lahle (1-2, 3.16) vs. RHP Dylan Cease (2-1, 4.15) López (2-2, 4.00) vs. RHP Lucas Giolito (1-2, 4.15) **Bally Sports North** THE TWINS: Have gone 5-4 through nine games on their current 10-game homestand, against the Nationals last weekend, 2-1 against the Yankees this week, and 2-1 against the Royals...this afternoon, Minnesota will wrap their homestand with the four-game series finale against the Royals...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Chicago for an off-day on Monday, then begin a six-game roadtrip with three against the White Sox from Tuesday-Thursday, then three against the Guardians next weekend...the Twins have gone 9-6 at Target Field and 7-6 on the road.

◆ Twins have gone 5-2 in their last seven games since April 23 after going 1-6 in a seven-game stretch from April 15-22.

RARE LATE LOSS FOR THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2...it marked their fist loss this season when outhitting their opponents (12-1)...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 5.2 innings pitched...Jorge Lopez blew his first save of the season, allowing a run to score and tie the game in the eighth...Jhoan Duran was issued the loss, allowing a run in the ninth inning on three walks and a wild pitch...the offense recorded 10 hits as Byron Buxton hit his sixth home run of the season...the loss snapped a nine-game home winning streak for the Twins, as the Royals won in Minnesota for the first time since May 28, 2022.

history since 1913 (min. 20.0 IP), behind only Walter Johnson (0.24 ERA in 1913) and Eddie Matteson (0.55 ERA in 1918).

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the seventh of 13 scheduled meetings in 2023...through six games, the Twins have gone 5-1 and outscored the Royals 28-14.

♣ The Twins are 17-6 in their last 23 against KC since April 21, 2022, including a record of 10-3 at Target Field in that span.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (44-for-132) with six doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBI, 20 walks, a .421 on-base percentage and a .959 OPS in 34 games against the Royals since 19.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .326 (30-for-92) with nine doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI, 22 runs scored and a .991 OPS in his last 22 games against the Royals, reaching safely in all 22... in six games this season, he is 9-for-24 and slashing .375/.444/.792.

♣ Trevor Larnach is hitting .338 (24-for-71) with two doubles, four home runs and 15 RBI in 23 career games vs. the Royals, his most RBI against any opponent in his career...in six games this season, he has reached 12 times in 26 plate appearances (.462 OBP).

HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE The Twins have homered in a season-long 12-straight games, since April 18...since that date, they have hit 21 home runs, the most in baseball in that span.

♣ Their current stretch is the club's longest since May 20-June 5, 2021, when they homered in 16 etraight

in 16 straight.

The Twins began this homestand on the morning of April 21 ranking tied for 15th in baseball in homers with 21 and now rank tied for fifth overall on the season with 36.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the fifth series win of the season for the Twins...the Twins have gone 4-3-1 through their first eight series this season...series results to the right >>

SPORTIN' A NEW POLO: Jorge Polanco has hit safely in all eight games since his return from the IL (left knee inflammation) and is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and a 1.029 OPS...his career-high hitting streak is 14, done from May 27-June 13, 2019.

■ Since his return on April 21, his 13 hits are tied with five other American Leaguers for most in that span...additionally, his nine RBI are tied for fourth most in the AL in that span.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Michael Helman and right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

Helman, 26, split the week between Low-A Fort Myers (rehab assignment - left hamstring strain) and St. Paul, combining to hit. 444 (8-for-18) with one double, one triple, two home runs, right RBI, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.444 OPS in four games...the Lincoln, Nebraska native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M University.

Varland, 25, made one start coming on Thursday at Rochester, allowing one earned run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts, earning the win...Varland started one game for the Twins on April 14 at New York-AL, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, helping lead the Twins to a 4-3 victory in the Bronx.

LAST START: Earned the 6-1 Twins win in the series opener against New York-AL on April 24 at Target Field, opposite Jhony Brito...pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, issued two walks and struck out eight batters...the second time Gray has pitched at least 7.0 innings this season (also 7.0 IP on April 7 vs. Houston)...relieved by Griffin Jax in the eighth inning followed by Jovani Moran in the ninth...the lone run allowed by the bullpen was an RBI groundout to Oswaldo Cabrera in the ninth inning...threw 107 pitches, the most pitches Gray has thrown since August 14, 2020 against Pittsburgh when he tossed 110 pitches.

