THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their current 10-game homestand, going 1-2 against the Nationals over the weekend, followed by consecutive wins over the Yankees the last two nights...today the Twins will play their final game of 2023 against New York... starting tomorrow night, Minnesota will host the Royals for four games through Sunday...the Twins have gone 7-4 at Target Field and 7-6 on the road.

◆ The Twins are looking to win their fourth-straight today, which would match a season-high, done twice previously: March 30-April 3 and April 11-14.

TWINS TAKE ANOTHER FROM THE YANKEES: The Twins beat the Yankees last night at Target Field by a score of 6-2...Joe Ryan (5-0) was the starter and winner, becoming the first fivegame winner in baseball...Ryan allowed two runs (1 earned) on seven his n 7.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...Jorge López and Jhoan Duran each pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Byron Buxton and Jorge Polanco...Buxton hit his fourth home run while Trevor Larnach hit his third homer.
♣ Ryan has won each of his first five starts this season, becoming the fifth pitcher in Twins/ Senators history (1901-present) to go 5-0 in his first five starts of the season, joining: Sad Sam Jones (5-0 from April 27-May 21-1, 1930), Bill McAfee (5-0 from August 19-2-September 4, 1932), Connie Marrero (5-0 from April 17-May 17, 1951) and Jerry Koosman (5-0 from April 10-May 1, 1979).

♣ The win secured the series victory for the Twins, marking their first series win over the Yankees since taking two out of three September 10-12, 2018 at Target Field.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins have gone 4-2 against the Yankees this season, going 2-2 in New York from April 13-16 and 2-0 at Target Field this week.

♣ A win today would give the Twins five wins in a season against the Yankees for the first time since going 5-5 in 2000.

♣ Twins have outscored the Yankees 28-16 this season (+12)...it marks their highest run differential vs. NY since 1991 when they posted a +18 (64-46)...the last time they were in the + was in 2014 at +3, outscoring the Yankees 32-29.

♣ Jorge Polanco is hitting .298 (31-for-104) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a .910 OPS in 26 career games against the Yankees...in his last 15 vs. NYY, he is hitting .349 (22-for-63) with six doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI and a 1.160 OPS...he has nine RBI in his last seven games vs. New York.

♣ Joey Gallo has two hits in four at-bats vs. his former club this season, including one double, one home run, one RBI and one walk.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their second sweep of the season today...their other sweep came in the series opener in Kansas City from March 30-April 2 (3 games)...last season, they swept opponents eight times, all in three games...the Twins' second sweep of 2022 came from April 26-28 vs. Detroit...the Twins are seeking a sweep of the Yankees for the first time since a three-gamer at the HHH Metrodome from September 6-8, 1991...the Twins swept the Yankees in 1993, '94 and '98, but they were all in just two games.

JOEY JACKS: Joey Gallo hit his sixth home run of the season Monday night and now has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 6.33, the highest in baseball (minimum 40 plate appearances)... despite missing 10 games (right intercostal strain — April 11-19), he still leads the club in homers and ranks tied for fourth in the American League and tied for 10th in baseball.

◆Additionally, he leads all of baseball in slugging percentage (min. 40 PA) at .789 and ranks third in OPS (1.167).

LAST START: Was dealt the loss in his start at Fenway Park against Boston on April 20 in a 11-5 Twins loss, opposite Tanner Houck...first time pitching at Fenway Park since July 12, 2019 where he took the 8-1 Dodgers loss...pitched only 2.0 innings, allowing one run and walking one batter,his first walk of the season...his lone blemish was a leadoff home run by Alex Verdugo...exited the game with a left ankle contusion after being hit with a 111 mph line drive by Jarren Duran to end the top of the second inning...was relieved by Emilio Pagán who gave up six runs in the third inning...the bullpen combined for 10 runs over 6.0 innings.

◆ Was his second-shortest outing since April 21, 2021 when he pitched 3.0 innings against Oak-land...the last time Maeda pitched just two innings in a start was July 17, 2019 in a 7-2 Dodgers win against Philadelphia...his first start in his career where he did not strikeout a single batter.

TWO STARTS AGO: Was dealt the loss in his 2023 Target Field debut against Chicago-AL on April 10 in a 4-3 Twins loss, opposite Dylan Cease...first time pitching at Target Field since August 14, 2021...pitched 6.0 innings, allowed four runs on eight hits with just three strikeouts...gave up a three-run home run to Hanser Alberto in the fourth after retiring 10 of the first 12 batters he faced.

AGAINST NEW YORK-AL: Maeda is facing the Yankees for just the second time in his career...last faced New York-AL on August 21, 2021 at Yankee Stadium, opposite Gerrit Cole...took the loss in 7-1 Twins defeat after pitching 4.1 innings, allowing five runs on four hits, walking one batter and fanning five...exited the game with forearm tightness...his 2021 campaign would end after it was revealed he needed Tommy John surgery, which he underwent in September 2021....was scheduled to pitch in the last series against New York-AL but was scratched due to minor arm and body fatigue.

COMING HOME: After his first home start of the 2023 season, Maeda is 0-1, 6.00 ERA (6.0 IP, 4 ER) with three strikeouts...batters are slashing .160/.192/.400 on the road against Maeda compared to .308/.308/.500 at home...in the 2021 season, Maeda pitched seven of his 21 starts at home...he went 2-2, 2.13 ERA (38.0 IP, 9 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts...is 5-3, 2.34 ERA (77.0 IP 20 ER) with 16 walks and 83 strikeouts in 13 starts at Target Field since becoming a Twin...has enjoyed re success at home over his career, with batters slashing .210/.267/.343 in home games versus

.240/.304/.424 during road games.

Ranks 10th in lowest home ERA in the American League since 2020, sixth in lowest WHIP (0.896) tied for fifth in lowest earned runs allowed and fifth in lowest opponent OPS (.523)

THE RIGHT STUFF: After his first three starts, Maeda has seen more success against right-handed batters, holding righties to a .194/.194/.419 slash line with nine strikeouts and a .613 OPS compared to left-handed hitters who are slashing .300/.333/.500 with three strikeouts and a .833 OPS.
