MINNESOTA: After Texas' 2-0 loss to Baltimore last night, Minnesota is now one of two teams in baseball yet to lose a game, joining Tampa Bay (4-0), who beat the Nationals last night...

MIAMI NICE: The Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 18th time in their history tonight...the Twins are 10-7 against the Marlins, going 2-1 at the Metrodome...

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins have won four straight against National League opponents, dating back to a three-game sweep of the Giants, from August 26-28, 2022...

GALLO-BOMBS: Joey Gallo has four hits in 13 at-bats this season, all of which have gone for extra-bases (3 home runs and 1 double)...last season with the Yankees and Dodgers, Gallo recorded 56 hits, 29 going for extra bases (52%)...

SERIES STUFF: A victory tonight would secure the second series win of the season for the Twins...in 2022, they went 21-24-6 in series play, going 14-8-4 at home and 7-16-2 on the road...

ROAD 'LOS: In his last 29 road games, dating back to August 13, 2022, Carlos Correa is hitting .321 (36-for-112) with five doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, 12 walks, a .386 on-base percentage and an .886 OPS...

SPRING RECAP: Maeda made five Grapefruit League appearances this spring and started four games, going 1-1, 4.91 ERA (14.2 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 14 strikeouts...was scoreless in his first two appearances that spanned three innings, giving up two hits and no walks...on March 19, allowed five runs against Atlanta over 4.0 innings, the most ever in his spring training career...pitched 5.0 innings in his final appearance on March 24 against New York-AL and surrendered two runs, three hits and issued three walks.

LAST START: Maeda had his third shortest outing of the season on August 21, 2021 against New York-AL...allowed five runs over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts and one walk...he exited the game in the fourth inning with right forearm tightness...season was cut short after it was revealed he would need Tommy John surgery.

TOMMY JOHN: Missed entire season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...spent the summer at the Twins spring training facility in Fort Myers, FL, with occasional visits to Minneapolis.

AGAINST MIAMI: Maeda is facing the Marlins for the sixth time in his career, going 1-2, 2.28 ERA (27.2 IP, 7 ER), with 12 walks and 59 strikeouts in his five appearances...has only made four starts against Miami...last faced Miami on July 19, 2019 at Dodger Stadium in a relief appearance, pitching one hitless inning and fanning two batters, earning his first hold of the season.

☞ Maeda's last appearance against Miami at loanDepot Park was on May 17, 2018 where he secured the win by pitching 8.0 shutout innings with eight strikeouts...the only blemishes in the game were two line drives to the outfield.

ON THE ROAD: In the 2021 season, Maeda pitched 66.7 percent of his games on the road...he went 4-3, with a 6.06 ERA (68.1 IP, 48 ER) with 22 walks and 76 strikeouts in 14 starts away from Target Field...is 26-22, 4.71 ERA (387.2 IP, 203 ER) with 124 walks and 491 strikeouts in his career on the road.

LEFTIES AND RIGHTIES: In 2021, Maeda posted similar lines to both lefties and righties with right handers batting .257/.312/.421 with 52 hits, nine doubles and 56 strikeouts over 202 AB, while lefties posted a .258/.331/.445 line with 54 hits, 11 doubles and 57 strikeouts over 207 AB.

☞ The 2021 season was different than the rest of his career where he historically has seen more success against right-handed batters, with righties only batting .203/.253/.349 with 297 hits against Maeda, as opposed to left-handed batters slashing .250/.321/.424 with 349 hits.

2021 ARSENAL: Over the 2020-2021 seasons, Maeda's slider has overtaken his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch in his five-pitch arsenal...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

MONTHLY MARKS: Maeda owns a 3.68 career ERA in May, 3.25 mark in June and 3.86 mark in July, before inching up to 3.98 in August, his second-highest career ERA in any month, behind only his 4.48 mark in April...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only, excluding March and October).

MILESTONE MAN: Maeda surpassed two career milestones in his start against the Mariners in Seattle on June 14, 2021...at the end of his second inning of work he reached 700 career MLB innings, becoming the 10th Japanese-born pitcher to hit that plateau in the majors...the others are: Hideo Nomo (1,976.1 IP), Hiroki Kuroda (1,319.0 IP), Yu Darvish (1,258.1 IP), Tomo Ohka (1,070.0 IP), Masahiro Tanaka (1,054.1 IP), Hisashi Iwakuma (883.2 IP), Daisuke Matsuzaka (790.1 IP), Masato Yoshii (757.1 IP) and Shigetoshi Hasegawa (720.1 IP)...additionally, Maeda's strikeout of Shed Long Jr. in the fourth inning on June 14 was the 2,000th of his career...he now has 2,067 strikeouts combined between Nippon Professional Baseball (1,233) and Major League Baseball (834)

☞ Maeda's final strikeout on July 17, 2021 was the 800th of his major league career...he became just the fifth Japanese-born pitcher in major league history to reach 800 career strikeouts, joining Nomo (1,918), Darvish (1,550), Tanaka (991) and Kuroda (986).

☞ Maeda's seven career games with 10-plus strikeouts are fourth most among Japanese-born pitchers in major league history, behind Darvish (47), Nomo (31) and Tanaka (14).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 1-0 0.00 ERA // CAREER: 29-31, 3.89 ERA)

Pablo López is scheduled to start against his former team in the final game of the three-game set against the Miami Marlins...in the offseason, López was traded to Twins, alongside infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio in exchange for infielder Luis Arraez...pitched 5.1 scoreless innings in debut with Twins against Kansas City, allowed only two hits and issued three walks with eight strikeouts...is 4-5, 3.00 ERA (72.0 IP, 24 ER) with 16 walks and 77 strikeouts in 13 Interleague games.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.

MINNESOTA NICE: Maeda is entering his fourth season (third active) with the Twins...since joining Minnesota, Maeda has gone 12-6, 3.90 ERA (173.0 IP, 75 ER) with 42 walks and 193 strikeouts.

☞ Maeda has the most strikeouts by a pitcher within his first 32 games with the Twins, has given up the second lowest amount of hits with 146 (trailing Joe Ryan at 131) and has the 15th lowest ERA (minimum 170.0 IP).

INTER-LEAGUE GAMES: Since the start of his career in 2016, Maeda has pitched in 24 inter-league games, going 7-7, 4.35 ERA (111.2 IP, 54 ER) with 38 walks and 121 strikeouts.

☞ Has given up the least amount of hits in 24 interleague games since 2016 with 92 (minimum 110.0 IP).
