GREAT STORY, COMPELLING AND RICH: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL, and 1-2 at Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game Interleague homestand with a loss to the Padres last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three against San Diego before completing the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, they will host the Cubs for three games over the weekend...the Twins have gone 10-7 at Target Field and 9-10 on the road.

◆ The Twins are looking to avoid losing a season-long four-straight games tonight.

GLASS CASE OF EMOTION: The Twins lost to the Padres last night at Target Field by a score of 6-1, allowing five runs in the final three innings...Louie Varland was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched...Griffin lax was issued the loss in relief, allowing two unearned runs in the seventh inning on no hits, two walks and one fielding error (Kirilloff)...the offense recorded six hits as lose Miranda drove in the only Twins run with a fourth inning RBI double...Twins went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base...Minnesota is now just 1-for-21 with RISP in their last three games.

NO TOUCHING OF THE HAIR OR FACE: The Twins have returned infielder Kyle Farmer from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Farmer, 32, has missed the Twins' last 24 games with a facial laceration, which he sustained after being hit in the face by a pitch on April 12 vs. Chicago-AL...he appeared in four games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .308 (4-for-13) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, two walks and four runs scored...to make room for Farmer on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned infielder Jose Miranda to St. Paul...Miranda, 24, hit .220 (29-for-132) with four doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, nine walks and 12 runs scored in 35 games for the Twins.

WHAT IF JUST FOR TONIGHT, WE WERE CO-PEOPLE: Pablo López, Sonny Gray and Joe Ryan are all tied for team lead with seven starts apiece...the three have combined to go 11-3, 2.55 ERA (127.0 IP, 36 ER) with 31 walks, 148 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .207 (97-for-468)...below are their individual numbers and AL ranks among starters:

SAN DIEG-ITES, SAN DIEGO-INS, SAN DIEAGANS: The Twins are 16-8 all-time against the Padres, posting a .667 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent...the Twins are 6-2 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 7-3 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium, and 1-2 at Metrodome.

■ The Twins have gone 2-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 1-2 vs. Washington from April 21-23 and 0-1 vs. San Diego.

FLY BALLS IN FLIGHT, AFTERNOON DELIGHT: The Twins have gone homerless in their last two games after homering in a franchise record 18-straight games from April 18-May 6...the streak started on April 18 and since that date, the Twins have hit 29 home runs, the sixth most in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (38), Atlanta (35), Los Angeles-NL (31) and San Francisco (31) in that span.

SON OF A B(EE) STING!: Byron Buxton has reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games and in a season-long 12 straight (via hit, walk or HBP)...it is the fourth-longest on-base streak of his career (also 2020), his top three are: 19 (August 3-21, 2017), 18 (August 9, 2022-April 9, 2023) and 16 (September 15-October 3, 2021)...he has a .396 on-base percentage (10 hits, 10 walks), a .690 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS during the streak.

THE HUMAN TORCH (WAS DENIED A BANK LOAN): Jhoan Duran has thrown 91 of his 215 pitches at least 100 mph, second most in baseball trailing St. Louis' Jordan Hicks (135)...he has thrown 24 pitches at least 102 mph (Hicks - 36)...since the start of last season, he has thrown 483 pitches of 1,238 total pitches 100-plus, the most in baseball, next being Hunter Greene with 413.

WHEN IN ROME AT HOME:: Twins have gone 10-7 at home this season for a .588 winning percentage, tied for seventh best in baseball...they have gone 4-1-0 in series play at Target Field this season, their one series defeat coming April 21-23, dropping two of three to Washington.

◆ Twins hitters are slashing .243/.324/.418 and scoring 4.47 runs-per-game at Target Field, compared to .198/.278/.356 with 4.05 runs-per-game on the road.

HEY EVERYONE! COME SEE HOW GOOD I LOOK!: Since coming off the Injured List (left knee inflammation) on April 21, Jorge Polanco has hit safely in 13 of 16 games...in 10 games at Target Field he has hit .326 (14-for-43) with nine RBI and an .884 OPS, compared to .200 (5-for-25) with two RBI and a .459 OPS in six road games...in fact, in his last 39 home games, dating back to June 7, 2022, Polo is hitting .302 (42-for-139) with an .888 OPS.

BY THE BEARD OF ZEUS!: Joey Gallo snapped an 0-for-last-25 last night, going 1-for-4...despite the recent slide, Gallo still has posted a .326 on-base percentage, a .541 slugging percentage and an .866 OPS in 26 games...he leads the Twins in slugging percentage (min. 80 plate appearances) and OPS...also, he ranks 15th in the AL in slugging percentage, first in the AL in avg. exit velo (95.8 mph) and second in hard hit % (64.4).

HEY ROC-UALUNG!: Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 307-275, including a record of 41-46 in Interleague Play, 1-3 vs. San Diego...since Rocco became the club's manager in 2019, the Twins have gone 164-127 at Target Field, the fourth most home wins in the AL...prior to Rocco, from 2010-18, the Twins had gone 350-379 at Target Field, the second fewest home wins in the AL (Houston - 252).

JUST DOING MY WORKOUT, THURSDAY'S ARMS AND BACK: Twins number two prospect, Royce Lewis, is scheduled to begin his rehab assignment with Double-A Wichita tomorrow...he has been recovering from surgery he had performed on his right ACL on June 21, 2022.

