with the second of three against Chicago-ALafter tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the
Twins will travel to New York to begin a seven-game, eight-day roadtrip with four against
the Yankees from Thursday-Sunday, followed by an off-day next Monday, then three against
the Dad Say at Fanway Dark from payt Tuesday Thursday

the Red Sox at Fenway Park from next Tuesday-Thursday.

Twins are looking to avoid losing a season-long three-straight...their other two-game losing streak was April 4-5, dropping the second and third games in Miami.

TWINS CAPITALIZE ON SOX MISTAKES, BUT STILL COME UP SHORT: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-3...Kenta Maeda (0-2) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts... all four runs allowed came in the fourth inning, highlighted by a Hanser Alberto three-run homer...the offense recorded just four hits, drew two walks, struck out 13 times, went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left nine men on base.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the second of 13 meetings this season... after this three-game series, their next series will be in three games from May 2-4 at Guaranteed Rate Field.

anteed Rate Field.

Since 2015, the Twins have gone 78-66 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

Joey Gallo is hitting 324 (11-for-34) with four home runs, seven walks, and a 1.115 OPS in his last nine games vs. the Sox.

Notables vs. Sox starter Lance Lynn: Ryan Jeffers is 3-for-5...Jose Miranda is 3-for-5...Matt Wallner is 1-for-3 with a home run...Willi Castro is 3-for-10 with two home runs and two walks...Trevor Larnach is 3-for-10 with one home run and two walks.

BUX FRESH SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .279 (65-for-233) with 20 doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 37 RBI, 44 runs scored and an .892 OPS in 68 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 20 (June 30, 2019-present):

CHRISTIAN ROCKS: Christian Vázquez has seven hits in 21 at-bats this season, including five walks and is slashing .333/.462/.333 with a .795 OPS in seven games...he has reached base in six of his seven games played (0-for-3 on April 4 at Miami)...among all catchers in baseball, he ranks first in on-base percentage, second in batting average, and tied for fourth in walks.

◆ He also has three defensive runs saved, leading all MLB catchers.

◆ He has a catcher ERA of 1.86, which ranks second best in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay's

Francisco Mejía (1.22).

RISPY BUSINESS: The Twins are hitting .154 (2-for-13) with runners in scoring position in their last two games after beginning the season hitting .344 (21-for-61) with RISP in their first eight...on the season, they are hitting .311 (23-for-74) with RISP, the fourth best in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (.342), Chicago-NL (.333) and Texas (.321)...additionally, they are hitting .316 (12-for-38) with RISP and two outs, tied for fourth best in baseball.

■ Notable individual with RISP: Ryan Jeffers is 2-for-3, Joey Gallo is 2-for-4, Donovan Solano is 3-for-5, Christian Vázquez is 3-for-5, Trevor Larnach is 5-for-10, Jose Miranda is 3-for-10 and Kyle Farmer is 3-for-8.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach went 1-for-5 yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 10 straight, setting a new career-high and passing his previous long of nine, done from May 23-June 2, 2021; has a .413 on-base percentage during his current run...he leads the team in both hits (12), RBI (8) and walks (7).

◆ Reaching safely in 10 straight to start the season is the longest since Byron Buxton did it in 10 in 2021...the last to post a streak longer to start a year was when Brian Dozier (17) and Joe Mauer (13) started 2018.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced the Miami Marlins his former team for the first time in his career in a no-LAST ITME UUL: Faced the Miami Marlins, his former team, for the first time in his career...In a nodecision, pitched 7.0 innings and allowed one run and three hits with one walk and eight strikeouts in a Twins 5-2 defeat April 5 at loanDepot Park...pitched opposite of Jesús Luzardo, who also did not factor into the decision...allowed a solo home run to Jorge Soler in the bottom of the first inning, then retired 19 of the next 21 hitters he faced to complete his outing...picked off two runners attempting to steal second base, marking his first career start with two pickoffs...left with game tied 1-1; Twins lost 5-2, falling in the final two games of a three-game set in Miami.

TWO STARTS AGO: López started on Opening Day for the first time in his career on March 30 at Kauffman Stadium and beat the Royals in his Twins debut, pitching 5.1 shutout innings with two hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts...retired first seven batters he faced and nine of first 10...became second Venezuelan-born pitcher to start for Minnesota on Opening Day, joining Johan Santona (2006 07). antana (2006-07).

NEW SOX: Has never faced the White Sox in his career...Chicago-AL will become the 25th opponent he has faced since his major league debut in 2018; yet to face Detroit, Boston, Seattle, Los Angeles-AL and Minnesota during his career...is 9-6, 3.38 ERA (138.1 IP, 52 ER), with 29 walks and 132 strikeouts in 24 career starts when facing a team for the first time...has tossed at least 5.0 innings in 21 of 24 such starts and has allowed 4-or-fewer earned runs in 20 of those 24 starts...is 4-1, 2.44 ERA (44.1 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 48 strikeouts in eight starts vs. new opponents since 2020.

WELCOME TO TARGET FIELD: Tonight is López's first home start as a Twin and first career start at Target Field...pitching in a new ballpark for the second time this year (March 30 - Kauffman Stadium) and 22nd time in his career...in his previous 21 starts at new ballparks, López has gone 10-4, 3.65 ERA (116.0 IP, 47 ER) with 31 walks and 117 strikeouts...López is 14-15, 3.45 ERA (284.0 IP, 109 ER) with 79 walks and 268 strikeouts in 50 career home starts, while he is 15-16, 4.34 ERA (238.1 IP, 115 ER) with 67 walks and 237 strikeouts in 46 road starts.

ALL RIGHT: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .100 (3-for-30) batting average this season. his 12 strikeouts against right-handed hitters are tied with Twins teammate loe Ryan and Seattle's Luis Castillo for the fifth most in the American League in 2023...left-handed hitters are batting .222 (2-for-9) with three walks and four strikeouts vs. López this year...over his career, López has enjoyed more success against right-handed hitters (.651 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.749 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: López has used a five-pitch mix in his first two starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...recorded strikeouts with four different pitches in his last start April 5 at Miami (sweeper - 4, 4-seam fastball - 2, changeup - 1, curveball - 1)...has exclusively used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters this year...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:
