**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their current 10-game homestand, going 1-2 against the Nationals over the weekend, followed by a win over the Yankees last night... tonight the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three against New York... after this series, the Twins will host the Royals for four games from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 6-4 at Target Field and 7-6 on the road...Twins have gone just 3-6 in their last nine after starting the season 10-4 in their first 14.

**WHAT DOES THE FOX SAY:** Tonight's game will be televised on WTFC Fox 9+/DirecTV/Mediacom/Midco Sports/DirecTV Stream/Fubo...the scheduling conflict is due to both the Minnesota Timberwolves and Minnesota Wild playoff games.

**SONNY SO MONEY AGAINST HIS FORMER SQUAD:** The Twins beat the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 6-1...Sonny Gray (3-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts...Sonny lowered his ERA to 0.62, the third-lowest ERA through a pitcher's first five games of the season in Twins/ Senators history since 1913 (min. 20.0 IP), behind only Walter John (0.24 ERA in 1913) and Eddie Matteson (0.55 ERA in 1918)...the offense recorded 100 hits, three coming from Max Kepler...Joey Gallo hit his team-leading sixth home run, a 432-foot shot, longer than any home run he hit as a Yankee, from 2021-22.

BROCK STEADY: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart from Triple-A St. Paul...Stewart, 31, has appeared in seven games for the Saints this season, posting a 2.08 ERA (8.2 IP, 2 ER), with two saves, two walks, 17 strikeouts, a 1.04 WHIP and a .219 (7-for-32) opponent batting average...the Normal, Illinois native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in July of 2022 and has appeared in 46 career major league games (11 starts), going 6-3, 6.05 ERA (105.2 IP, 71 ER), one save, 48 walks and 87 strikeouts with Los Angeles-NL (2016-19) and Toronto (2019)...Stewart will occupy the vacated 26-man roster spot left by Bailey Ober, who was optioned to St. Paul yesterday...to make room for Stewart on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Trevor Megill for release or assignment...in seven appearances for the Saints this season, Megill has allowed 14 runs on nine hits in 9.2 innings pitched, with 13 walks and 16 strikeouts.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins have gone 3-2 against the Yankees this season...a win tonight would secure the season series for Minnesota, which would mark their first over the Yankees since going 4-2 in 2001.

◆ The Twins are looking to win a series over the Yankees for the first time since taking two out of three September 10-12, 2018 at Target Field...Twins have gone 10-31-3 vs. the Yankees in series play since 2001.

◆ Jorge Polanco is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with four doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.138 OPS in his last 14 games against the Yankees...he has eight RBI in his last six games vs. New York.

**POLO ON THE MARCO:** Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all four games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and a 1.056 OPS...he enters tonight with 99 career home runs, looking to be the 21st player in club history to reach the 100-home run mark (since 1961).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the fourth series win of the season for the Twins...the Twins have gone 3-3-1 through their first seven series this season, going 3-0 at Kansas City from March 30-April 2, 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 2-1 vs. Houston at Target Field from April 7-9, 2-1 vs. Chicago-AL from April 10-12, 2-2 at New York-AL from April 13-16, 1-2 at Boston from April 18-20 and 1-2 vs. Washington at Target Field from April 21-23.

RYAN KING: Ryan's last start against the Yankees came in game one on April 13 in the opener of fa four-game series at Yankee Stadium...Ryan allowed one run on three hits in 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and 10 strikeouts...he was supported with 11 runs, including a nine-run first inning...the Twins have won each of Ryan's last eight starts, dating back to September 13, 2022, while he has gone 7-0 with one no-decision in that span...Ryan is one of five pitchers in baseball with at least four wins, joining Kyle Gibson (4-0), Clayton Kershaw (4-1), Shane McClanahan (4-0) and Gerrit Cole (4-0).

♣ Nine other pitchers in Twins/Senators franchise history have won each of their first four starts in a season (since 1901): Brad Radke (2001), Jim Deshaies (1993), Bill Krueger (1992) Allan Anderson (1989), Jerry Koosman (1979). Connie Marrero (1951), Bill McAfee (1932), Sad Sam Jones (1930) and Eddie Matteson (1918).

♣ Four pitchers in that same time frame have won their first five: Koosman ('79), Marrero ('51), McAfee ('32) and Jones ('30).

JOEY JACKS: Joey Gallo hit his sixth home run of the season last night and now has an atbat-per-home run ratio of 6.45, the highest in baseball (minimum 40 plate appearances)... despite missing 10 games (right intercostal strain — April 11-19), he still leads the club in homers and ranks tied for third in the American League and tied for eighth in baseball. 

◆ He leads baseball in average exit velocity at 98.7 mph (minimum 40 PA)... additionally, he ranks second in baseball in average distance of balls put in play at 239 feet...his average home run distance is 413 feet, tied with Adolis García and Ryan Mountcastle for third highest in baseball, trailing Sean Murphy (421 ft.) and Matt Olson (419 ft.).

LONELY FOR LEFTIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for just the fifth time this season, the previous four being Jesús Luzardo on April 5 at Miami (5-2 loss), Nestor Cortes on April 14 at New York-AL (4-3 win), Chris Sale on April 18 at Boston (5-4 loss) and Patrick Corbin on April 23 vs. Washington (3-1 win)...the Twins are tied for third in baseball in fewest at-bats against left-handed pitchers with just 148.

Twins are slashing just .203/.273/.351 with six home runs vs. lefties (Correa, Gallo, Garlick, Larnach, Polanco and Taylor)...against right-handers, the Twins are .241/.312/.395.

Carlos Correa is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with a 1.144 OPS against left-handed pitching in his last 32 games, since August 9, 2022.

2 - 2 - 2 : Low-A Fort Myers catcher Andrew Cossetti has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...the 23-year-old from Eagleville, PA hit .555 (10-for-18) with two doubles, three home runs, five walks, 14 RBI and a 1.792 OPS for the Mighty Mussels... he currently leads the FSL in home runs (4), RBI (17), OBP (.510), SLG (.784), OPS (1.294), and total bases (29).

**HBD JACQUE!:** Former Twins outfielder Jacque Jones is celebrating his 48th birthday today...Jacque homered twice against the Yankees during the 2004 ALDS — one time off Mike Mussina in Game 1 and the other time off Kevin Brown in Game 3.

LAST TIME OUT: Ryan extended his career-long winning streak to seven games, earning the victory in the Twins 10-4 win at the Boston Red Sox on April 19...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, issuing one walk with three strikeouts...allowed one run in the third, fifth and sixth innings, including a solo home run to infielder Kiké Hernández in the sixth...opposed right-hander Corey Kluber, who took the loss...10 runs of support were the second most of Ryan's career, trailing only his last start on April 13 at New York-AL (11)...his three strikeouts ties six other starts for the second fewest in his career and is the lowest total in his 15 career quality starts.

With the win, became the 10th pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to win his first four starts of the year and the first since Brad Radke went 4-0 from April 3-20, 2001...with a win tonight, would become fifth pitcher in franchise history to go 5-0 in his first five starts of a season and first since Jerry Koosman in 1979.

Ryan's four wins this year are tied for first in baseball with New York-AL's Gerrit Cole, Baltimore's Kyle Gibson, Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw and Tampa Bay's Shane McClanahan.

TWO STARTS AGO: Improved to 3-0 on the year and won his career-best sixth-consecutive decision on April 13 vs. the New York Yankees at Yankee Stadium...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing three hits and one earned run with no walks and 10 strikeouts...took the mound with a 9-0 lead after the Twins plated nine runs in the top of the first inning against Yankees starter Jhony Brito and reliever Colten Brewer...Ryan struck out outfielder Franchy Cordero in the third inning to record his 200th career strikeout, becoming the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history to record 200 strikeouts within his first 35 career games...his 10 strikeouts matched his previous start for the second most in his career...11 runs of support were the most of Ryan's career...Iwins won 11-2 to take the series opener.

WIN STREAK BY THE NUMBERS: In his last eight starts dating back to September 13, 2022, Ryan is 7-0, 2.17 ERA (49.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 56 strikeouts...opponents are slashing .156/.219/.254 against Ryan during the win streak, and his .474 opponent OPS is the third lowest in baseball in that stretch among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched (Shohei Ohtani - .360, Jeffrey Springs - .448)...the span marks the longest win streak of Ryan's career and the longest win streak by a Twins starter since Michael Pineda went 8-0 in a 16-start stretch from July 21, 2019-April 15, 2021.

YANKEE RERUN: Tonight is Ryan's first career start vs. New York-AL at Target Field and his third career start vs. the Yankees overall...faced New York-AL two starts ago (see note above) and also on September 7, 2022 at Yankee Stadium, taking the loss in a 7-1 Twins defeat...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed three hits and four runs while issuing four walks and striking out three batters...the four walks issued are tied for second most in his career (April 8, 2022 vs. Seattle), and the three strikeouts in that start are tied with six other starts for the second fewest in his career...overall, Ryan is 1-1, 4.09 ERA (11.0 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 13 strikeouts in his two career starts vs. the Yankees.
