<b>THE TWINS:</b> Have gone 2-3 through five games on their seven-game, eight-day roadtripthey
won the first two in Yankee Stadium on Thursday and Friday, followed by three consecutive
losses from Saturday through last night, two in New York and one in Bostontonight the
Twins will continue the trip with the second of three against the Red Sox at Fenway Park
after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis to begin
a 10-game homestand with three games against the Nationals (April 21-23), three games
against the Yankees (April 24-26) and four games against the Royals (April 27-30).

**WEIRD GAME ENDS IN 10-INNING LOSS FOR TWINS:** The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings, making them 2-1 in extras this season... Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing just one run on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and seven strikeouts...the Twins took a two-run lead in the top of the 10th but Jovani Moran allowed three runs to score in the bottom half on three hits and one walk...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by a Max Kepler home run in the seventh inning, his second of the season...Christian Vázquez made his return to Fenway, going 1-for-4 with a single and two strikeouts...the three hour and seven minute game marked the longest for the Twins this season.

GALLANT RETURN: The Twins have returned outfielder Joey Gallo from his rehab assignment GALLANI RETURN: The Iwins have returned outfielder Joey Gallo from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Gallo has missed the Twins' last 10 games with a right intercostal strain, an injury he sustained on April 7 vs. Houston...he played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 2-for-12 with one double... Gallo has hit .278 (5-for-18) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI, four runs scored and a 1.183 OPS in seven games for the Twins this season...to make room for Gallo on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Kyle Garlick to Triple-A St. Paul...Garlick played in two games for the Twins, going 1-for-7 with a home run and one RBI.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins have lost two straight to the Red Sox, dating back to August of 2022, but have gone 3-2 in their last five against Boston...after this series, the Twins will host the Sox for four games at Target Field from June 19-22.

◆ Twins are looking to avoid losing a series to the Red Sox for the first time since dropping a three-game series at Fenway from August 24-26, 2021.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .316 (54-for-171) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 36 runs scored, 33 walks, a .424 on-base percentage, a .538 slugging percentage and a .962 OPS in 46 career regular season games against the Red Sox...he is hitting .315 (29-for-92) with seven home runs and a .987 OPS in 24 career games at Fenway.

CARLOS ACROSS AMERICA: In his last 36 road games, dating back to August 13, 2022, Carlos Correa is hitting .309 (42-for-136) with six doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 16 walks, a .378 on-base percentage and an .886 OPS...since that date, he ranks tied for eighth in the AL in batting average, ninth in on-base percentage and 10th in OPS (minimum 100 plate appearances).

© Correa's first-inning single last night was the hardest hit ball for a Twin this season, with a 113.9 mph exit velocity.

'PEN STILL MIGHTY: The Twins bullpen has combined to go 3-2, 2.75 ERA (52.1 IP, 16 ER) with 15 walks, 56 strikeouts, a .197 opponent batting average and a .590 opponent OPS...they rank third among all bullpens in baseball in ERA, and fourth in opponent batting average and OPS. 

The Twins' bullpen has averaged 90.1 mph, the fourth-highest average pitch velocity in the AL and seventh-highest in baseball... they have an average fastball velocity of 94.7 mph, fourth-best in the AL and sixth-best in baseball.

After ranking third in baseball in innings pitched in 2022 (654.1), they have pitched the fewest innings in 2023 (52.1).

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan improved to 3-0 on the year and won his career-best sixth-consecutive decision on April 13 vs. the New York Yankees at Yankee Stadium...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits and one earned run with no walks and 10 strikeouts...took the mound with a 9-0 lead after the Twins plated nine runs in the top of the first inning against Yankees starter Jhony Brito and reliever Colten Brewer...Ryan struck out outfielder Franchy Cordero in the third inning to record his 200th career strikeout, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history to record 200 strikeouts within his first 35 career games...his 10 strikeouts matched his previous start for the second most in his career...11 runs of support were the most of Ryan's career...Twins won 11-2 to take the series opener.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Ryan won his second-straight start to open the season on April 8 vs. the Houston Astros at Target Field, pitching 6.0 innings with four runs and three hits allowed, one walk and 10 strikeouts...his 10 strikeouts were the second-most in his career, one shy of his 11 strikeouts on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL...all four runs came in on designated hitter Yordan Alvarez's grand slam in the top of the third ining...opposed right-handed pitcher Luis Garcia, who did not factor into the decision...Ryan retired the last 11 batters he faced and exited after 6.0 complete innings, then the Twins broke a 4-4 tie with a run in the bottom of the sixth inning and went on to win 9-6, securing the series victory.

WIN STREAK BY THE NUMBERS: In his last seven starts dating back to September 13, 2022, Ryan is 6-0, 1.85 ERA (43.2 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks and 53 strikeouts...opponents are slashing .140/.204/.220 against Ryan during the win streak, and his .424 opponent OPS is the second lowest in baseball in that stretch among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings pitched (Shohei Ohtani - .360)...the span marks the longest win streak of Ryan's career and the longest win streak by a Twins starter since Michael Pineda went 8-0 in a 16-start stretch from July 21, 2019-April 15, 2021.

RYAN VS. THE RED SOX: In two career starts vs. Boston, both coming during the 2022 season, Ryan went 1-1, 4.91 ERA (11.0 IP, 6 ER) with one walk and 15 strikeouts... defeated the Red Sox in his only previous start at Fenway Park on April 15, 2022, tossing 6.0 innings and allowing only one run and five hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins victory...lost to Boston at Target Field August 31, 2022, allowing five runs and eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and eight strikeouts...is 2-2, 3.74 ERA (33.2 IP, 14 ER) with seven walks and 38 strikeouts in six career starts vs. American League Fast onponents vs. American League East opponents.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** Tonight is Ryan's third road start of 2023...won his first two road starts of the season April 2 at Kansas City and April 13 at New York-AL and is 4-1, 1.76 ERA (30.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 32 strikeouts and a .159 opponent batting average in his last five road starts dating back to September 7, 2022...in his career, Ryan has gone 10-4, 3.44 ERA (89.0 IP, 34 ER) with 21 walks and 92 strikeouts in 16 road starts...he has similar numbers at Target Field, going 8-5, 3.65 ERA (103.2 IP, 42 ER) with 34 walks and 115 strikeouts in 19 career starts at home.

**LEFT IS RIGHT**: Left-handed hitters batted .182 (2-for-11) against Ryan in his last start April 13 at New York-AL and are hitting .103 (3-for-29) against him this year...right-handed hitters haven't fared much better, hitting .158 (6-for-38) with 18 strikeouts vs. Ryan in 2023...over his career, Ryan has slightly better splits against left-handed hitters than righties, with lefties batting just .187 with a .616 OPS since his debut in 2021...right-handed hitters are hitting .208 with a .645 OPS off Ryan... his .133 opponent on-base percentage vs. lefties ranks third in baseball this season (min. 3 GS).

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a three-pitch mix in his first three starts of the 2023 season...has used his four-seam fastball the most of his three pitches, throwing it 58.5 percent of the time...recorded strikeouts with each of his three pitches April 13 at New York-AL (four-seam fastball - 7, split finger - 2, sweeper - 1)...opposing hitters are 0-for-21 against his two offspeed offerings this year..here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
