THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their current 10-game homestand, going 1-2 against the Nationals last weekend, followed by a 2-1 series victory over the Yankees this week...

Big Yankee Innings Keep Brooms in Closet: The Twins lost to the Yankees yesterday afternoon in the three-game series finale, failing to record their second sweep of the season...

Everything is Winderful Now: The Twins have returned right-handed pitcher Josh Winder from rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...

Royalty Check: The Twins and Royals are playing the fourth of 13 scheduled meetings in 2023...these two teams opened the season at Kauffman Stadium from March 30-April 2 as the Twins swept the three-game series, outscoring the Royals 11-4...

Zack Attack: Royals starter Zack Greinke is 5-14 in 31 career games (27 starts) vs. Minnesota, his most losses against any opponent...additionally, he is 1-7 in 10 career starts at Target Field and 1-2 in six career games (4 starts) at the Metrodome.

Central Heating: The Twins are playing a series against an AL Central opponent for the third time this season after sweeping the Royals in three games at Kauffman Stadium from March 30-April 2, followed by a 2-1 series victory over Chicago-AL from April 10-12...

Power Surge: The Twins have homered in a season-long nine-straight games, since April 18...since that date, they have hit 15 home runs, tied for second most in baseball with Los Angeles-AL and Los Angeles-NL, and trailing Atlanta (16).

Polanco Party: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all five games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with four doubles, one home run, six RBI and a 1.136 OPS...

Jose is on his Way: After starting the season hitting .191 (9-for-47) with no extra-base hits and a .461 OPS in his first 12 games, Jose Miranda is hitting .288 (15-for-52) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, four walks and a .351 on-base percentage in his last 14 games.

Masher of Baseballs: Joey Gallo hit his seventh home run of the season yesterday and now has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 6.00, the highest in baseball (minimum 45 plate appearances)...

Additionally, he leads all of baseball in slugging percentage (min. 40 PA) at .810 and ranks third in OPS (1.177).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision against Washington on April 21 at Target Field, with a 3-2 Twins defeat, opposite Trevor Williams...pitched 6.1 innings and allowed one run on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts...his lone blemish came from a solo shot from Joey Meneses in the seventh inning; Meneses was the last batter he faced...was relieved by Caleb Thielbar, who retired the next two batters of the inning...in the eighth inning, Griffin Jax allowed two RBI singles to give the Nationals the lead.

TWO STARTS AGO: Mahle took the loss against New York-AL on April 15 at Yankee Stadium, with the Twins falling 6-1 and snapping a four-game win streak...pitched 4.1 innings and allowed four runs (2 earned) on four hits with three walks and five strikeouts...opposed right-hander Domingo Germán, who earned the win...Mahle allowed a two-run home run to catcher Kyle Higashioka in the second inning and a solo home run to first baseman Anthony Rizzo in the third...was relieved in the fifth inning with one out by left-hander Jovani Moran, who stranded the two runners he inherited...Mahle became the first Twins starter to pitch fewer than 5.0 innings in 2023, snapping a 15-game streak of Twins starters pitching at least 5.0 innings from October 5, 2022 to April 14, 2023.

NUMBERS VS. THE ROYALS: Tonight is Mahle's fourth career start vs. Kansas City and second with Minnesota...is 1-0, 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER) with six walks and eight strikeouts in three previous starts vs. the Royals...last start against Kansas City was on August 17, 2022 in his third start with Minnesota...did not factor into the decision after pitching only 2.1 shutout innings with just one strikeout...exited the game in the third inning with right shoulder fatigue...Twins won 4-0...earned his last win against the Royals on June 13, 2018 at Kauffman Stadium...pitched 6.1 scoreless innings, allowing three hits, two walks and striking out one batter in a 7-0 Cincinnati victory...Mahle's ERA against the Royals is the third lowest across any team he's faced, trailing Oakland (1.50) and Arizona (1.80)...his .135 opponent batting average against the Royals ranks 10th lowest across the league since 2018 (min. 10.0 IP).

HOME SWEET HOME: In 59 career home appearances (58 starts), Mahle is 13-19, 4.94 ERA (306.0 IP, 168 ER) with 124 walks and 351 strikeouts...he has better career numbers on the road, going 20-22, 3.73 ERA (325.2 IP, 135 ER) with 107 walks and 320 strikeouts in 63 career road starts...tonight is his fifth career start at Target Field since becoming a Twin...in his previous four starts at Target he is 0-1, 3.92 ERA (20.2 IP, 9 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

LEFT LEADER: Left-handed hitters are batting .103 (3-for-29) with seven strikeouts against Mahle this season...his .103 opponent batting average vs. lefties ranks second in the American League this year behind Nestor Cortes (.095) (min. 4 GS)...is holding lefties to just 4-for-45 (.089) in his eight starts with the Twins since being traded from Cincinnati last season...righties are hitting .321 (17-for-53) with three doubles, three home runs and 15 strikeouts against Mahle in 2023.

☞ Owns a .189 (127-for-671) opponent batting average against left-handed hitters since the start of 2020, second best in the majors in that span (min. 600 AB), behind only Milwaukee's Brandon Woodruff (.187).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Mahle has utilized a four-pitch arsenal this year, primarily relying on a four-seam fastball and slider...is tied for seventh with Logan Gilbert for least hits allowed on a slider at three...has exclusively used his cutter against lefties...here's a look at Mahle's 2023 repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

NIGHT AND DAY: Mahle is making his third night start of the season...has enjoyed more success in his night starts this season going 1-0, 1.59 ERA (11.1 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and 11 strikeouts in his night starts compared to 0-2, 5.23 ERA (10.1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 11 strikeouts in two day starts...tied for fifth in the American League in lowest night ERA...is 18-20, 2.37 ERA (352.0 IP, 171 ER) with 131 walks and 357 strikeouts in 69 night games (68 starts) in his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 1-2, 3.00 ERA // CAREER: 29-33, 3.88 ERA)

Pablo López is scheduled to start the second game of the four-game series vs. the Kansas City Royals at Target Field tomorrow afternoon...took the loss in his last start on April 22 against the Washington Nationals, a 10-4 Twins defeat...went 4.0 innings, allowing five runs on eight hits with two walks and six strikeouts...facing Kansas City for the third time in his career...is 1-1, 1.54 ERA (11.2 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and 14 strikeouts in his previous two starts...his 1.54 ERA is the fifth lowest against any opponent he has faced...last faced the Royals on Opening Day this season, earned the win after pitching 5.1 innings scoreless with two hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts; Marlins won 2-0.

CAREER NOTES

- Made 23 starts in 2022, 19 for Cincinnati to begin the year and four for the Twins in August and September, combining to go 6-8, 4.40 ERA (120.2 IP, 59 ER) with 43 walks and 126 strikeouts.
- Ended 2022 on Injured List with right shoulder inflammation, his third stint of the year on the IL, after departing from final start September 3, 2022 in the third inning.
- Acquired by Minnesota via trade from Cincinnati on August 2, 2022 in exchange for minor league infielders Christian Encarnacion-Strand and Spencer Steer, and left-handed pitcher Steve Hajjar.
- Named the Reds' 2022 Opening Day starter, making his first Opening Day start and his fifth-consecutive Opening Day roster.
- In 2021, established single-season career highs in wins (13), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (201)...ranked among the National League pitching leaders in starts (T-1st), wins (T-10th) and strikeouts (9th).
- Opponents hit just .198 (34-for-172) against Mahle in 2020...went 2-2, 3.59 ERA (47.2 IP, 19 ER) with six home runs, 21 walks and 60 strikeouts over the course of the season.
- Made the first relief appearance of his major league career, following 54 consecutive starts, on August 12, 2020 vs. Kansas City (3.1 IP, 2 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K).
- Went 2-10, 4.93 ERA (102.1 IP, 56 ER) in 19 starts in 2019 before he went on the 10-day Injured List on July 22 with a left hamstring strain...went 1-2, 5.93 ERA (27.1 IP, 18 ER) in six starting efforts after his September callup.
- Entered the 2018 season rated as the fourth-best prospect in the Reds organization by *Baseball America* and went 7-9, 4.95 (109.0 IP, 60 ER) in 22 starts before he was optioned to Louisville on August 3.
- Made his major league debut in a start on August 27, 2017 vs. Pittsburgh (L, 5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 4 BB, 5 K).
