THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, sweeping the Royals in three last weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in Miami this week... this afternoon, the Twins will wrap the series with the three-game series finale at loanDepot Park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then begin their 14th season at Target Field with three against the Astros from Friday-Sunday and three against the White Sox from Monday-Wednesday.
\* Twins return home Friday where they went 46-35 at Target Field in 2022.
\* Today marks the first rubber game of 2023...the Twins were 7-7 in such instances in 2023.

TICK TOCK: Through five games, the Twins average time of game is two hours and 23 minutes, the fastest in baseball...their longest game this season has been 2:35 (April 2 at KC), while their shortest was last night at 1:57...last season, the Twins average time of game was 3:07, a difference of 44 minutes to this season.

ENTER SANDY-MAN, TWINS BATS TO SLEEP: The Twins were shut out by the Marlins and reigning NL Cy Young Award winner Sandy Alcantara last night by a score of 1-0...Kenta Maeda (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing just one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, including nine strikeouts, the most by a Twins starter this season...it marked Maeda's first appearance on a regular season major league mound since August 21, 2021 — a span of 591 days...the offense recorded just three hits as Trevor Larnach reached twice, going 1-for-3 with a walk...the game was played in one hour and 57 minutes, the shortest 9-inning game for Minnesota since September 10, 2010 at Cleveland (also 1:57).

HAPPY PABLO DAY: Today's starter, Pablo López, was acquired by the Twins via trade with Miami on January 20, along with infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez...López made his major league debut with the Marlins on June 30, 2018 and pitched parts of five major league seasons with Miami from 2018-22, going 28-31, 3.94 ERA (510.0 IP, 223 ER), with 142 walks, 489 strikeouts and a 1.19 WHIP in 94 starts...his 489 strikeouts still rank 12th on the Marlins all-time list...last season, he became the 16th pitcher in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched...he was named the 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award winner...in 50 career stats at loanDepot Park, he has gone 14-15, 3.45 ERA (284.0 IP, 109 ER) with 79 walks, 268 strikeouts and 26 quality starts...below are his ranks in this ballpark:

MOUND MASTERS: Through five games, Twins pitchers have combined to post a 1.03 ERA (26.1 IP, 3 ER), with 10 walks, 31 strikeouts, while holding batters to a slashline of .172/.260/.280... below are their ranks among all starting staffs in Major League Baseball:

MINNESOTA: The Twins 4-1 record ranks tied for second-best in baseball with Atlanta and Milwaukee, and trailing Tampa Bay (5-0)...a win today would give the Twins their best start since 2017, when they were also 5-1...a win today would also mark the 10th time in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) to win at least five games in their first six chances.

THE OTHER GUYS: The Twins have won four of their last five against National League opponents, dating back to August 26, 2022...their next Interleague game after today will be when the Twins host the Nationals from April 21-23.

\* The Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 19th time in their history today...the Twins are 10-8 against the Marlins, going 2-1 at the Metrodome, 2-1 at Dolphin Stadium, 3-4 at Marlins Park/loanDepot and 3-2 at Target Field.

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins have six hits in 21 at-bats vs. left-handed pitching this season, including two home runs (Gallo & Larnach).
\* Last season, the Twins went 27-22 in games started by left-handers.
\* Carlos Correa hit .299 (40-for-134) with a .945 OPS vs. lefties last season...in his last 26 games, dating back to August 9, 2022, he is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with a 1.197 OPS against left-handed pitching.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A victory today would secure the second series win of the season for the Twins...in 2022, they went 21-24-6 in series play, going 14-8-4 at home and 7-16-2 on the road...the last time the Twins won both of their first two series in a season came in 2021, taking two of three at both Milwaukee and Detroit.

LARNACH ON WOOD: Trevor Larnach has eight hits and four walks in 23 plate appearances this season, slashing .421/.522/.684 in five games...his .421 batting average ranks fifth in the AL, trailing Matt Chapman (.579), Adam Duvall (.476), Taylor Ward (.435) and Yoán Moncada (.429)...his .522 OBP also ranks fifth, trailing Chapman (.619), Mike Trout (.565), Duvall (.542) and Gleyber Torres (.524).