- ♣ Has tossed at least 3.0 minings and allowed other-leaven fulls in each of this list live outlings of the year, the second-longest such streak in Twins/Senators history (since 1913), behind only Ervin Santana's six-game run from April 3-May 2, 2017.
 ♣ Lowered his ERA this season to 0.62, the third-lowest ERA through a pitcher's first five games of the season in Twins/Senators history since 1913 (min. 20.0 IP), behind only Walter Johnson (0.24 ERA in 1913) and Eddie Matteson (0.55 ERA in 1918).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the series opener against the Red Sox on April 18 at Fenway Park, opposite Chris Sale...pitched 5.0 innings, allowed one run on seven hits, walked two batters and fanned seven...his seven hits were the most Gray has allowed since August 8, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL when he also allowed seven hits...the lone run came from an RBI single to Rafael Devers in the first inning...relieved by Jorge López in the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 5.0 innings...Griffin Jax allowed one run in the eighth...Jovani Moran entered in the 10th inning and took the Twins 4-3 loss after a walkoff RBI single by Alex Verdugo.

AGAINST KANSAS CITY: Gray is facing the Royals for the 12th time in his career, going 8-2, 1.54 ERA (70.0 IP, 12 ER) with 16 walks and 60 strikeouts in his 11 previous appearances...last faced Kansas City on April 1 at Kauffman Stadium...earned the win after pitching 5.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits, walking four batters and striking out one...relieved by Jorge Alcala in the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings to secure the Twins 2-0 victory...was the first time in Twins history the season opened with back-to-back shutouts, following Pablo López's performance the day prior. performance the day prior.

 thas won his last eight starts against the Royals, dating back to April 16, 2016...is 8-0, 0.90 ERA (50.0 IP, 5 ER) with 12 walks and 46 strikeouts in that span...owns the lowest ERA against the Royals since 2016 (min 50.0 IP)...is tied with Eric Milton from 2000-2004 and Roger Clemens from 1985-1988 for the longest win streak against the Royals.
 His 1.54 ERA against the Royals is his second lowest against any opposing team in his career, trailing the Rockies (1.29)...has the lowest ERA and opponent batting average (.204) against the Royals since 2014 (min. 70.0 IP).
 His last loss against the Royals came on August 11, 2014 in a 3-2 Oakland loss.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: In three home starts this season, Gray is 2-0, 0.47 ERA (19.0 IP, 1 ER) with five walks and 26 strikeouts...Gray went 4-2, 2.66 ERA (67.2 IP, 20 ER) with 25 walks and 78 strikeouts in 13 starts at home in 2022...is now 52-39, 3.76 ERA (747.1 IP, 312 ER) with 252 walks and 727 strikeouts in his career at home, including 6-2, 2.18 ERA (86.2 IP, 21 ER) in 16 starts

at Target Field (Twins are 11-5 in those games).

Among American League pitchers, Gray ranks second in home ERA, trailing Gerrit Cole (0.33)...
fourth in home strikeouts, trailing Jacob DeGrom (40), Gerrit Cole (33) and Luis Castillo (29)... ranks sixth in opponent batting average (.156) at home...his .436 opponent OPS at home ranks fourth (min. 15.0 IP).

THIS IS THE (RIGHT) WAY: So far this season, Gray has seen similar success against lefties and righties with a slight edge against right-handers...Gray has held righties to a .190 batting average (12-for-63) with five doubles and 26 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are batting .195 with three doubles and eight strikeouts.

- ★ Ranks 10th among American League pitchers in opponent batting average against righties... is tied for sixth for the most strikeouts against righties (min. 25.0 IP).
 ★ Since 2019, is holding left-handed hitters to a .201 (177-for-880) batting average, ranking third among the league (min. 850 AB) in that span, trailing Gerrit Cole (.187) and Zac Collec (104).
