THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game, eight-day roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (2-2 at Yankee Stadium and 1-2 at Fenway Park), the Twins began their 10-game homestand with a 2-1 series loss to the Nationals over the weekend...tonight the Twins will continue the homestand with the first of three against the Yankees...after this series, the Twins will host the Royals for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 5-4 at Target Field and 7-6 on the road...Twins have gone just 2-6 in their last eight after starting the season 10-4 in their first 14.

OBER AND THE BOYS RALLY FOR ROCCO: The Twins beat the Nationals yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-1, earning Rocco Baldelli his 300th career managerial victory...Bailey Ober (1-0) made his 2023 debut, allowing one run on three hits in 5.2 innings pitched...Caleb Thielbar (1.1 IP) and Jorge López (1.0 IP) each recorded a hold, while Jhoan Duran (1.0 IP) earned his fifth save...the offense recorded nine hits, highlighted by Jorge Polanco, who went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI...Ryan Jeffers and Jose Miranda each had two hits and Michael A. Taylor hit his fourth home run of the season, a 444-foot shot, the fourth longest of his career and longest for a Twin this season...the game was played in 2:13, the fifth-fastest game for the Twins this season.

TWINS AND YANKEES: The Twins have gone 2-2 against the Yankees this season, splitting a four-game series to start the last roadtrip, from April 13-16...the Twins outscored the Yankees 15-5 in the first two games, then were outscored 1-8 in games three and four.

The last time the Twins hosted the Yankees was from June 7-9, 2022, winning the middle game of the three-game series.

Since 2002, the Twins have gone 40-100 against the Yankees in regular season play.

Carlos Correa is hitting. 306 (48-for-157) with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 33 RBI, 17 walks, a 371 on-base percentage, a 611 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS in 41 career regular season games against the Yankees.

Jose Miranda is hitting. 325 (13-for-40) with three doubles, one home run, eight RBI, two walks and an .832 OPS in 11 career games vs. the Yankees.

Jorge Polanco is hitting. 333 (18-for-54) with three doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI and a 1.151 OPS in his last 13 games against the Yankees...he has homered in three of his last five vs. New York.

Tonight's starter. Sonny Gray, pitched parts of two seasons with the Yankees, going 15-16, 4.51 ERA (195.2 IP, 98 ER), with 84 walks and 182 strikeouts in 41 games (34 starts)... he was originally acquired by the Yankees in a trade with Oakland on July 31, 2017, in exchange for Dustin Fowler, James Kaprielian and Jorge Mateo...he was dealt by the Yankees to the Reds on January 21, 2019, with Reiver Sanmartin, in exchange for Shed Long Jr. and a competitive balance round A pick.

SINCE WE LAST SPOKE: Since the two wins in Yankee Stadium on April 13 and 14, the Twins have hit just .207 with 3.6 runs-per-game...below are their offensive comparisons from the first 14 games and the last eight games:

POLO ON THE MARK: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all three games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .385 (5-for-13) with a 1.077 OPS...yesterday afternoon, he hit his 99th career home run...below are the Twins to reach 100 (since 1961):

DO YOU EVEN LIFT, JOE?: Joey Gallo did not appear against the Yankees during the four-game series at Yankee Stadium (IL - right intercostal strain)...Gallo played parts of two seasons in New York, hitting .159 (67-for-421) with 25 home runs, 46 RBI, 77 walks and 194 strikeouts in 140 games...ne hit his fifth home run of the season on Friday night and now has an atbat-per-home run ratio of 6.80, second highest in baseball (minimum 30 plate appearances), trailing Max Muncy (6.45)...despite missing 10 games (right intercostal strain — April 11-19), he still leads the club in homers and ranks tied for 10th in the American League.

◆ He leads baseball in average exit velocity at 100.3 mph (minimum 30 PA)...additionally, he ranks fifth in baseball in average distance of balls put in play at 237 feet.
