Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision for the Twins home opener against the Houston Astros on April 7, opposite José Urquidy...pitched 7.0 innings, with one run over four hits and one walk issued...

Gray's 13 strikeouts were the most by a Twins starter since Francisco Liriano's 15 strikeouts July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was the winner in his season debut in game two of a three-game series at Kansas City on April 1, opposite Jordan Lyles...Twins won 2-0, securing the series victory...pitched 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, four walks and just one strikeout...

AGAINST CHICAGO-AL: Gray is facing the White Sox for the 11th time in his career, going 4-2, 4.47 ERA (52.1 IP; 26 ER) with 21 walks and 48 strikeouts in his 10 previous appearances...last faced Chicago-AL on September 2, 2022 at Guaranteed Rate Field...

Made one relief appearance against the White Sox on August 7, 2018 where he pitched the final 3.0 innings of a 13-inning game as a Yankee...allowed only one hit, issued one walk and fanned four batters...earned the win.

HOME SWEET HOME: After his home debut, Gray is 0-0, 1.29 ERA (7.0 IP; 1 ER) with one walk and 13 strikeouts...his at home ERA is ranked eighth in the American League (minimum 7.0 IP)...

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: So far this season, Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to lefties...in his first two starts, Gray has held righties to .130/.161/.200 (4-for-30) with 13 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are slashing .250/.438/.333 with just one strikeout.

In his career, Gray owns a .237 opponent batting average (628-for-2654) with 674 strikeouts against right-handed hitters and a .222 batting average (571-for-2569) with 678 strikeouts against left-handed hitters.

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...continued to use his curveball the most at 31.5 percent compared to 24.6 percent last year...has exclusively used the slider against righties and has only used his changeup against lefties...

Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
Named to Baseball America's 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Baseball America Triple-A All-Star.
Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

AGAINST THE CENTRAL: Gray is facing an American League Central opponent for the 53rd time in his career (51st start)...he is 24-13, 3.27 ERA (297.0 IP, 144 ER), with 117 walks and 269 strikeouts in his career against the AL Central.

Since becoming a Twin last season, Gray is 7-2, 2.76 ERA (62.0 IP, 19 ER), with 16 walks and 61 strikeouts in 12 starts against the AL Central...he ranks sixth in ERA and is tied for ninth in strikeouts against the AL Central since 2022 (50.0 IP minimum).
