THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their seven-game, eight-day roadtrip, going 2-2 at Yankee Stadium over the weekend, followed by a 1-1 split of the first two games at Fenway Park this week...today, the Twins will complete the trip with the three-game series finale in Boston....after today's game, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis to begin a 10game homestand with three games against the Nationals over the weekend, followed by three games against the Yankees (April 24-26) and four games against the Royals (April 27-30). $\Phi$ Twins are seeking their second winning roadtrip this season, going 4-2 in their previous
trip to open the season (3-0 at KC and 1-2 at MIA).

TWINS BREAK OUT THE BATS IN BOSTON: The Twins beat the Red Sox last night at Fenway Park by a score of 10-4, evening this three-game series...Joe Ryan (4-0) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched... he joined Gerrit Cole and Shane McClanahan as the only pitchers in baseball with four wins...Brent Headrick made his major league debut, pitching 3.0 innings with one run allowed on one hit...the offense recorded nine hits as Edouard Julien went 3 -for-4 with his second home run...Joey Gallo made his return from the IL, hitting his team-leading fourth home run, a three-run jimmy jack in the third inning. $\Phi$ Headrick became the third pitcher in Twins history (since 1961) to earn a save in their debut, joining Micheal Nakamura ( $6 / 7 / 03$ ) and Steve Barber ( $4 / 9 / 70$ )...Headrick earned the trifecta ast night as manager Rocco Baldelli presented him with three game balls postgame: One for his debut, one for his first strikeout (Enmanuel Valdez) and one for the save.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Twins recorded nine hits last night, five going for extra-bases, while only striking out six times...since their 13-hit, nine-extra-base-hit and 11-run game to start this roadtrip (April 13 at NYY), they had just 4.5 hits-per-game, 2.3 runs-per-game and 48 strikeouts in four games until last night.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the third of seven games in 2023... after this series, the Twins will host the Sox for four games at Target Field from June 19-22... the Twins have won four of their last six games against the Sox, dating back to April 2022. runs scored, 33 walks, a . 414 on-base percentage, a .523 slugging percentage and a 937 OPS in 47 career regular season games against the Red Sox...he has a 940 OPS in 25 career regular season games at Fenway Park.

CALL THE FIRE DEPARTMENT: The Twins bullpen has combined to go 3-2, 2.77 ERA ( $55.1 \mathrm{IP}, 17$ ER) with 17 walks, 59 strikeouts, a 193 opponent batting average and a .579 opponent OPS...they rank fifth among all bullpens in baseball in ERA, and third in opponent batting average and OPS.
$\Phi$ The Twins' bullpen has averaged 88.9 mph , the fifth-highest average pitch velocity in the AL and eighth-highest in baseball.
SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the fourth series win of the season for the Twins...the Twins have gone 3-1-1 through their first five series this season, going 3-0 at Kansas City from March 30-April 2, 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 2-1 vs. Houston at Target Field from April 7-9. 2-1 vs. Chicago-AL from April 10-12 and 2-2 at New York-AL from April 13-16.
$\Phi$ Twins are looking to win their second-straight series against the Red Sox after taking two of three at Target Field from August 29-31, 2022...they are looking for their first series win in Fenway since taking two of three from September 3-5, 2019.

BACK STOP, WON'T STOP: Christian Vázquez is slashing .325/400/.400 with an 800 OPS in 13 games... he has reached base safely in 10 of 13 games played...among all catchers in baseball, he ranks tied for first in batting average, fitth in on-base percentage and 10th in OPS. क He has a catcher ERA of 2.26, which ranks second best in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay's Francisco Mejía (1.82).
ANALYST ANALYSIS: Notes on Bally Sports North analysts LaTroy Hawkins and Glen Perkins in their careers at Fenway Park:
क Hawkins pitched in 15 career games at Fenway.... his first career game in this ballpark came on May 6, 1998 as the Twins won 8-7. Hawk earned the victory, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and one strikeout...it marked his fifth career road win...Paul Molitor, David Oritz and Torii Hunter were all in the lineup for the Twins that day.
$\Phi$ Perkins made his major league debut at Fenway on September 21, 2006, pitching 1.1 scoreless innings with no hits allowed, no walks and one strikeout in a Twins $6-0$ defeat... 10 of Perk's 11 career appearances here were scoreless, while he struck out 16 batters in 11.2 innings.
I'M JUST GLADD TO BE HERE: Twins Radio stallion Dan Gladden played in 32 career games at Fenway Park and was simply dominant, hitting . 326 ( 45 -for-138) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, 14 RBI, 23 runs scored and seven stolen bases ( 8 attempts). he had 15 career multi-hit games in this ballpark, including a 4-for-5 effort on July 20, 1988 , which included one walk in a game that was started by Roger Clemens...Gladden's . 326 batting average in Boston was his highest of any ballpark (minimum 100 at-bats).
FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: Tomorrow night's 7:10 pm (CT) game against the Nationals will be televised on WTFC Fox 9+/DirecTV/Mediacom/ Midco Sports/DirecTV Stream/Fubo...the scheduling conflict is due to both the Minnesota Timberwolves and Minnesota Wild playoff games.

LAST START: Was dealt the loss in his 2023 Target Field debut against Chicago-AL on April 10 in a 4-3 Twins loss, opposite Dylan Cease...first time pitching at Target Field since August 14, 2021.. pitched 6.0 innings, allowed four runs on eight hits with just three strikeouts...the last time Maeda struck out three batters was also against Chicago-AL on May 11, 2021...gave up a three-run home run to Hanser Alberto in the fourth after retiring 10 of the first 12 batters he faced...is now 2-2, 5.58 ERA ( 30.2 IP, 19 ER ), with nine walks and 27 strikeouts in six starts against Chicago-AL in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt the loss in his return from Tommy John surgery against Miami on April 4 in a 1-0 Twins loss, opposite Sandy Alcantara...first major league start since August 21, 2021 at New York-AL, a span of 591 days...allowed just one run on three hits over 5.0 innings of work...his Ione blemish of the game was a home run in the second inning to Avisail García...struck out nine batters; the last time Maeda struck out nine batters was August 3, 2021 against Cincinnati...is now 1-3, 2.20 ERA ( 32.2 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and 34 strikeouts against Miami in his career...left the game in the sixth inning withwith Twins Head Athletic Trainer Nick Paparesta due to fatigue.
AGAINST BOSTON: Maeda is facing the Red Sox for the third time in his career...last faced Boston on April 14, 2021 in the first game of a doubleheader at Target Field...took the loss in 3-2 Twins defeat after pitching 4.1 innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on seven hits, walking two batters and fanning five...his last start at Fenway Park was on July 12, 2019 as a Dodger...took the loss after pitching 5.2 innings, allowing three runs on four hits, issuing one walk and striking aout seven batters in a 8-1 Dodgers loss.
$\Phi$ Has three Postseason relief appearances against the Red Sox in his career from the 2018 World Series...pitched in games two, three and four with a 3.00 ERA (3.0 IP, 1 ER), two walks and six strikeouts...faced three batters in the seventh inning of game two, pitched in the 15th and 16th innings of the 18 -inning game three, and pitched in ninth inning in game four where he allowed four runs on two hits, only one run was charged to Maeda.

BACK ON THE ROAD: After his first start of the 2023 season, Maeda is $0-1,1.80$ ERA (5.0 IP, 1 ER) with nine strikeouts...batters are slashing .167/.167/.333 on the road against Maeda compared to .308/.308/.500 at home...in the 2021 season, Maeda pitched two-thirds of his games on the road... he went 4-3, 6.06 ERA ( 68.1 IP, 46 ER) with 22 walks and 76 strikeouts in 14 starts on the road... is 7-5, 5.05 ERA (107.0 IP 60 ER ) with 26 walks and 123 strikeouts on the road since becoming a Twin...is ranked 11th in highest strikeouts-per-9.0 innings in road games in the American League since 2020 at 10.35 ( min 100.0 IP )...has enjoyed more success at home over his career with batters slashing .210/.267/.343 in home games versus .240/.304/.424 during road games.

THE RIGHT STUFF: After his first two starts, Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters, holding righties to a .214/.214/.464 slash line with nine strikeouts compared to left-handed hitters who are slashing $.313 / .313 / .375$ with three strikeouts.
$\Phi$ Historically Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters, with righties only batting $.204 / .252 / .350$ with 303 hits against Maeda, as opposed to left-handed batters slashing 251. $321 / .4223$ with 354 hits...ranks second in opponent batting average vs. righties since 2016 (min 750.0 IP), trailing only Max Scherzer (.177).

THE ARSENAL: In two starts this season, Maeda used a five-pitch mix, favoring his slider....he used the slider mostly against righties for seven strikeouts, alongside his fastball for three strikeouts...hs used his sinker exclusively against righties and has only used his curveball against lefties...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:
