THE TWINS: Have gone 2-1 through three games on their seven-game, eight-day roadtrip, winning the first and second games in Yankee Stadium, followed by a loss yesterday...this afternoon they will play the four-game series finale in New York...the Twins will travel to Boston tomorrow afternoon during the off-day, then play the Red Sox for three games at Fenway Park from Tuesday-Thursday.

AFTERNOON BUMMER IN THE BRONX: The Twins lost to the Yankees yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-1 in game three of four at Yankee Stadium...Tyler Mahle (1-2) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs (2 earned) on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts, including home runs by Kyle Higashioka and Anthony Rizzo...the offense recorded just five hits, two going for extra bases as the Twins got back-to-back doubles from Trevor Larnach and Jose Miranda in the seventh, proving to be the only run for the Twins.

USE YOUR HEAD: The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick from Triple-A St. Paul...Headrick, 25, has appeared in two games (1 start) for the Saints this season, allowing six runs on 12 hits in 9.0 innings pitched, with two walks and 12 strikeouts...the 6-foot-6, 238-pound lefty has pitched in parts of four minor league seasons in the Twins organization, going 13-10, 3.52 ERA (184.0 IP, 72 ER), 67 walks, 238 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP and a 11.6 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio in 46 games (41 starts)...the Braidwood, Illinois native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Illinois State University...to make room for Headrick on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to Triple-A St. Paul...Varland made the start for the Twins on Friday night at Yankee Stadium and took a no-decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and eight strikeouts in a Twins 4-3 victory.

NOTE: Since 2019, Baldelli ranks fourth in the AL in wins, trailing NYY's Aaron Boone (336), TB's Kevin Cash (335) and CLE's Terry Francona (309).

99 PROBLEMS: Since 2002, the Twins have gone 40-99 against the Yankees in regular season play...since the start of 2017, they are 4-17 in regular season games at Yankee Stadium.

☞ The Twins and Yankees are playing the fourth of seven scheduled games in 2023...after this four-game series, the Twins will host the Yankees for three games from April 24-26 at Target Field.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .314 (48-for-153) with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 33 RBI, 17 walks, a .380 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS in 40 career regular season games against the Yankees...he has homered in four of his last five games at Yankee Stadium...Correa is 6-for-10 with one double and two home runs in his career against his former Astros teammate, Gerrit Cole.

☞ Jose Miranda is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with three doubles, one home run, eight RBI, two walks and an .898 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Yankees.

COLE HARD FACTS: Last season, the Twins faced Gerrit Cole twice, scoring eight runs on 13 hits in 9.0 innings pitched, including six home runs...he beat the Twins on September 7 at Yankee Stadium, allowing one run on five hits in 6.2 innings pitched with 14 strikeouts...in his first start against Minnesota on June 9 at Target Field, he was tagged for seven runs on eight hits in 2.1 innings pitched, including five home runs...Luis Arraez, Byron Buxton (2), Carlos Correa and Trevor Larnach all homered off Cole...Arraez, Buxton and Correa led the game off with three consecutive homers, which marked the seventh time in baseball history for a team to begin a game with three consecutive homers...Twins still lost that game by a score of 10-7.

SERIES-LY?: The Twins are looking to win a series over the Yankees for the first time since taking two out of three September 10-12, 2018 at Target Field...their last series victory in NY came in a three-game series May 30-June 1, 2014 (2-1)...Twins have won a four-game series over the Yankees just five times since 1961: September 2-4, 1966 in MN; July 3-5, 1967 in MN (sweep); May 23-25, 1969 in NY; July 5-8, 1984 in MN; and June 21-24, 1991 in NY.

☞ Twins are seeking their fourth series win of the season...they have gone 3-1 through their first four series, going 3-0 at Kansas City (3/30-4/2), 1-2 at Miami (4/3-5), 2-1 vs. Houston at Target Field (4/7-9) and 2-1 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field (4/10-12).

DAY MEN, FIGHTERS OF THE NIGHT MEN: The Twins are playing their 11th day game today...10 day games are tied with Chicago-AL, New York-NL and San Francisco for the most in baseball...they have gone 6-4 in day games, tied with Boston and New York-AL for third-most day wins in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (7-1) and New York-NL (7-3).

☞ Notables hitters in day games this season: Christian Vázquez is 8-for-19 (.421), Donovan Solano is 10-for-28 (.357), Ryan Jeffers is 5-for-14 (.357), Byron Buxton is 12-for-40 (.300).

TENACIOUS D: Donovan Solano has hit safely in 10-straight games, the longest for a Twin this season...the streak is tied for third-longest active streak in baseball (Bryson Stott the leader at 15)...his career-high is 17, done with San Francisco from July 25-August 15, 2020...during his current stretch, he is hitting .368 (14-for-38) with two walks, a .415 on-base percentage and an .888 OPS in that span.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Manager Rocco Baldelli played 30 career games in New York, hitting .292 (33-for-113)...he played in just three career games at new Yankee Stadium, going 2-for-5 with one RBI...at old Yankee Stadium, he played 27 games and hit .287 (31-for-108) with seven doubles, one triple, five home runs and 15 RBI with an .809 OPS...Rocco's first career road game was played at old Yankee Stadium on April 12, 2003, going 3-for-4 with two doubles, two runs scored and one RBI.

LAST TIME OUT: López did not factor into the decision against the Chicago White Sox on April 11 at Target Field...pitched 7.2 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts...after the first four batters reached base in the first inning, López retired the final 23 batters he faced in order...recorded 10 strikeouts for the third time in his career and was one short of his career high of 11, done twice in the 2022 season...opposed right-hander Lance Lynn, who also took a no-decision...Twins won 4-3 in 10 innings to take the second game of the series.

- ⚔ *Per Elias*, the 23 batters sent down in succession are the third most in Twins history, trailing Scott Baker (24 - 8/31/2007 vs. Kansas City) and Jack Kralick (25 - 8/26/1962 vs. Kansas City).
- ⚔ Threw 31 pitches in the first inning, then only needed 67 pitches to complete the next 6.2 innings (eight pitches in the second inning, 11 in the third, seven in the fourth, nine in the fifth, 12 in the sixth, 11 in the seventh and nine in the eighth).

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced the Miami Marlins, his former team, for the first time in his career...in a no-decision, pitched 7.0 innings and allowed one run and three hits with one walk and eight strikeouts in a Twins 5-2 defeat April 5 at loanDepot Park...pitched opposite of Jesús Luzardo, who also did not factor into the decision...allowed a solo home run to Jorge Soler in the bottom of the first inning, then retired 19 of the next 21 hitters he faced to complete his outing...left with game tied 1-1; Twins lost 5-2, falling in the final two games of a three-game set in Miami.

VS. THE YANKEES: López is facing New York-AL for the second time in his career...last faced the Yankees with Miami on August 21, 2018, going 6.0 innings and allowing one earned run and seven hits with one walk and four strikeouts in a no-decision...the Marlins fell 2-1 in 12 innings...López has made eight career starts against American League East opponents, going 2-3, 3.07 ERA (44.0 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 49 strikeouts.

BRONX DEBUT: Today is López's first career start at Yankee Stadium...pitching in a new ballpark for the third time this year (March 30 - Kauffman Stadium, April 11 - Target Field) and 23rd time in his career...in his previous 22 starts at new ballparks, López has gone 10-4, 3.57 ERA (123.2 IP, 49 ER) with 32 walks and 127 strikeouts...López is 15-16, 4.34 ERA (238.1 IP, 115 ER) with 67 walks and 237 strikeouts in 46 road starts, while he is 14-15, 3.43 ERA (292.2 IP, 111 ER) with 80 walks and 278 strikeouts in 51 career home starts.

ALL RIGHT: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .111 (5-for-45) batting average this season...his 19 strikeouts against righties lead the American League and are second in MLB, behind Cincinnati's Nick Lodolo (20)...left-handed hitters are batting .150 (3-for-20) with four walks and seven strikeouts vs. López this year...over his career, López has enjoyed more success against right-handed hitters (.646 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.743 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: López has used a five-pitch mix in his first three starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...threw 29 changeups in his last start April 11 vs. Chicago-AL and recorded four strikeouts with the pitch after throwing 28 changeups and recording five strikeouts with it in his first two starts combined...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:
