Emilio Pagán, Brock Stewart and Jorge López all combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings of relief...the offense recorded six hits, two from Joey Gallo, who singled and doubled...Carlos Correa went 1 -for-4 with a go-ahead two-run double with two outs in the seventh inning.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starters have combined to go 14-9, 3.13 ERA (216.0 IP, 75 ER) with 54 walks, 240 strikeouts and a . 221 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in all of baseball:

 walks allowed, 18 th in fielding independent pitching, 12th in WHPP, 24th in strikeouts and 16th in OPS.
NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins have gone 4-5 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 1-2 vs. Washington from April 21-23 and 2-1 vs. San Diego...atter this series, the Twins will continue their IL schedule with three at Los Angeles from Monday-Wednesday क The Twins went 8-12 against the National League last season...for the first time in 2023 the Twins will play each of the 15 National League teams...Minnesota's remaining 2023 Interleague home schedule includes Target Field visits from the Giants (May 22-24), Brewers (June 13-14), Diamondbacks (August 4-6), Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September -10).the Twins will also play road games at the Dodgers (May (15-17) Braves June
26-28), Cardinals (August 1-3), Phillies (August 11-13), Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies' (September 29-0ctober 1).

TWINS-CUBS: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the first time since 2021 when they went $2-2$...they were swept in two games at Target Field from August 31-September 1 and swept the cubs in wo games at wrigley Field rom Septembe ${ }^{17-22}$...the Twins are 17-20 all-time against the Cubs, going 3-5 at Target Field, 8-12 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at 2015 and 2021) as Chicago has won four straight in this ballpark...the last Twins win over the Cubs at Target Field was on June 19, 2015, a 7-2 victory.
$\Phi$ Max Kepler is hitting . 419 (13-for-31)' with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and a 1.244 OPS in nine career games vs. the Cubs...he had a two-homer game at Wrigley Field when these two last met on September 22, 2021....additionally, in his last four games vs. the Cubs, he has three three-hit games.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 47 times on the season, the sixth most in the AL and ninth most in baseball... 37 of their home runs have come in their last 26 games since April 13 ...since that date, their 36 homers are second most in the AL (Tampa Bay - 46 )
and fifth most in baseball, tralling Tampa (46), Atlanta (44), Los Angeles-NL (40) and San and fifth most in baseball, trailing tampa (46), Atlanta (44), Los Angeles-NL (40) and San
$\Phi$ Byron Buxton ranks tied for seventh in the AL in homers with eight....among AL players with a minimum of 80 plate appearances, Gallo ranks third in at-bats-per-home run ratio at 11.43 , trailing Brent Rooker (10.80) and Luke Raley (11.13).

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Twins relievers have combined to post a 211 opponent batting average, tied with the Cubs for the second lowest in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (.203).. they have allowed just 97 hits this season, the second fewest in baseball, tralling Texas (96).
$\Phi$ The Twins'"pen has held opponents to a. 183 average on breaking pitches ( 8 th in baseball).
OK AK: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, Alex Kirilloff has hit. 333 ( 4 -for-12) with six walks, a 556 on-base percentage and an . 889 OPS in five games...in his last 15 games between Triple-A (April 18-May 4) and Minnesota (May 6-11), he has combined to hit .320 ( 16 -for- 50 ) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 12 walks, a 469 on-base percentage and a 1.009 OPS.
LOW ON LEFTIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for just the seventh time this season, the previous six being Jesús Luzardo on April 5 at Miami ( $5-2$ loss), Nestor Cortes on April 14 at New York-AL (4-3 win), Chris Sale on'April 18 at Boston ( $5-4$ loss), Patrick Corbin on April 23 vs. Washington (3-1 win), Cortes again on April 25 ( $6-2$ win) and Logan Allen on May 6 at Cleveland (4-3 loss)...the Twins have the fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at just 246 .
玉 Twins are slashing just .203/.280/.362 vs. lefties, compared to $.224 / .306 / .391$ vs. righties
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting. 467 (7-for-15) with an . 800 OPS against left-handed pitching this season
In his last 3 g games against lett-handed pitching (since August 9, 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting . 314 ( 22 -for-70) with five doubles,
one triple, five home runs, 14 RB , 13 walks, a 407 on-base percentage, a 629 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS...however Correa is 0 -for-his-last-1 vs. lefties, his last hit being a single on April 22 vs. Washington's Anthony Banda

LATE IN THE GAME 'LOS: Carlos Correa is hitting . 344 (11-for-32) with a . 976 OPS in innings 7-9, compared to .127 (7-for-55) with a .450 OPS in innings 1-3 and .167 (7-for-42) with a . 405 OPS in innings 4-6...in his last two games, Correa has reached base four times in nine plate appearances overall, with two doubles and three RBI.

AGAINST CHICAGO－NL：Gray is facing the Cubs for the 11th time in his career，going 4－3，3．11 ERA （55．0 IP，19 ER）with 13 walks and 70 strikeouts in his 10 previous appearances．．．last faced Chicago－ NL on September 6， 2021 at Wrigley Field，taking the 4－3 Reds loss after allowing two runs on three hits（ $1 / H R$ ）with eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings．．．was relieved in the sixth inning by Lucas Sims as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings．
