$\Phi$ The Twins have beat the Sox 65 times at Target Field (since 2010), second-most of any opponent (Kansas City - 66).
THE BUCK SHOW: Byron Buxton hit his 100th career home run last night, becoming the 20th player in club history (since 1961) to reach that mark....he has 12 hits in 39 at-bats to start the season (.308)...since 2021, Buck is hitting . 348 ( 54 -for-155) with 13 doubles, 16 home runs, 30 RBI and 34 runs scored in 41 March/April games...in 2021, he was named American League Player of the Month for April.
SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the third series win of the season for the Twins...in 2022, they went 21-24-6 in series play, going 14-8-4 at home and 7-16-2 on the road...the Twins have gone 2-1 through their first four series this season, going 3-0 at Kansas City from March 30-April 2, 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5 and 2-1 vs. Houston at Target Field from April 7-9.
THE TRUTH ON TREVOR: Trevor Larnach went 1 -for- 3 with a walk last night, extending his career-long on-base streak to 11 straight and has a 420 on-base percentage during his current run...he leads the team in hits ( 13 ), RBI ( 8 ) and walks (8).
$\Phi$ Reaching safely in 11 straight to start the season is the longest since Brian Dozier (17) and Joe Mauer (13) started 2018.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision for the Twins home opener against the Houston Astros on April 7, opposite José Urquidy....pitched 7.0 innings, with one run over four hits and one walk issued... struck out a career high 13 batters...his previous record was 12 batters, which he last reached on July 3, 2019 against Milwaukee...struck out five of the first 10 batters he faced...relieved by Griffin Jax to start the eighth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings in relief of Gray, before Jorge López allowed a an unearned run in the 10th inning...Twins secured the victory via a walkoff RBI single by Kyle Farmer.
$\Phi$ Gray's 13 strikeouts were the most by a Twins starter since Francisco Liriano's 15 strikeouts July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland.
TWO STARTS AGO: Was the winner in his season debut in game two of a three-game series at Kansas City on April 1 , opposite Jordan Lyles...Twins won $2-0$, securing the series victory....pitched 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, four walks and just one strikeout... walked four of his first 13 batters faced...relieved by Jorge Alcala to start the sixth inning, as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings in relief of Gray.
AGAINST CHICAGO-AL: Gray is facing the White Sox for the 11th time in his career, going 4-2, 4.47 ERA (52.1 IP, 26 ER) with 21 walks and 48 strikeouts in his 10 previous appearances....last faced Chichgo-AL on September 2, 2022 at Guaranteed Rate Field...did not factor into the decision after pitching only 4.0 innings, surrendering two runs, five hits, one walk and striking out two batters.

Ф Made one relief appearance against the White Sox on August 7, 2018 where he pitched the final 3.0 innings of a 13-inning game as a Yankee...allowed only one hit, issued one walk and fanned four batters...earned the win.
$\Phi$ Since becoming a Twin, Gray has a 9.39 ERA against the White Sox, the second highest agaisnt any team has faced trailing only the Red Sox (10.80)

HOME SWEET HOME: After his home debut, Gray is 0-0, 1.29 ERA ( $7.0 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with one walk and 13 strikeouts....his at home ERA is ranked eighth in the American League (minimum 7.0 IP)...Gray went 4-2, 2.66 ERA ( 67.2 IP, 20 ER) with 25 walks and 78 strikeouts in 13 starts at Target Field...is now 50-38, 3.82 ERA ( 735.1 IP, 312 ER) with 248 walks and 714 strikeouts in his career at home.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: So far this season, Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to lefties...in his first two starts, Gray has held righties to .130/.161/.200 (4-for-30) with 13 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are slashing .250/.438/.333 with just one strikeout.
$\Phi$ In his career, Gray owns a 237 opponent batting average (628-for-2654) with 674 strikeouts against right-handed hitters and a .222 batting average ( 571 -for-2569) with 678 strikeouts against left-handed hitters
玉 Since 2019, is holding left-handed hitters to a . 202 (172-for-851) batting average, is now third among major league right-handed pitchers ( $\min .750 \mathrm{AB}$ ) in that span, trailing Gerrit Cole (.190) and Zac Gallen (.198).
