 68 strikeouts, while holding batters to a slashline of .185/.246/.304...below are their ranks among all starting staffs in Major League Baseball:

CENTRAL HEATING: The Twins are playing a series against an AL Central opponent for the second time this season after sweeping the Royals in three games at Kauffman Stadium from March 30-April 2...they will play their division for just 52 games this season, compared to the previous 76 times...the Twins went 39-37 against the AL Central last season, with pitchers posting a 3.55 ERA, their lowest of an opposing division.

CLUTCH CITY: Twins are hitting .328 (22-for-67) with runners in scoring position, tied for third best in baseball with Chicago-ML, trailing Tampa Bay (.317) and Arizona (.333)...additionally, they are hitting .344 (11-for-32) with RISP and two outs, fourth best in baseball.

Notable individual with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is 2-for-3, Joey Gallo is 2-for-4, Donovan Solano is 3-for-5, Christian Vázquez is 3-for-5, Trevor Larnach is 4-for-9, Jose Miranda is 3-for-9 and Kyle Farmer is 3-for-7.

FARMERS ONLY: Kyle Farmer has seven hits in 22 at-bats this season (.315), including five hits in his last nine at-bats...he has seven RBI this season, tied with Joey Gallo for team-lead...Farmer was acquired via trade with Cincinnati on November 18, 2022 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Casey Legumina.

THE TRUTH ON TREVOR: Despite going 0-for-3 yesterday, Trevor Larnach drew a walk and has now reached base in all nine games to start the season, matching his career-best streak also done from May 23-June 2, 2021; has a .439 on-base percentage during his current run...his 11 hits on the season are tied with Byron Buxton for team-lead...additionally, he leads the club in walks (7)...his .439 on-base percentage ranks 10th in the American League.

DONNIE BARRELS: Donovan Solano has hit safely in four straight games, hitting .357 (5-for-14) with two walks, a .438 on-base percentage and an .866 OPS in that span...he was signed by the Twins to a one-year contract on February 23.

C4-EVER MINNESOTA: Carlos Correa has reached safely in seven of eight games played this season, recording six hits with three walks...on January 11, Carlos Correa signed a six-year guaranteed contract through the 2028 season...the deal includes four team options covering the 2029 through 2032 campaigns, each of which can automatically vest based on performance in the previous season...the 28-year-old hit .291 (152-for-522) with 24 doubles, one triple, 22 home runs, 64 RBI, 70 runs scored, 61 walks, a .366 on-base percentage and an .834 OPS in 136 games for the Twins last season...he led all MLB shortstops in OPS (.834), while ranking second among that same group in slugging percentage (.467) and on-base percentage (.366), and third in batting average (.291) and RC/27 (5.84)...Correa also hit .310 (79-for-255) with an .880 OPS in 67 home games, the sixth-highest home average in the AL and 10th best in baseball; it was also the eighth-best home average in Target Field history (since 2010)...after the season, Correa was named winner of the Most Valuable Twin Award, the Bob Allison Award for leadership, the Jim Kaat Award as Twins Defensive Player of the Year, the Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and the Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award.

THIS AND THAT:

- Through nine games, the Twins average time of game is 2:26 minutes, the fastest in baseball...last season, the Twins average time of game was 3:07, a difference of 41 minutes to this season.
Twins catchers have combined to hit .321 (9-for-28) with six walks and a .441 on-base percentage.
Twins have committed just three errors on the season, tied for fifth fewest in baseball.
On this day in 1982, the Twins acquired reliever Ron Davis and minor leaguers Greg Gagne and Paul Boris from New York-AL, in exchange for infielder Roy Smalley and pitcher Gary Serum...Davis ranks fifth on Twins all-time saves list with 108 while Gagne was inducted into the Twins Hall of Fame in 2010.
Low-A Fort Myers hitting coach Rayden Sierra is celebrating his 28th birthday today...he shares a birthday with Do-Hyoung Park, who celebrated his birthday early yesterday by spotting a Dennis Santana and Kyle Lohse jersey in the Thomson Reuters Champions Club.

LAST START: Was dealt the loss in his return from Tommy John surgery against Miami on April 4...first major league start since August 21, 2021 at New York-AL, a span of 591 days...allowed just one run on three hits over 5.0 innings of work...his lone blemish of the game was a home run in the second inning to Avisail Garcia...struck out nine batters; the last time Maeda struck out nine batters was August 3, 2021 against Cincinnati...is now 1-3, 2.20 ERA (32.2 IP, 8 ER), with three walks and 34 strikeouts against Miami in his career...left the game in the sixth inning with trainer due to fatigue.

AGAINST CHICAGO-AL: Maeda is facing the White Sox for the sixth time in his career, going 2-1, 5.37 ERA (24.2 IP, 15 ER) in his five starts...last faced Chicago-AL on June 29, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field, allowing seven runs on eight hits over 4.2 innings with five walks and four strikeouts...tied with his starts on April 2, 2021 against Oakland and August 31, 2017 against Arizona for his most earned runs allowed in a start in his career.

Since joining the Twins, Maeda is 1-1, 6.41 ERA (19.2 IP 14 ER), with eight walks and 21 strikeouts vs. the White Sox...his highest walks issued, second highest earned runs and fourth highest strikeout total and ERA against any opponent in that span.

BACK AT HOME: In the 2021 season, Maeda pitched only pitched a third of his games at home...he went 2-2 3.70 ERA (38.0 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts in seven starts at Target Field...is 5-2, 2.03 ERA (71.0 IP 16 ER) with 16 walks and 79 strikeouts at Target Field since becoming a Twin...has enjoyed more success at home over his career with batters slashing .210/.267/.343 in home games versus .240/.304/.424 during road games.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: In his first start back, Maeda held lefties to zero hits in four at-bats and struck out too...righties are batting .214 (3-for-14) with one home run and seven strikeouts.

Historically Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters, with righties only batting .204/.253/.350 with 230 hits against Maeda, as opposed to left-handed batters slashing .229/.320/.422 with 349 hits.

THE ARSENAL: In his first start of the 2023 season, Maeda used a five-pitch mix, favoring his slider...he used the slider mostly against righties for five strikeouts, alongside his fastball for three strikeouts...only used his curveball once...here's a breakdown of his repertoire.

CENTRALIZED PITCHING: Since joining the Twins, Maeda is 7-3, 3.52 ERA (94.2 IP, 37 ER) with 21 walks and 111 strikeouts...in 21 career starts against the AL Central, Maeda is 10-4, 3.42 ERA (115.2 IP, 44 ER), with 26 walks and 130 strikeouts...his career ERA against the AL Central is the second best, trailing the NL East (3.05) and his 10 wins are tied for his most wins against any division (NL Central)...here is what his numbers against every division look like:

Pablo López is scheduled to start in the second game of the three-game series against the Chicago White Sox...has never faced the White Sox in his career...is 8-6, 3.36 ERA (131.1 IP, 49 ER) with 28 walks and 128 strikeouts when facing a team for the first time...pitched 7.0 innings against Miami, allowed one run on three hits and issued one walk with eight strikeouts, reached 500 career strikeouts...is 2-1, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) with five walks and 20 strikeouts in three games against the AL Central.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owens the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
