THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL, and 1-2 at Cleveland), the twins began their six-game Interleague homestand with a loss and a win against the Padres the last two nights...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale against San Diego...starting tomorrow night, they will welcome the Cubs for three games over the weekend...the Twins have gone 11-7 at Target Field and 9-10 on the road. The Twins have gone 6-3 in their last nine home games. The Twins are 1-3 in rubber games this season, their one win coming in the third game of the White Sox series at Target Field on April 12.

ANY WAY YOU CAN GET IT: The Twins beat the Padres last night by a score of 4-3 in 11 innings...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on two hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with a season-high four walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, two from both Max Kepler and Alex Kirilloff...Kepler hit his sixth home run of the season...Kirilloff drove in Kepler in the 11th inning with a walk-off single to rightfield, the first walk-off RBI of AK's career...it marked the third walk-off hit for the Twins this season (Farmer single on 4/7 vs. HOU and Castro scoring on 4/11 vs. CWS).

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starters have combined to go 14-9, 3.09 ERA (210.0 IP, 72 ER) with 54 walks, 234 strikeouts and a .220 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks among all teams in all of baseball:

NOTE: In 2022, the Twins starters finished 27th in baseball in innings, 20th in ERA, 13th in BAA, 25th in walks allowed, 18th in fielding independent pitching, 12th in WHIP, 24th in strikeouts and 16th in OPS.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins have gone 3-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 1-2 vs. Washington from April 21-23 and 1-1 vs. San Diego...the Twins' next IL series will be this weekend vs. the Chicago Cubs.

The Twins went 8-12 against the National League last season...for the first time in 2023, the Twins will play each of the 15 National League teams...Minnesota's remaining 2023 Interleague home schedule includes Target Field visits from the Cubs (Friday-Sunday), Giants (May 22-24), Brewers (June 13-14), Diamondbacks (August 4-6), Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September 8-10)...the Twins will also play road games at the Dodgers (May 15-17), Braves (June 26-28), Cardinals (August 1-3), Phillies (August 11-13), Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies (September 29-October 1).

YOU STAY CLASSY, SAN DIEGO: The Twins are 17-8 all-time against the Padres, posting a .680 winning percentage, their highest vs. any NL opponent...the Twins are 7-2 all-time against the Padres at Target Field, 7-3 at Petco Park, 2-1 at Qualcomm Stadium and 1-2 at Metrodome. The Twins are 14-5 against the Padres in their last 19 games, dating back to June of 2008.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 46 times on the season, the sixth most in the AL and ninth most in baseball...36 of their home runs have come in their last 25 games since April 13...since that date, their 36 homers are second most in the AL (Tampa Bay - 45) and fifth most in baseball, trailing Tampa (45), Atlanta (44), Los Angeles-LA (40) and San Francisco (37).

Byron Buxton ranks tied for seventh in the AL in homers with eight...Joey Gallo ranks tied for 16th in the AL in homers with seven...among AL players with a minimum of 80 plate appearances, Gallo ranks third in at-bats-per-home run ratio at 11.00, trailing Brent Rooker (10.40) and Luke Raley (10.50).

MAX STRENGTH: Max Kepler has reached safely in 11 of his last 12 games, posting a .919 OPS in that span, a .364 on-base percentage and a .556 slugging percentage...in those 12 games, he has 11 hits, four home runs, eight walks, eight RBI and nine runs scored.

Kepler ranks in the 88th percentile in baseball in hard hit percentage at 50.0% — a figure that is up 10.1% from his 39.9 mark in 2022...additionally, he ranks in the 89th percentile in xSLG (.534), in the 85th percentile in avg exit velo (91.7) and 88th percentile in barrel % (14.9).

Kepler is 2-for-4 with a home run and three RBI lifetime against Yu Darvish.

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are looking to win their sixth series of the season today, going 5-5-1 in series play in 2023 (results to the right)...their only series loss at home this season was dropping two of three to the Nationals from April 21-23...today would mark their first series win over an NL team since sweeping the Giants in three games from August 26-28, 2022.

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Twins relievers have combined to post a .216 opponent batting average, the fifth lowest in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (.202), New York-AL (.205) Chicago-NL (.211) and Texas (.215)...they have allowed just 97 hits this season, the second fewest in baseball, trailing Texas (96).

The Twins' pen has held opponents to a .177 average on offspeed pitches (1st in baseball) a .248 average on fastballs (7th best in baseball) and .206 average on breaking balls (10th in baseball).

DAY MEN, FIGHTERS OF THE NIGHT MEN: The Twins are playing their 21st day game today...20 day games are tied with Chicago-AL and Detroit for the second most in baseball, trailing Miami (22)...they have gone 10-10 in day games.

Byron Buxton has five of his eight home runs this season in day games...Buck has a .907 OPS in 18 day games in 2023.

Twins pitchers have a 4.07 ERA (179.0 IP, 81 ER) in day games, compared to 2.39 ERA (154.1 IP, 41 ER) in night games.

ON THIS DAY IN FRANCHISE HISTORY: In 1919, Walter Johnson of the Washington Senators pitched 12 scoreless innings in a duel with Jack Quinn of the New York Yankees at the Polo Grounds...Johnson allowed only two hits and retired 28 batters in a row...the Senators moved to Minnesota prior to the 1961 season...Johnson is the Senators/Twins franchise all-time leader in wins (417), starts (666), games (802), ERA (2.17), complete games (531), innings pitched (5914.2) and shutouts (110).

TARGET FIELD TUNES: The Twins announced their second-ever postgame concert series at Target Field yesterday...hip-hop, R&B and cultural icon T-Pain will perform on Thursday, June 15 following the Twins' 6:10 p.m. home game vs. the Detroit Tigers, while record-setting country music singer-songwriter Carly Pearce will take the stage after the 6:10 p.m. Twins vs. Texas Rangers contest on Thursday, August 24...both artists will perform full 75-minute sets, with their respective concerts beginning approximately 20 minutes after that evening's game ends...admission to the T-Pain postgame concert on June 15 and the Carly Pearce postgame show on August 24 are free with a ticket to those respective Twins games.

LAST START: Earned his second win of the season in a 2-0 Twins victory against the Cleveland Guardians at Progressive Field on May 5, opposite Peyton Battenfield...pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one batter and struck out six...marked Ober's second longest outing of his career and his longest outing since September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL when he tossed 7.1 innings...received two runs of support via a two-run homer by Max Kepler in the top of the sixth inning...relieved by Jorge López in the eighth inning as he combined with Joao Duran to pitch two scoreless innings...Duran earned his seventh save of the season.

- ☞ Has allowed one-or-fewer runs in all three of his starts...currently holds the second-longest streak in the Twins rotation this season of starts with one run or less, trailing Sonny Gray's six-game streak from April 1 to April 30.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in a 3-2 Twins defeat against the Kansas City Royals at Target Field on April 29, opposite Brad Keller...pitched 5.2 innings, allowed one run, walked two batters, and fanned six...marked Ober's most strikeouts since September 27, 2022 when he fanned a career-high 10 batters against Chicago-AL...his lone blemish came in the fifth inning when he yielded a game-tying RBI single to Nicky Lopez...lifted from the game in the sixth inning with two outs after allowing a single to Nick Pratto...relieved by Caleb Thielbar, followed by Griffin Jax, Jorge López and Joao Duran...López allowed a RBI single to the first batter he faced, Salvador Perez, in the eighth inning...the winning run scored on Duran's first wild pitch of the season in the ninth.

OBER VS. SAN DIEGO: Facing the Padres for the first time in his career...making his fourth career Interleague start, second this season...is 1-0, 3.86 ERA (14.0 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 12 strikeouts in three career Interleague starts...San Diego will be the 13th team he has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021...in 12 career starts when facing an opponent for the first time, Ober is 1-2, 4.12 ERA (54.2 IP, 25 ER) with 14 walks and 54 strikeouts...San Diego outfielder Adam Engel and infielder Xander Bogaerts are the only active Padres hitters to previously face Ober...Bogaerts went 2-for-5 across two games as a member of the Boston Red Sox while Engel went 0-for-3 as a member of the Chicago White Sox.

COMING HOME: Ober is making his third home start of the season, 18th of his career...he is 1-0, 1.59 ERA (11.1 IP, 2 ER) with five walks and 10 strikeouts in his first two home games this season...last season, he went 2-0, 3.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 28 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field.

- ☞ Ober is 5-1, 3.56 ERA (83.1 IP, 33 ER) with 22 walks and 87 strikeouts in 17 career starts at Target Field...Twins have gone 11-6 in his home starts...ranks third for the most strikeouts in their first 17 home starts with the Twins, fifth in lowest ERA and third in lowest earned runs allowed (min. 80.0 IP).
- ☞ Tied for 14th in the American League for lowest home ERA this season (min. 10.0 IP)...his .180 opponent batting average at home is tied for 20th in the AL.
- ☞ Currently has a four-game win streak at home, dating back to September 24, 2021...is 4-0, 2.66 ERA (40.2 IP, 12 ER) with 11 walks and 44 strikeouts in the eight-game span...took his last loss at home on August 17, 2021 vs. Cleveland.

THE RIGHT WAY: Right-handed hitters are batting just .111 (3-for-27) with 11 strikeouts against Ober after his first three starts of the season...left-handed hitters are hitting .200 (7-for-35) with five strikeouts...Ober issued his first walk to a left-handed hitter this season in his last start on May 5 at Cleveland...in his career, right-handed hitters are batting .217/.237/.411 with 12 doubles and 96 strikeouts against Ober...lefties are hitting .268/.332/.430 with 17 doubles and 63 strikeouts off him.

- ☞ Tied for ninth in lowest opponent batting average against righties, tied for fifth in the AL (min. 8.0 IP)...his .291 opponent OPS ranks seventh lowest in all of baseball.

ARSENAL: Ober used a four-pitch mix in his first three starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...three of Ober's six strikeouts in his last start on May 5 came from his slider and recorded his first two strikeouts from his curveball this season...also threw 40 fastballs in his last start...mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

☞ Ober ranks 15th for the lowest opponent batting average against a slider in the American League, tied for 13th against a curveball and is tied for 11th against a fastball (min. 250 pitches).

ACROSS THE RIVER: In his four starts with Triple-A Saint Paul this season, Ober went 2-1, 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 18, earned the win in 6-0 Saint Paul victory versus Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one batter and fanned six.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 4-0, 1.35 ERA // CAREER: 94-77, 3.50 ERA)

Sonny Gray is set to pitch the first game of the three-game series against the Chicago Cubs tomorrow at Target Field...did not factor his last start May 6 against Cleveland in a 4-3 Twins defeat at Progressive Field; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...brought his ERA to 1.35, which leads baseball...last faced Chicago-NL September 6, 2021 as a member of Cincinnati, taking the loss at Wrigley Field in a Reds 4-3 defeat; pitched 5.0 innings...allowed five hits, three runs (2 earned) and struck out eight batters...career 4-3, 3.11 ERA (55.0 IP, 19 ER) in 10 career starts vs. the Cubs.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
