BROCK STEADY: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart from Triple-A St. Paul. Stewart, 31, has appeared in seven games for the Saints this season...

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins have gone 3-2 against the Yankees this season... a win tonight would secure the season series for Minnesota...

POLO ON THE MARCO: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all four games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and a 1.056 OPS...

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the fourth series win of the season for the Twins... the Twins have gone 3-3-1 through their first seven series this season...

RYAN KING: Ryan's last start against the Yankees came in game one on April 13 in the opener of a four-game series at Yankee Stadium... Ryan allowed one run on three hits in 7.0 innings pitched...

JOEY JACKS: Joey Gallo hit his sixth home run of the season last night and now has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 6.45, the highest in baseball (minimum 40 plate appearances)...

LONELY FOR LEFTIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for just the fifth time this season, the previous four being Jesús Luzardo on April 5 at Miami (5-2 loss), Nestor Cortes on April 14 at New York-AL (4-3 win)...

- ☞ Making his fifth start and appearance of 2023 and his second start at Target Field this year...also his 37th career start and appearance.
- ☞ Has won a career-best seven consecutive decisions, since September 13, 2022; is 7-0, 2.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks, 56 strikeouts and a .156 opponent batting average in that eight-start span.
- ☞ Facing New York-AL for the second time this year and the third time in his career...is 1-1, 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in two career starts vs. the Yankees.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan extended his career-long winning streak to seven games, earning the victory in the Twins 10-4 win at the Boston Red Sox on April 19...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, issuing one walk with three strikeouts...allowed one run in the third, fifth and sixth innings, including a solo home run to infielder Kiké Hernández in the sixth...opposed right-hander Corey Kluber, who took the loss...10 runs of support were the second most of Ryan's career, trailing only his last start on April 13 at New York-AL (11)...his three strikeouts ties six other starts for the second fewest in his career and is the lowest total in his 15 career quality starts.

- ☞ With the win, became the 10th pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to win his first four starts of the year and the first since Brad Radke went 4-0 from April 3-20, 2001...with a win tonight, would become fifth pitcher in franchise history to go 5-0 in his first five starts of a season and first since Jerry Koosman in 1979.
- ☞ Ryan's four wins this year are tied for first in baseball with New York-AL's Gerrit Cole, Baltimore's Kyle Gibson, Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw and Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber.

TWO STARTS AGO: Improved to 3-0 on the year and won his career-best sixth-consecutive decision on April 13 vs. the New York Yankees at Yankee Stadium...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits and one earned run with no walks and 10 strikeouts...took the mound with a 9-0 lead after the Twins plated nine runs in the top of the first inning against Yankees starter Jhonny Brito and reliever Colten Brewer...Ryan struck out outfielder Franchy Cordero in the third inning to record his 200th career strikeout, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history to record 200 strikeouts within his first 35 career games...his 10 strikeouts matched his previous start for the second most in his career...11 runs of support were the most of Ryan's career...Twins won 11-2 to take the series opener.

WIN STREAK BY THE NUMBERS: In his last eight starts dating back to September 13, 2022, Ryan is 7-0, 2.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 56 strikeouts...opponents are slashing .156/.219/.254 against Ryan during the win streak, and his .474 opponent OPS is the third lowest in baseball in that stretch among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched (Shohei Ohtani -.360, Jeffrey Springs -.448)...the span marks the longest win streak of Ryan's career and the longest win streak by a Twins starter since Michael Pineda went 8-0 in a 16-start stretch from July 21, 2019-April 15, 2021.

YANKEE RERUN: Tonight is Ryan's first career start vs. New York-AL at Target Field and his third career start vs. the Yankees overall...faced New York-AL two starts ago (see note above) and also on September 7, 2022 at Yankee Stadium, taking the loss in a 7-1 Twins defeat...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed three hits and four runs while issuing four walks and striking out three batters...the four walks issued are tied for second most in his career (April 8, 2022 vs. Seattle), and the three strikeouts in that start are tied with six other starts for the second fewest in his career...overall, Ryan is 1-1, 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in his two career starts vs. the Yankees.

ON TARGET: In 19 career starts at Target Field, Ryan is 8-5, 3.65 ERA (103.2 IP, 42 ER) with 34 walks and 115 strikeouts...has similar career numbers on the road, going 11-4 with a 3.51 ERA (95.0 IP, 37 ER), 22 walks and 95 strikeouts in 17 starts...has only made one home start this season, earning the win against Houston on April 8 in a 9-6 Twins victory (6.0 IP, 3 H, 4 R/ER, 1 BB, 10 K)...since his debut on September 1, 2021, Ryan's 115 strikeouts at Target Field are the most by any pitcher.

LEFT/RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting .152 (7-for-46) against Ryan this year...right-handed hitters haven't fared much better, hitting .182 (8-for-44) against Ryan...his .167 overall opponent batting average ranks third in baseball this season (min. 20.0 IP), trailing only Gerrit Cole (.155) and Shohei Ohtani (.092)...over his career, Ryan has slightly better splits against left-handed hitters than righties, with lefties batting just .189 with a .618 OPS since his debut in 2021...right-handed hitters are hitting .210 with a .654 OPS off Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a three-pitch mix in his first four starts of the 2023 season...has used his four-seam fastball the most of his three pitches, throwing it 57.5 percent of the time...recorded two strikeouts with his four-seam fastball and one strikeout with his sweeper in his last start on April 19 at Boston...allowed four hits on offspeed pitches to the Red Sox after opposing hitters went 0-for-21 against his two offspeed offerings in his first three starts...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 0-3, 4.15 ERA // CAREER: 59-44, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Kenta Maeda is set to start the series finale against the New York Yankees at Target Field tomorrow afternoon...took the loss in his last start on April 20 at the Boston Red Sox, going 2.0 innings and allowing one run on one hit with one walk and no strikeouts in an 11-5 Twins defeat...was removed from the game after taking a line drive off his left ankle in the second inning...facing New York-AL for the first time this year and the second time in his career...took the loss in his only previous start vs. the Yankees August 21, 2021, pitching 4.1 innings with five runs and four hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts; Twins lost 7-1...Maeda was removed from the game with right forearm tightness and later underwent Tommy John surgery, ending his season.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.