WHY DO THEY CALL IT THE BIG APPLE? BECAUSE THERE'S AN APPLE TREE ON EVERY STREET: This Friday night, the Twins will host the Cubs on Apple TV+...it will mark the club's second time on that platform this season, the previous being Friday, May 5 at Cleveland (2-0 win).

HE HAS A VOICE THAT COULD MAKE A WOLVERINE PURR: Did you know that Twins radio stud Dan Gladden played 38 career games vs. the Padres, hitting .241 (33-for-137) with 12 multi-hit games from 1983-86...in his final game against the Padres, while playing for the Giants, he homered in the seventh inning off good ol' Bob Stoddard...Gladden and Stoddard were born four months apart in San Jose, CA.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 7-3, 12-inning win at Guaranteed Rate Field on May 4 against the Chicago White Sox...went 7.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on six hits with one walk and eight strikeouts...allowed a two-run home run to designated hitter Eloy Jiménez in the bottom of the third inning...stranded two runners in scoring position in the sixth inning by inducing an inning-ending groundout from infielder Elvis Andrus...retired the side in order in the seventh inning and was relieved by Jorge López in the bottom of the eighth after the Twins tied the score 2-2 on a Byron Buxton solo home run in the top of the eighth. Minnesota scored five runs in the 12th inning and five Twins relievers limited the White Sox to one unearned run over 5.0 innings pitched to close out the victory.

The Marked his third start of 7.0-or-more innings and eight-or-more strikeouts this season, tied for first in baseball this year with Toronto's Kevin Gausman and Houston's Framber Valdez...

López has recorded nine such starts in his career.

López has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in each of his last eight starts, since October 4, 2022, the longest streak of his career...his seven-start streak to start 2023 is tied with Atlanta's Spencer Strider and Seattle's Logan Gilbert for the longest streak in baseball.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win in the Twins 8-6 victory over Kansas City on April 28 at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing a season-high six runs on a season-high-tying eight hits with one walk and seven strikeouts...opposed right-hander Jordan Lyles, who took the loss...conceded a first-inning run for the fourth time this year when catcher Salvador Perez hit a sacrifice fly, scoring infielder Bobby Witt Jr...allowed a RBI single to infielder Nick Pratto in the fourth inning and a two-run homer to Perez in the sixth...first two batters of the seventh inning reached against López before he was relieved by Griffin Jax, who allowed both inherited runs to score...received eight runs of support, his highest total of the season and the most since May 7, 2022 with Miami at San Diego...Twins bullpen held Royals scoreless in the final two innings to secure the victory.

\$\Pi\$ Allowed at least eight hits in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career, also doing so with Miami on July 31, 2022 vs. New York-NL (12 H) and August 6, 2022 at Chicago-NL (9 H).

\$\Pi\$ Earned his first career win when allowing four-or-more earned runs...previous high allowed in a win was three earned runs, done five times in his career, most recently on September 27, 2022 at New York-NL.

\$\Pi\$ Stopped his two-game losing streak and recorded his first career win at Target Field, giving him a win at 14 different ballparks in his career.

SHAKY STARTS, THEN SMOOTH SAILING: López allowed two hits in the first inning of his last start at Chicago-AL on May 4 but held the White Sox scoreless...marked the third time he has held opponents scoreless in the first inning this year (March 30 at Kansas City, April 16 at New York-AL)...six of López's 18 runs allowed (33.3 percent) this season have come in the first inning...here are his numbers in the first inning compared to all other innings combined:

STATS VS. SAN DIEGO: Facing the Padres for the third time in his career and first time with Minnesota... pitched against San Diego twice in 2022 with Miami, going 1-1, 4.26 ERA (12.2 IP, 6 ER) with five walks and seven strikeouts in those two starts...last faced the Padres on August 17, 2022 at loanDepot Park, taking the loss in a 10-3 Marlins defeat...pitched 4.2 innings, allowing six earned runs on six hits with three walks and two strikeouts...the two strikeouts tied three other starts for his second-lowest strikeout total last season...in his only other start vs. San Diego, earned the win at Petco Park on May 7, 2022, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with five hits allowed, two walks and five strikeouts in a 8-0 Marlins victory...tied his start on June 8, 2021 vs. Colorado for the longest outing of his career.

FINDING HIS TARGET: Tonight is López's fourth start of the year at Target Field...also his fourth career start at the venue...in his first three home starts this season, López went 1-1, 6.62 ERA (17.2 IP, 13 ER) with four walks and 23 strikeouts, with the Twins winning two of those three starts...Minnesota has gone 2-2 in his four road starts this year, with López going 1-1, 1.78 ERA (25.1 IP, 5 ER) with 83 walks and 31 strikeouts...over his career, López is 15-16, 3.64 ERA (301.2 IP, 122 ER) with 83 walks and 291 strikeouts in 53 home starts...in 48 road starts, he is 15-17, 4.26 ERA (251.1 IP, 119 ER) with 69 walks and 252 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: López has limited left-handed hitters to a .230 (14-for-61) batting average this season... right-handed hitters are batting at a .232 (23-for-99) clip...his 35 strikeouts against righties are sixth most in the American League...over his career, López has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.667 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.737 OPS)...his .221 (134-for-606) opponent batting average against right-handed hitters since 2021 is 18th best in baseball (min. 500 at-bats).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first seven starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has exclusively used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball when facing left-handed hitters...recorded strikeouts with all five of his pitch types in his last start on May 4 at Chicago-AL (four-seam fastball - 2, sweeper - 2, changeup - 2, sinker - 1, curveball - 1)...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:
