THE TWINS: After completing their last six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Chicago-AL, and 1-2 at Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game Interleague homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Padres this week...

TWINS TAKE SERIES OVER SAN DIEGO: The Twins beat the Padres yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-3, winning the three-game series and improving to 6-5-1 in series play (5-1-0 at Target Field)...

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starters have combined to go 14-9, 3.13 ERA (216.0 IP, 75 ER) with 54 walks, 240 strikeouts and a .221 opponent batting average...

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins have gone 4-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 1-2 vs. Washington from April 21-23 and 2-1 vs. San Diego...after this series, the Twins will continue their IL schedule with three at Los Angeles from Monday-Wednesday...

TWINS-CUBS: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the first time since 2021 when they went 2-2...they were swept in two games at Target Field from August 31-September 1 and swept the Cubs in two games at Wrigley Field from September 21-22...

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 47 times on the season, the sixth most in the AL and ninth most in baseball...37 of their home runs have come in their last 26 games since April 13...

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Twins relievers have combined to post a .211 opponent batting average, tied with the Cubs for the second lowest in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (.203)...

OK AK: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Alex Kirilloff has hit .333 (4-for-12) with six walks, a .556 on-base percentage and an .889 OPS in five games...

LOW ON LEFTIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for just the seventh time this season, the previous six being Jesús Luzardo on April 5 at Miami (5-2 loss), Nestor Cortes on April 14 at New York-AL (4-3 win), Chris Sale on April 18 at Boston (5-4 loss), Patrick Corbin on April 23 vs. Washington (3-1 win), Cortes again on April 25 (6-2 win) and Logan Allen on May 6 at Cleveland (4-3 loss)...

LATE IN THE GAME 'LOS: Carlos Correa is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with a .976 OPS in innings 7-9, compared to .127 (7-for-55) with a .450 OPS in innings 1-3 and .167 (7-for-42) with a .405 OPS in innings 4-6...

MINOR MOVES: Right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez was returned from his rehab assignment today, reinstated from the 15-day Injured List and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...

- Enters today leading all qualified major league pitchers in ERA...also ranks fourth in FIP (2.11), behind Arizona's Zac Gallen (1.66), Atlanta's Spencer Strider (1.79) and Texas' Nathan Eovaldi (1.98).
- Making his 255th career appearance and 246th career start.
- Facing Chicago-NL for the first time this season, 11th in his career; is 4-3, 3.11 ERA (55.0 IP, 19 ER) with 13 walks and 70 strikeouts.
- Making eighth start of the year and fifth at home...is 7-2, 2.14 ERA (92.2 IP, 22 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in 17 home starts since joining the Twins.
- Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision against the Cleveland Guardians on May 6 at Progressive Field...pitched 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts in a 4-3 Twins loss, opposite Logan Allen...marked the first start Gray has allowed more than one run this season...retired nine of the first 10 batters he faced...allowed all three runs in the bottom of the fourth inning...issued a walk to infielder Amed Rosario to start the inning; allowed three consecutive singles (two for RBI, one from designated hitter Josh Naylor followed by another from infielder Josh Bell)...allowed his final run on a bases-loaded walk to outfielder Myles Straw...relieved by Jorge Alcalá in the sixth inning...Twins would tie the game off of two home runs (a two-run homer by Max Kepler in the top of the sixth and a solo shot from Carlos Correa in the seventh)...Alcalá yielded the winning run to Steven Kwan in the bottom of the seventh for his first home run of the year.

☞ Brought his ERA to 1.35, the fifth lowest in Twins/Senators history in ERA through a pitcher's first seven starts of a season (since 1913, min. 30.0 IP), trailing only Walter Johnson (0.30 in 1913, 1.00 in 1918 and 1.02 in 1914) and Harry Harper in 1915 (1.35).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his fourth win of the season in the series finale against the Kansas City Royals on April 30 at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins victory, opposite Brady Singer...marked the third time this season he has pitched at least 6.0 innings (also pitched 7.0 innings vs. Houston on April 7 and 7.0 vs. New York-AL on April 24)...yielded his only run on a RBI groundout by Edward Olivares...relieved by Emilio Pagan in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings while allowing three runs (two earned)...one run scored on an error by Jorge Polanco in the seventh...Josh Winder allowed a two-RBI single to Vinnie Pasquino in the ninth.

☞ Allowed one-or-fewer runs and tossed at least 5.0 innings in his first six starts this season, tied with Ervin Santana (April 3-May 2, 2017) for the longest such streak to start the season in Twins/Senators history since 1913.

☞ The start was Gray's 30th in a Twins uniform...has a 2.56 ERA through his first 30 starts with the Twins, the third lowest ERA within a pitcher's first 30 career games as a Twin (min. 150.0 IP), behind Scott Erickson (2.31 ERA from June 25, 1990-June 2, 1991) and Dean Chance (2.52 ERA from April 13-August 22 (1), 1967).

AND THEN THERE WAS ONE: Gray is the only pitcher in the majors who has yet to allow a home run this season (min. 40.0 IP)...is the fifth pitcher in Twins history to allow zero home runs through their first seven games...the longest streak from a Twins starter is Frankie Rodriguez at eight games and 45.1 IP in 1995.

AGAINST CHICAGO-NL: Gray is facing the Cubs for the 11th time in his career, going 4-3, 3.11 ERA (55.0 IP, 19 ER) with 13 walks and 70 strikeouts in his 10 previous appearances...last faced Chicago-NL on September 6, 2021 at Wrigley Field, taking the 4-3 Reds loss after allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR) with eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings...was relieved in the sixth inning by Lucas Sims as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings.

☞ Ranks fifth in lowest ERA (3.11) against the Cubs since 2016 (min. 50.0 IP), trailing Joe Musgrove (2.05), Miles Mikolas (2.18), Jacob DeGrom (2.29) and Brent Suter (2.73)...is tied for 11th for the most strikeouts (70) against the Cubs, alongside Jacob DeGrom.

☞ Has made six starts against the Cubs at home...is 3-1, 2.12 ERA (34.0 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks and 41 strikeouts in those starts...holding a three-game win streak against the Cubs at home...is 3-0, 1.13 ERA (24.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts in the four-game span.

☞ His .183 opponent batting average vs. the Cubs is his third lowest against any opponent in his career.

☞ Gray is 12-8, 3.43 ERA (186.1 IP, 71 ER) with 60 walks and 183 strikeouts in 32 career Interleague games (31 starts).

HOME SWEET HOME: Gray is making his fifth home start of the season tonight, going 3-0, 0.72 ERA (25.0 IP, 2 ER) with six walks, 33 strikeouts and a .172 (15-for-87) opponent batting average in his four prior home outings...went 4-3, 2.66 ERA (67.2 IP, 20 ER) with 25 walks and 78 strikeouts in 13 home starts in 2022 and is 53-38, 3.74 ERA (753.1 IP, 33 ER) with 253 walks and 734 strikeouts in 133 career home appearances, including 129 starts.

☞ Is 7-2, 2.14 ERA (92.2 IP, 22 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in 17 home starts since becoming a Twin...ranks second for the most strikeouts in their first 17 home starts in Twins/Senators history, trailing Dave Boswell (114 in 1964), ranks eighth in lowest ERA (min. 90 IP).

☞ Ranks fourth in lowest home ERA this season, trailing Arizona's Zac Gallen (0.33), Detroit's Eduardo Rodriguez (0.42) and Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw (0.45)...ranks 10th for the most home strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...continues to use his curveball the most at 26.0 percent...primarily uses his curveball (107 pitches) and changeup (419 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (104 pitches), sinker (88 pitches) and sweeper (91 pitches) against righties...allowed his first hit off his changeup in his last start on May 5...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

- Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

THIS IS THE (RIGHT) WAY: So far this season, Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to left-handed hitters...Gray has held righties to a .176 (15-for-85) batting average with six doubles and 36 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are batting .230 (14-for-61) with four doubles and 11 strikeouts...since becoming a Twin, lefties are slashing .208/.259/.307 against him while righties are batting .226/.307/.347.
 ☞ Ranks fourth among American League pitchers in opponent batting average against righties, tied for eighth in all of baseball...also tied for 11th for the most strikeouts against righties, tied for sixth in the AL.

IN THE NIGHT: Gray is making his fourth night start of the season...is 1-0, 2.12 ERA (17.0 IP, 4 ER) with seven walks and 21 strikeouts in his three previous night starts...went 4-3, 3.03 ERA (74.1 IP, 25 ER) with 25 walks and 75 strikeouts in 14 night starts last season and is 57-50, 3.66 ERA (895.2 IP, 364 ER) with 326 walks and 878 strikeouts in 158 career night appearances including 153 starts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2023 SEASON: 5-1, 2.45 ERA // CAREER: 20-10, 3.39 ERA)
