LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss at New York-AL on April 16 in a 2-0 Twins defeat...went 6.0 innings, allowed two runs and seven hits, walked one and struck out seven batters...pitched opposite of Gerrit Cole, who tossed a complete-game shutout...infielder DJ LeMahieu had both RBI against López, producing a run-scoring single in the third inning and hitting a solo home run in the sixth...the 340-foot home run was the second shortest over-the-fence home run against López in his career, according to Statcast (Harold Ramirez - 337 feet on May 24, 2022)...López eclipsed 100 pitches for the first time since September 20, 2022 vs. Chicago-NL (105 pitches) and became the first Twins pitcher to throw over 100 pitches in an April game since Kyle Gibson on April 28, 2019 vs. Baltimore (105 pitches).

TWO STARTS AGO: López did not factor into the decision against the Chicago White Sox on April 11 at Target Field...pitched 7.2 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts...after the first four batters reached base in the first inning, retired the final 23 batters he faced in order...recorded 10 strikeouts for the third time in his career and was one short of his career high of 11, done twice in the 2022 season...opposed right-hander Lance Lynn, who also took a no-decision...Twins won 4-3 in 10 innings to take the second game of the series.

⚔ **Per Elias, the 23 batters sent down in succession was the third-longest single-game stretch by a pitcher in Twins history (1961-present),** trailing Scott Baker (24 - 8/31/2007 vs. Kansas City) and Jack Kralick (25 - 8/26/1962 vs. Kansas City).

A HAPPY PABLO DAY, INDEED: Yesterday, the Twins announced that they signed López to a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season...in his first four starts with Minnesota this year, López notched his 500th career strikeout (April 5 at Miami), recorded his third career 10-plus strikeout game (April 11 vs. Chicago-AL) and set the record for the most strikeouts within the first four career games in a Twins uniform (33)...López currently ranks fourth in strikeouts and ninth in ERA among MLB pitchers with at least four games started in 2023.

NATIONAL NEWS: In 12 career starts against Washington, López is 4-2, 4.57 ERA (61.0 IP, 31 ER) with 24 walks and 43 strikeouts...all 12 starts were with Miami...in his last start vs. the Nationals on July 3, 2022, López went 6.1 innings, allowed two runs on three hits, issued three walks and struck out five batters in a no-decision...the Marlins beat Washington 7-4...Miami won six of López's last eight starts against the Nats dating back to September 22, 2019...López is 4-0, 2.09 ERA (38.2 IP, 9 ER) with 34 strikeouts in his last seven starts vs. Washington, dating back to August of 2020...his last win was on April 27, 2022 at Nationals Park.

HOME COOKING: Today is López's second home start of the year and second career start at Target Field...in his last three home starts since September 15, 2022, López is 1-0, 2.14 ERA (21.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .164 opponent batting average...his 10.50 strikeouts-per-walk ratio at home is fourth best in baseball during that stretch (min. 20.0 IP)...over his career, López is 14-15, 3.43 ERA (291.2 IP, 111 ER) with 80 walks and 278 strikeouts in 51 home starts...in 47 road starts, he is 15-17, 4.31 ERA (244.1 IP, 117 ER) with 68 walks and 244 strikeouts.

LEFT, RIGHT, DON'T MATTER: López has limited left-handed hitters to a .161 (5-for-31) batting average this season...right-handed hitters have not fared much better, batting at a .169 (10-for-59) clip...his 22 strikeouts against righties are tied for third most in the American League...over his career, López has enjoyed more success against right-handed hitters (.650 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.740 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: López has used a five-pitch mix in his first four starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...opposing batters are hitting .087 (4-for-46) against López's offspeed offerings this year with 23 strikeouts...threw 13 curveballs against New York-AL on April 16 for a 12.6 percent usage rate, the most he has used the pitch in a start this season...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

- Signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota on April 21, 2023.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Recipient of 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, which is voted on by the Miami chapter of the BBWAA to recognize a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
- Spent 2017 season at High-A level in Seattle and Miami organizations.
- Went 6-1, 1.88 ERA (71.2 IP, 15 ER) in 17 appearances (13 starts) for Low-A Clinton (Seattle) in 2016.
