MIND YOUR P'S AND Q'S, BUSTER, AND REMEMBER WHO YOU'RE DEALIN' WITH: The Twins have gone 2-2 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 against San Diego this week, followed by a loss to the Cubs last night...this afternoon, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three against Chicago-NL...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to southern California to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Dodgers from Monday-Wednesday (off-day Thursday) and three against the Angels from Friday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 12-8 at Target Field and 9-10 on the road.

LIFE MOVES PRETTY FAST: The Twins lost to the Cubs last night at Target Field by a score of 6-2...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow five runs on seven hits in 3.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded just four hits, two going for extra-bases as Carlos Correa (8) and Willi Castro (3) each doubled...the attendance was announced at 30,037, the second-highest for the Twins this season, trailing their Home Opener crowd of 38,465 on April 7 vs. Houston.

RELIEVER'S DAY OFF: Twins starters have thrown an MLB-best 221.1 innings pitched...they have averaged 5.3 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022...they have combined to go 14-9, 3.09 ERA (221.1 IP, 76 ER) with 55 walks, 249 strikeouts and a .221 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in all of baseball:

LÓPEZ...GRAY...RYAN...RYAN...RYAN...RYAN, ANYONE? RYAN...: Pablo López, Sonny Gray and Joe Ryan have combined to go 11-3, 2.47 ERA (138.2 IP, 38 ER) with 36 walks, 165 strikeouts and an opponent batting average of .204 (103-for-504)...below are their individual numbers and AL ranks among starters:

IF YOU NEED ANYTHING, CALL (ST. PAUL). RINGY DINGY: The Twins have made the following roster moves this morning:

Placed outfielder Max Kepler on the 10-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain...Kepler hit .212 (21-for-99) with five doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI and 10 walks in 28 games for the Twins this season...this is his second stint on the IL, after also missing time from April 8-April 15 with right patellar tendinitis...to replace Kepler on the 26-man roster, will be outfielder Trevor Larnach...Larnach has gone 7-for-14 with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI and three walks in four games for the Saints, after being optioned to St. Paul on May 5...this is his second stint with the Twins this season (previously, Opening Day-May 5).

Recalled right-handed pitcher Cole Sands from Triple-A St. Paul...Sands, 25, has gone 0-1, 2.63 ERA (13.2 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 16 strikeouts and a .163 (8-for-49) opponent batting average in seven relief appearances for the Saints...this is his second stint with the Twins this season, after previously making the club's Opening Day roster and being optioned to St. Paul on April 14. Sands has posted a 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER) with three strikeouts in two major league outings this year...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Dereck Rodriguez to St. Paul.

SAUSAGE KINGS OF CHICAGO: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 39th time in their history...the Twins are 17-21 all-time against the Cubs, going 3-6 at Target Field, 8-12 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...this series marks the fourth time the Cubs have visited Target Field (2012, 2015 and 2021), as Chicago has won five straight games in this ballpark...the last Twins win over the Cubs at Target Field was on June 19, 2015, a 7-2 victory.

THEY ALL ADORE HIM, THEY THINK HE'S A RIGHTEOUS DUDE: Joe Ryan is making his third career start against the Cubs, his last coming on September 22, 2021, striking out a career-high 11 in 5.0 innings pitched...he became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (since 1901) to strike out 11 batters in a start of 5.0 innings-or-less...today marks Ryan's first start vs. an NL opponent since August 26, 2022 vs. San Francisco, when he pitched 6.0 shutout two-hit innings in a Twins 9-0 victory.

RELAX, YOU HAVE NOTHING TO WORRY ABOUT, WE'RE PROFESSIONALS: The Twins have gone 4-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami from April 3-5, 1-2 vs. Washington from April 21-23, 2-1 vs. San Diego and 0-1 vs. Chicago-NL...after this series, the Twins will continue their IL schedule with three at Los Angeles from Monday-Wednesday.

I'LL GO, I'LL GO, I'LL GO, I'LL GO, I'LL GO: The Twins have stolen 10 bases on the season, seven coming in their last 11 games...they have been caught five times overall...10 steals are the fewest in baseball...by comparison, the Cubs rank sixth in baseball with 35...in 2022, the Twins stole 38 bags, the fewest in baseball.

SOMETHING D-O-O ECONOMICS...VOO DU(RAN) ECONOMICS: Jhoan Duran has thrown 97 of his 232 pitches at least 100 mph, second most in baseball trailing St. Louis' Jordan Hicks (135)...he has thrown 24 pitches at least 102 mph (Hicks - 36)...since the start of last season, he has thrown 489 pitches of 1.255 total pitches 100-plus, the most in baseball, next being Hunter Greene with 418. Since the start of 2022, Duran's 1.86 ERA ranks fifth best among AL relievers (minimum of 75.0 IP) and seventh best in MLB.

