THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game, eight-day roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Yankee Stadium and 1-2 at Fenway Park), the Twins began their 10-game homestand with a 2-1 series loss to the Nationals over the weekend...

OBBER AND THE BOYS RALLY FOR ROCCO: The Twins beat the Nationals yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-1, earning Rocco Baldelli his 300th career managerial victory...

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins have gone 2-2 against the Yankees this season, splitting a four-game series to start the last roadtrip, from April 13-16...

Since 2002, the Twins have gone 40-100 against the Yankees in regular season play. Carlos Correa is hitting .306 (48-for-157) with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 33 RBI, 17 walks, a .371 on-base percentage, a .611 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS in 41 career regular season games against the Yankees.

SINCE WE LAST SPOKE: Since the two wins in Yankee Stadium on April 13 and 14, the Twins have hit just .207 with 3.6 runs-per-game...below are their offensive comparisons from the first 14 games and the last eight games:

BRI-PEAT?: The Twins faced Jhony Brito in game one of the four-game series at Yankee Stadium on April 13, scoring nine runs in the first inning and chasing Brito after 0.2 innings...

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all three games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .385 (5-for-13) with a 1.077 OPS...

DO YOU EVEN LIFT, JOE?: Joey Gallo did not appear against the Yankees during the four-game series at Yankee Stadium (IL - right intercostal strain)...Gallo played parts of two seasons in New York, hitting .159 (67-for-421) with 25 home runs, 46 RBI, 77 walks and 194 strikeouts in 140 games...

BUCK TRUCK GETS A TUNE-UP: After an 0-for-15 stretch from April 13-18, Byron Buxton has hit safely in four straight, hitting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, one home run, three runs scored, two walks and just four strikeouts in that span with a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.014 OPS.

MUST BE TWINS: Twins utility player Willi Castro and left-handed reliever Jovani Moran are both celebrating their 26th birthdays today... Castro has appeared in one major league game on his birthday going 1-for-3 with a home run in 2021 against the Royals...

- Making his 252nd career appearance, 243rd career start.
- Making fifth start of the year, third at home...is 5-2, 2.37 ERA (79.2 IP, 21 ER) with 28 walks and 96 strikeouts in 15 starts at Target Field with the Twins.
- Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in the series opener against the Red Sox on April 18 at Fenway park, opposite Chris Sale...pitched 5.0 innings, allowed one run on seven hits, walked two batters and fanned seven...his seven hits were the most Gray has allowed since August 8, 2022 vs Los Angeles-NL when he also allowed seven hits...the lone run came from an RBI single to Rafael Devers in the first inning...relieved by Jorge López in the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 5.0 innings...Griffin Jax allowed one run in the eighth...Jovani Moran entered in the 10th inning and took the Twins 4-3 loss after a walkoff RBI single by Alex Verdugo.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was the winner in the rubber match against the Chicago White Sox on April 12 at Target Field, opposite Lucas Giolito...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits, two walks issued and five strikeouts...relieved by Jorge Alcalá to start the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.2 scoreless innings until Jhoan Duran gave up a solo home run to Lenyn Sosa in the ninth inning...Twins won 3-1, securing the series victory to finish the homestand.

AGAINST NEW YORK-AL: Gray is facing the Yankee for the seventh time in his career, going 1-2, 4.04 ERA (35.2 IP, 16 ER) with 14 walks and 33 strikeouts in his six previous appearances...last faced New York-AL on September 8, 2022 at Yankee Stadium...did not factor into the decision despite a quality start, after pitching 6.0 innings, surrendering one run, six hits, one walk and striking seven batters...relieved by Griffin Jax as the bullpen allowed one run over three innings...the lone blemish came from Jorge López who gave up a solo home run to Miguel Andújar in the eighth...the Twins went on to win 4-3 after a two-run eighth-inning homer from Carlos Correa.

- Gray pitched parts of two seasons with the Yankees, going 15-16, 4.51 ERA (195.2 IP, 98 ER), with 84 walks and 182 strikeouts in 41 games (34 starts)...he was originally acquired by the Yankees in a trade with Oakland on July 31, 2017, in exchange for Dustin Fowler, James Kaprielian and Jorge Mateo...he was dealt by the Yankees to the Reds on January 21, 2019, with Reiver Sanmartin, in exchange for Shed Long Jr. and a competitive balance round A pick.
- Has not pitched against the Yankees in a home game since June 15, 2017 as a member of Oakland...pitched 5.1 innings, allowed three runs on eight hits, walked three batters and struck out six...is 1-2, 4.76 ERA (22.2 IP, 12 ER) with 10 walk and 21 strikeouts in home games against the Yankees in his career.
- Earned his last win against the Yankees on July 7, 2015.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: After his first two home starts of the year, Gray is 1-0, 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and 18 strikeouts...Gray went 4-2, 2.66 ERA (67.2 IP, 20 ER) with 25 walks and 78 strikeouts in 13 starts at home in 2022...is now 51-39, 3.79 ERA 740.1 IP, 312 R with 250 walks and 719 strikeouts in his career at home, including 5-2, 2.37 ERA (79.2 IP, 21 ER) in 15 starts at Target Field (Twins are 10-5 in those games).

Among American League pitchers, Gray is ranked fourth in home ERA, trailing Shohei Ohtani (0.00), Gerrit Cole (0.33) and Jeffrey Springs (0.56)...tied with Jeffrey Springs for second in home strikeouts-per-nine (13.50), just behind Jacob DeGrom (15.09)...tied for sixth in opponent batting average (.197)...his .460 opponent OPS ranks fifth (min. 10.0 IP).

THE RIGHT WAY: So far this season, Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to lefties...in his four starts, Gray has held righties to .177/.222/.255 (9-for-51) with 22 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are slashing .258/.378/.355 with just four strikeouts.

- Tied for sixth among American League pitchers in opponent batting average against righties...is tied for eighth in all of baseball with JP Sears in strikeouts versus righties (min. 20.0 IP).
- However, since 2019, is holding left-handed hitters to a .203 (177-for-870) batting average, ranking fourth among major league right-handed pitchers (min. 750 AB) in that span, trailing Gerrit Cole (.188), Zac Gallen (.194) and Lucas Giolito (.201).

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...continues to use his curveball the most at 26.3 percent...after throwing 24 fastballs in his last start, his fastball has become his second most used pitch at 17.6 percent...continues to exclusively use the slider against righties and has only used his changeup against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

Right-hander Joe Ryan is scheduled to pitch in the second game of the three-game series against the New York Yankees on Tuesday...earned the 10-4 win in his last start on April 19 against the Boston Red Sox at Fenway Park; allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR) with one walk and three strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work...faced New York-AL on April 13 at Yankee Stadium, an 11-2 Twins win...pitched 7.0 innings, surrendered one run on three hits and struck out 10 batters...marked the first time in his career with double digit strikeouts in back-to-back games...is 1-1, 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in two career starts against New York-AL.

- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.
