THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their seven-game, eight-day roadtrip...they won the first two in Yankee Stadium on Thursday and Friday, followed by three consecutive losses from Saturday through last night, two in New York and one in Boston...tonight the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three against the Red Sox at Fenway Park...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis to begin a 10-game homestand with three games against the Nationals (April 21-23), three games against the Yankees (April 24-26) and four games against the Royals (April 27-30).

WEIRD GAME ENDS IN 10-INNING LOSS FOR TWINS: The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings, making them 2-1 in extras this season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and seven strikeouts...the Twins took a two-run lead in the top of the 10th but Jovani Moran allowed three runs to score in the bottom half on three hits and one walk...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by a Max Kepler home run in the seventh inning, his second of the season...Christian Vázquez made his return to Fenway, going 1-for-4 with a single and two strikeouts...the three hour and seven minute game marked the longest for the Twins this season.

GALLANT RETURN: The Twins have returned outfielder Joey Gallo from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Gallo has missed the Twins' last 10 games with a right intercostal strain, an injury he sustained on April 7 vs. Houston...he played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 2-for-12 with one double...Gallo has hit .278 (5-for-18) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI, four runs scored and a 1.183 OPS in seven games for the Twins this season...to make room for Gallo on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Kyle Garlick to Triple-A St. Paul...Garlick played in two games for the Twins, going 1-for-7 with a home run and one RBI.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins have lost two straight to the Red Sox, dating back to August of 2022, but have gone 3-2 in their last five against Boston...after this series, the Twins will host the Sox for four games at Target Field from June 19-22.

Twins are looking to avoid losing a series to the Red Sox for the first time since dropping a three-game series at Fenway from August 24-26, 2021.

Carlos Correa is hitting .316 (54-for-171) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 36 runs scored, 33 walks, a .424 on-base percentage, a .538 slugging percentage and a .962 OPS in 46 career regular season games against the Red Sox...he is hitting .315 (29-for-92) with seven home runs and a .987 OPS in 24 career games at Fenway.

ROC MILESTONES: New England area native Rocco Baldelli needs two wins to reach 300 managerial victories in his career...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

MAX POWER: Max Kepler has homered twice in his last four games...each of his last four home runs have been hit on the road (dating back to June of 2022)...Kepler has one career home run off Corey Kluber, which came on August 31, 2016 at Progressive Field...he hit his 131st career home run last night, moving within one of tying Jacque Jones for 14th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

NOTE: Kepler has one leadoff home run this season, coming on April 3 at Miami, off Johnny Cueto...he has 14 leadoff homers in his career, tied with Chuck Knoblauch for fourth-most in club history, trailing Brian Dozier (28) and Jacque Jones (20).

CARLOS ACROSS AMERICA: In his last 36 road games, dating back to August 13, 2022, Carlos Correa is hitting .309 (42-for-136) with six doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 16 walks, a .378 on-base percentage and an .886 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for eighth in the AL in batting average, ninth in on-base percentage and 10th in OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances). Correa's first-inning single last night was the hardest hit ball for a Twin this season, with a 113.9 mph exit velocity.

PEN STILL MIGHTY: The Twins bullpen has combined to go 3-2, 2.75 ERA (52.1 IP, 16 ER) with 15 walks, 56 strikeouts, a .197 opponent batting average and a .590 opponent OPS...they rank third among all bullpens in baseball in ERA, and fourth in opponent batting average and OPS. The Twins' bullpen has averaged 90.1 mph, the fourth-highest average pitch velocity in the AL and seventh-highest in baseball...they have an average fastball velocity of 94.7 mph, fourth-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball. After ranking third in baseball in innings pitched in 2022 (654.1), they have pitched the fewest innings in 2023 (52.1).

WELL PLAYED, MAUER: Joe Mauer is celebrating his 40th birthday today...Mauer shares a birthday with actor James Franco, actress Kate Hudson, former NFL star/former Head and Shoulders commercial co-star Troy Polamalu and tennis player Maria Sharapova. Other former Twins celebrating birthdays: Frank Viola (63), Joe Beimel (46), Dennys Reyes (46) and Zach Duke (40).

☞ Has won a career-best six consecutive decisions, since September 13, 2022; is 6-0, 1.85 ERA (43.2 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks, 53 strikeouts and a .140 opponent batting average in that seven-start span.
☞ Facing Boston for the third time in his career and second time at Fenway Park...1-1, 4.91 ERA (11.0 IP, 6 ER) with one walk and 15 strikeouts in two previous starts vs. Red Sox.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan improved to 3-0 on the year and won his career-best sixth-consecutive decision on April 13 vs. the New York Yankees at Yankee Stadium...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits and one earned run with no walks and 10 strikeouts...took the mound with a 9-0 lead after the Twins plated nine runs in the top of the first inning against Yankees starter Jhonny Brito and reliever Colten Brewer...

TWO STARTS AGO: Ryan won his second-straight start to open the season on April 8 vs. the Houston Astros at Target Field, pitching 6.0 innings with four runs and three hits allowed, one walk and 10 strikeouts...his 10 strikeouts were the second-most in his career, one shy of his 11 strikeouts on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL...

WIN STREAK BY THE NUMBERS: In his last seven starts dating back to September 13, 2022, Ryan is 6-0, 1.85 ERA (43.2 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks and 53 strikeouts...opponents are slashing .140/.204/.220 against Ryan during the win streak, and his .424 opponent OPS is the second lowest in baseball in that stretch among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings pitched (Shohei Ohtani - .360)...

RYAN VS. THE RED SOX: In two career starts vs. Boston, both coming during the 2022 season, Ryan went 1-1, 4.91 ERA (11.0 IP, 6 ER) with one walk and 15 strikeouts...defeated the Red Sox in his only previous start at Fenway Park on April 15, 2022, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing only one run and five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins victory...

ROAD WARRIOR: Tonight is Ryan's third road start of 2023...won his first two road starts of the season April 2 at Kansas City and April 13 at New York-AL and is 4-1, 1.76 ERA (30.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 32 strikeouts and a .159 opponent batting average in his last five road starts dating back to September 7, 2022...

LEFT IS RIGHT: Left-handed hitters batted .182 (2-for-11) against Ryan in his last start April 13 at New York-AL and are hitting .103 (3-for-29) against him this year...right-handed hitters haven't fared much better, hitting .158 (6-for-38) with 18 strikeouts vs. Ryan in 2023...

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a three-pitch mix in his first three starts of the 2023 season...has used his four-seam fastball the most of his three pitches, throwing it 58.5 percent of the time...recorded strikeouts with each of his three pitches April 13 at New York-AL (four-seam fastball - 7, split finger - 2, sweeper - 1)...

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 0-2, 4.09 ERA // CAREER: 59-43, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Kenta Maeda is set to start the series finale against the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park tomorrow afternoon...last start was April 10 vs. the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, a 4-3 Twins loss...went 6.0 innings and took the loss, allowing four earned runs and eight hits with no walks and three strikeouts...

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
• In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
• Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
• Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
• Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz... learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
• In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
• In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
• Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, Baseball America High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
• Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
• Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
• Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams, including first team All-America honors by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.
