SONNY SHINES IN OPENER: The Twins beat the Astros yesterday at Target Field by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched...Gray set a career-high with 13 strikeouts, fanning exactly half of the batters he faced (26)... 13 strikeouts were also the most for a Twins starter since Francisco Liriano had 15 on July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland .the offense recorded 11 hits, three from Jose Miranda, who drove in the game-tying run in the bottom of the 10th...Kyle Farmer drove in the game-winning run with a single, his second career walk-off...the other was in his major league debut with the Dodgers on July 30,2017 vs. San Francisco. $\mp$ Gray's 13 strikeouts marked the most by a Twin in their Home Opener, passing the previous record of 10, done by Bert Blyleven in 1974 vs. Chicago-AL and José Berríos in 2019 vs. Cleveland.玉 The Twins drew 38,465 in attendance for the Opener, their 12th Home Opener sellout in Target Field's history...184th sellout in Target Field history overall.

Kansas City

JOE VS. THE 'STROS: Today Ryan faces the Astros for the second time in his career...lost to Houston May 10, 2022 at Target Field, allowing four hits and four earned runs in 4.0 innings with a careerhigh five walk and three strikeouts...Ryan allowed two hits and a walk to start the fifth inning before being removed with the Twins trailing 3-0...tied four other starts for the shortest start of his career... is looking for his first career win vs. an American League West opponent... has gone 0-4, 5.87 ERA (23.0 IP, 15 ER ) with 16 walks and 21 strikeouts in five previous starts against the AL West.

RIGHT ON TARGET: Ryan will make his first home start of 2023 today...in 18 career starts at Target Field, Ryan is 7-5, 3.50 ERA ( $97.2 \mathrm{IP}, 38$ ER) with 33 walks and 105 strikeouts...on the road, Ryan has gone 9-4, 3.62 ERA (82.0 IP, 33 ER) with 21 walks and 82 strikeouts in 15 starts...owns a 9.7 strikeout-towalk ratio and a 1.02 WHIP at home in his career, slightly better than his 9.0 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 1.07 WHIP in road starts...Ryan's 105 strikeouts at Target Field rank ninth among active players.