\* An In Memoriam video and moment of silence will pay tribute to those whom we have lost this past offseason...the Twins will reserve a scout seat behind home plate in memory of Mike Radcliff, the club's beloved Vice President, Player Personnel and member of two scouting halls of fame, who passed away in February after a courageous three-year battle with cancer.
\* 100-year-old World War II veteran, Technical Sergeant Don Halverson, will raise the American flag inside Gate 34 as part of the Salute to America presented by Thomson Reuters...Twins Season Ticket Holders will unfurl a second, giant American flag on the field.
\* The National Anthem will be sung by one of the stars of the national tour of the Tony Award-winning Broadway musical Hamilton at the Orpheum Theatre, presented by Hennepin Theatre Trust.
\* A flyover will feature two F-16 Fighting Falcons from the Minnesota National Guard's 148th Fighter Wing, based out of Duluth.
\* The ceremonial first pitches will be thrown by Minneapolis natives and 2022 Rock & Roll Hall of Fame inductees Jimmy Jam & Terry Lewis.

**LAST TIME OUT:** López started on Opening Day March 30 at Kansas City and earned the win in his Twins debut, pitching 5.1 shutout innings with two hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts...retired seven batters he faced and nine of first 10...escaped bases-loaded, one-out jam in the bottom of the fifth by inducing a 3-2-4 double-play groundout from Royals outfielder MJ Melendez...was his first career Opening Day start and was first Twins pitcher to wear the new road gray uniforms...became second Venezuelan-born pitcher to start for Minnesota on Opening Day, joining Johan Santana (2006-07).

**BACK IN MIAMI:** Facing the Marlins, his former club, for the first time in his career...was traded from Miami to the Twins January 20 along with infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio in exchange for infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez...is 14-15, 3.45 ERA (284.0 IP, 109 ER) with 79 walks and 268 strikeouts in 50 career starts at loanDepot Park...85.3 percent of his career starts are against National League opponents...is 24-26, 4.09 ERA (438.0 IP, 199 ER) vs. NL opponents in his career.

- ⚔ Is three strikeouts away from reaching 500 career strikeouts...would become the 21st Venezuelan-born pitcher all-time to reach the milestone.
- ⚔ Is currently fifth among active Venezuelan pitchers in strikeouts, trailing Carlos Carrasco (1511), Germán Márquez (971), Eduardo Rodríguez (969) and Martín Pérez (916).

**NO POTHOLES ON THIS ROAD:** With the victory at Kansas City in his first start, López improved his career road record to 15-16, 4.44 ERA (231.1 IP, 114 ER) with 66 walks and 229 strikeouts...last season, he went 6-5, 3.00 ERA (93.0 IP, 31 ER) in 16 starts on the road compared to 4-5, 4.55 ERA (87.0 IP, 44 ER) in 16 home starts...his 96 road strikeouts in 2022 tied for eighth in the National League, while his .224 road opponent batting average was 18th best in the NL (min. 50.0 IP).

**RIGHT ON:** López continued his dominance vs. right-handed hitters on Opening Day, with Royals righties hitting just .100 (1-for-10) against him...right-handed hitters slashed .218/.269/.379 with nine home runs, 18 walks and 102 strikeouts against López in 2022...his 102 strikeouts vs. right-handed hitters ranked seventh among National League right-handed pitchers...lefties hit .249/.320/.427 with 12 home runs, 35 walks and 72 strikeouts vs. López in 2022...over his career, López has enjoyed more success against right-handed hitters (.657 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.748 OPS).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** López used a five-pitch mix in his first start vs. Kansas City, according to Baseball Savant...debuted his sweeper, throwing the pitch 22.4 percent of the time and collecting three strikeouts with it...utilized his sweeper and sinker vs. right-handed hitters and primarily threw his changeup and curveball to left-handed hitters...here is a look at his arsenal from Opening Day:

- ⚔ Opened season as Marlins' number two starter behind the season's eventual National League Cy Young Award winner Sandy Alcantara.
  - ⚔ Named the NL Pitcher of the Month for April, going 3-0 with a 0.39 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 23.1 innings...became the 12th pitcher in Major League Baseball history to allow one run or less in his first four starts of the season while pitching at least 20.0 innings.
  - ⚔ Pitched 8.0 scoreless innings on May 7 at San Diego to match his career-high, done once before on June 8, 2021 vs. Colorado.
  - ⚔ Set a career high with 11 strikeouts on May 13 vs. Milwaukee, which he matched again on July 26 at Cincinnati.