NINE (TEEN) TIMES...NINE (TEEN) TIMES: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Alex Kirilloff has hit .308 (4-for-13) with six walks, a .526 on-base percentage and an .834 OPS in six games...in his last 16 games among Triple-A (April 18-May 4) and Minnesota (May 6-12), he has combined to hit .314 (16-for-51) with two doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 12 walks, a .462 on-base percentage and a .991 OPS.

WHAT'S THE SCORE?...NOTHIN' NOTHIN'...WHO'S WINNING?...THE BEARS: The Twins have a run differential of +20 (164-144), tied with Boston for the sixth best in the American League, trailing Tampa Bay's +120 (244-124), Texas' +84 (238-154), Baltimore's +32 (198-166), Houston's +25 (166-141) and Seattle's +21 (166-145)...they rank fifth in all of baseball in runs allowed but tied for 21st in runs scored.

WHO DO YOU LOVE?! YOU LOVE A CAR(LOS)!: Carlos Correa is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with a .947 OPS in innings 7-9, compared to .140 (8-for-57) with a .485 OPS in innings 1-3 and .163 (7-for-43) with a .625 OPS in innings 4-6. In his last three games overall, Correa has reached base five times in 13 plate appearances (.385 OBP), with three doubles and three RBI. Correa has doubled in three-straight games, tying his career long for a doubles streak, done four times previously, last from April 1-3, 2019...his career long for an extra-base hit streak is six, coming April 19-24, 2019 with Houston.

THE PLACE IS A MUSEUM, IT'S VERY BEAUTIFUL AND VERY COLD, AND YOU'RE NOT ALLOWED TO TOUCH ANYTHING: The Twins have gone 12-8 at home this season, tied for fifth-most home wins in baseball...they have gone 5-1-0 in series play at Target Field in 2023, their one series defeat coming April 21-23, dropping two of three to Washington. Since the start of last season, the Twins have gone 58-43 at Target Field, the fourth-most home wins in the AL, trailing New York (72-33), Tampa Bay (70-33) and Houston (63-37).

DO YOU REALIZE IF WE PLAYED BY THE RULES, RIGHT NOW WE'D BE IN GYM: With 2023 new pitch clock rules in play, the Twins have an average time of game of 2 hours and 33 minutes, the fastest in the league...their average time of game in 2022 was 3:07 (12th slowest in baseball), a difference of 34 minutes from this year to last.

- ☞ Making his eighth start and appearance of 2023 and his third home start of the year...also his 40th career start and appearance.
- ☞ Facing Chicago-NL for the third time in his career and first time since September 22, 2021...is 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks and 16 strikeouts in two previous starts vs. the Cubs.
- ☞ Lost his last start, snapping a 10-start span in which he won a career-best eight-consecutive decisions; went 8-0, 2.06 ERA (56.2 IP, 13 ER) from September 13, 2022 to April 25, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his first loss of the 2023 season and snapped his career-long streak of eight-consecutive winning decisions on May 7 at Cleveland in a 2-0 Twins defeat...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs and a season-high eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts...allowed both runs in the first inning on four singles; infielder José Ramírez and designated hitter Josh Bell each recorded RBI singles against Ryan...retired 15 of 17 batters from the bottom of the first inning to the bottom of the sixth...stranded two runners in the sixth inning by striking out outfielder Will Brennan to end his outing...Emilio Pagan and Brock Stewart each recorded scoreless innings out of the Twins bullpen but Minnesota had only one hit against three Guardians pitchers in the shutout loss...marked Ryan's first loss since September 7, 2022 at New York-AL...Twins have lost Ryan's last two starts after winning his previous nine outings from September 13, 2022 to April 25, 2023.

☞ Has not allowed a home run in his last three starts...last allowed a homer in the sixth inning on April 19 at Boston to Kiké Hernández...looking to match his career-long streak today of four games without allowing a homer, done twice previously (9/13-20/2022, 4/21-5/10/2022).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 3-2 defeat in 10 innings at the Chicago White Sox on May 2, opposite right-hander Michael Kopech...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, allowed just one hit, issued two walks and struck out seven...his only hit allowed was a second-inning single to Gavin Sheets...Sheets reached second on a wild pitch and was the only runner to reach scoring position against Ryan...retired 12 of the final 13 batters he faced, inducing an inning-ending double play from outfielder Andrew Benintendi in the bottom of the sixth inning to complete his outing...left with Minnesota leading 1-0, but the Twins bullpen allowed three runs (2 earned) in 3.2 innings to drop the series opener.

☞ Marked his fourth career start allowing one-or-fewer hits, also doing so on September 13, 2022 vs. Kansas City (7.0 IP, 0 H), April 27, 2022 vs. Detroit (7.0 IP, 1 H) and September 8, 2021 at Cleveland (7.0 IP, 1 H).

LEAGUE LEADER: Despite losing his last start at Cleveland on May 7, Ryan remains one of the top starting pitchers in the American League in several statistical categories...here are his numbers through seven starts and how they rank among qualified AL pitchers:

VS. THE CUBS: Today is Ryan's third career start vs. Chicago-NL and first since the 2021 season...went 1-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER) with two walks and 16 strikeouts in his two previous starts against the Cubs...made his major league debut vs. Chicago-NL at Target Field on September 1, 2021, taking the loss in a 3-0 Twins defeat; pitched 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on three hits with one walk and five strikeouts...earned the win in his last start against the Cubs on September 22, 2021 at Wrigley Field, a 5-4 Twins victory; went 5.0 innings with two runs and three hits allowed, one walk and a career-high 11 strikeouts...became the first pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with 11 strikeouts in a complete start of 5.0 innings-or-less.

☞ In three career starts vs. National League Central opponents (CHC & MIL), Ryan is 1-1, 3.52 ERA (15.1 IP, 6 ER) with four walks and 19 strikeouts.

☞ Today is Ryan's eighth career Interleague start and first of the 2023 season; is 3-3, 6.00 ERA (36.0 IP, 24 ER) with 11 walks and 39 strikeouts in seven previous starts vs. the Senior Circuit.

RIGHT ON TARGET: Ryan is unbeaten at Target Field this year, going 2-0 with a 3.46 ERA (13.0 IP, 5 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average in his two home starts...making a start at Target Field for the first time since earning the win against New York-AL on April 25 (7.0 IP, 2 R, 1 ER, 7 H, 0 BB, 7 K)...in 20 career home starts, Ryan has gone 9-5, 3.50 ERA (110.2 IP, 43 ER) with 34 walks and 122 strikeouts...has similar numbers in 19 career road starts, going 11-5 with a 3.28 ERA (107.0 IP, 39 ER), 24 walks and 106 strikeouts.

☞ Since his debut in 2021, Ryan has held opposing batters to a .190 (77-for-406) batting average in home starts, the seventh-lowest opponent batting average at home in baseball during that span (min. 100.0 IP).

LEFT (AND RIGHT) OUT IN THE COLD: Left-handed hitters are batting only .183 (15-for-82) with a .501 OPS against Ryan this year...right-handed hitters are hitting .200 (16-for-80) with a .529 OPS...his .191 overall opponent batting average ranks sixth among all qualified American League pitchers this season, trailing LAA's Shohei Ohtani (.143), BAL's Tyler Wells (.169), NYY's Domingo Germán (.174) and DET's Eduardo Rodriguez (.174)...over his career, Ryan has slightly better splits against left-handed hitters than righties, with lefties batting just .192 with a .604 OPS since his debut in 2021...right-handed hitters are hitting .211 with a .640 OPS off Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first seven starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 85.7 percent of the time...opponents are batting just .190 (28-for-147) with 42 strikeouts against Ryan's four-seamer and split finger combined...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ Ryan's four-seam fastball has accumulated a run value of -.7, which ranks tied for third in baseball (min. 50 PA) with Chicago-NL's Justin Steele and Detroit's Eduardo Rodriguez, behind only Seattle's George Kirby (-8) and New York-AL's Gerrit Cole (-9).

DAYTIME JOE: After making four-straight night starts from April 13-May 2, Ryan is making his second-consecutive daytime start today and his first at Target Field since April 8 vs. Houston...has gone 2-1 in three daytime starts this season with a 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 20 strikeouts...in his career, Ryan is 8-4, 2.73 ERA (82.1 IP, 25 ER) with 23 walks, 76 strikeouts and a .189 (56-for-296) opponent batting average in 15 daytime starts...his .189 opponent batting average in day starts ranks seventh in baseball since the start of 2021 among pitchers with at least 75.0 innings pitched during the day...in 24 career nighttime starts, he is 12-6, 3.79 ERA (135.1 IP, 57 ER) with 35 walks and 152 strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP LOUIE VARLAND (2023: 0-0, 4.32 ERA // CAREER: 1-2, 4.01 ERA)

Right-hander Louie Varland is scheduled to start the three-game series finale vs. the Chicago Cubs at Target Field tomorrow afternoon...did not factor into the decision in his last start vs. San Diego on May 9, a 6-1 Twins defeat...recorded his second quality start of the season; went 6.0 innings and allowed one run on five hits, with two walks and six strikeouts...has never faced Chicago-NL in his career before and has yet to face any current Cubs hitters...making his second-straight Interleague start after facing American League teams in his first seven career major league starts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
