THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2, going 2-1 vs. San Diego last week, then 2-1 against Chicago-NL over the weekend...tonight, the Iwins will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Dodgers through Wednesday, followed by an off-day Thursday, then play three against the Angels in Anaheim from Friday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 14-8 at Target Field and 9-10 on the road.

TWINS CLEAN IT UP FOR ALL THE MOMS: The Twins celebrated Mother's Day by beating the Cubs yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 16-3, their largest margin of victory this season...Louie Varland (1-0) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded season highs in runs and hits (18)...each player in the starting lineup had a hit as seven Twins had multiple hits...additionally, seven different Twins had at least two RBI as Trevor Larnach drove in four...Larnach (4), Joey Gallo (9) and Michael A. Taylor (5) each homered.

4 The Twins won back-to-back games by at least 10 runs for the fourth time in Twins/Senators history (since 1901), previously doing so from July 9 (2)-July 10, 1932; September 14-15, 1962; and April 24-25, 1996.

4 The Twins set a Target Field record with 29 runs scored over a three-game series.

 DODGE BALL: The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 20th time in their history tonight, the Twins are 6-13 all-time; they have lost 10-straight to the Dodgers, dating back to April 30, 2014...their current losing streak is the longest active streak for the Twins against one team and longest against any team...lower right are the Twins all-time longest losing streaks to single opponents.
 ♣ Carlos Correa has hit .305 (25-for-82) with an .881 OPS in 21 career regular and Postseason games against the Dodgers...in 14 career regular season games, he has hit .321 (17-for-53) with three doubles three home runs, seven RBI and a .916 OPS.
 ♣ Joey Gallo was acquired by the Dodgers at the trade deadline last season from New York-AL, in exchange for minor league right-handed pitcher Clayton Beeter...Gallo played 44 games for the Dodgers, hitting 162 (19-for-117) with seven home runs and 23 RBI...in that span, he posted an .868 OPS in 25 games at Dodger Stadium...Gallo has reached base safely in each of his last seven games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2018, posting a .556 on-base percentage in that span, drawing at least one walk in all seven.
 ♣ Wile Farmer was drafted by the Dodgers in the eighth round of the 2013 MIB Draft out of the University of Georgia...he made his MIB debut with LA on July 30, 2017 vs. SF at Dodger Stadium, hitting a pinch-hit, walk-off two-run double in his first plate appearance...he played 59 games to rthe Dodgers in the eighth round of the 2013 MIB Draft out of the University of Georgia...he was traded by the Dodgers with Matt Kemp, Yasiel Puig, Alex Wood and cash to the Reds for Homer Bailey, Jeter Downs and Josiah Gray in December of 2018.
 LITERALLY *ONCE** UPON A TIME IN HOLLYWOOD: In the regular season, Minnesota is .1-7

LITERALLY *ONCE* UPON A TIME IN HOLLYWOOD: In the regular season, Minnesota is 1-7 all-time at Dodger Stadium, 2-6 at Target Field and 3-0 at Metrodome...the Twins only win at Dodger Stadium came on June 11, 2005, a 5-3 victory as Carlos Silva beat Derek Lowe...Justin Morneau and Torii Hunter both homered for the Twins in that game as Morneau had four RBI... they have not won here in 6,548 days, their longest drought in any ballpark in their history.

The Including the Postseason, the Twins are 1-10 all-time at Dodger Stadium, going 0-3 in this ballpark during the 1965 World Series.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins have gone 6-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego and 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL...they have gone 5-2 in their last seven vs. the NL after starting 1-4.

OFFENSIVE COORDINATORS: The Twins recorded 31 hits in their final two games against the Cubs on Saturday and Sunday...they had 34 hits in their previous six games combined, from May 6-12...in their last two games, they hit .397 (31-for-78) with 10 doubles, eight home runs, 27 RBI, 27 runs scored, a .460 on-base percentage, an .833 slugging percentage and a 1.293 OPS...despite having the third lowest team batting average in baseball (.228), the Iwins still rank 12th in baseball in runs scored (191).

CLEARING THE WALL-EYE: After hitting eight home runs in their last two games, the Twins have homered 55 times on the season, the third most in the AL and sixth most in baseball...45 of their home runs have come in their last 29 games since April 13...since that date only the Rays (51) and Braves (48) have hit more...Dodgers are fourth with 44.

♣ Tonight's starter, Pablo López, is the man behind The Land of 10,000 Rakes home run celebration "Minnesota" fishing vest...López went to a sporting goods store after a day game on April 29, buying the vest along with a Paw Patrol kids fishing pole...the next day the Twins won over the Royals 8-4 as Byron Buxton hit a 453-foot homer, becoming the first to wear the new celebration attire.

KIRILLOFF THE HOOK: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Alex Kirilloff has hit .409 (9-for-22) with six walks, a .536 on-base percentage and an 1.308 OPS in eight games...in his last 18 games between Triple-A (April 18-May 4) and Minnesota (May 6-14), he has combined to hit .350 (21-for-60) with four doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI, 12 walks, a .473 on-base percentage and a 1.140 OPS.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-long five-straight games, hitting .333 (7-for-21) with four doubles, one home run, eight RBI, two walks, a .391 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.058 OPS in that span.

♣ Correa has recorded an extra-base hit in five-straight games, doubling in three-straight from Wednesday-Friday, homering on Saturday, then doubling again yesterday afternoon... it is tied for the second-longest extra-base hit streak of his career, his career long being six, from April 19-24, 2019 with Houston.

JOEY LONGBALLS: Joey Gallo hit his team-leading ninth home run of the season yesterday...he has averaged 409 feet on his home runs this season, tied for sixth best in the AL...additionally, he has an average exit velocity of 94.8 mph, ranking fifth in baseball, trailing Yandy Díaz (95.8), Aaron Judge (95.4), Matt Chapman (95.1) and Matt Olson (95.0).

HOW DO YOU SAY HAPPY BIRTHDAY IN CANADIAN: Former Twins great and Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau is celebrating his 42nd birthday today...he played eight times on his birthday, tied with Joe Mauer, Torii Hunter and Kent Hrbek for third-most in Twins history...he hit .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, four home runs and eight RBI on his birthday...his home run and RBI totals on his birthday are most in Twins history, while his hit total is second behind only Tony Oliva (12)...he hit multiple homers on his birthday twice and is one of three players in major league history with multiple multi-homer games on his birthday, alongside Duke Snider (2) and Kirk Gibson (2)...he shares a birthday with former Twin Brian Dozier (36).

PLOUFFE! THERE HE IS!: Former Twins infielder Trevor Plouffe is making his Bally Sports North TV debut this week with the team in southern California...the West Hills, California native was selected by the Twins 20th overall in the 2004 First-Year Player Draft out of Crespi Carmelite High School in Encino, CA...he played seven seasons with the Twins from 2010-16, hitting .247 (651-for-2638) with 148 doubles, 10 triples, 96 home runs, 357 RBI, 218 walks, 332 runs scored and a .727 OPS in 723 games for Minnesota...he played 545 games at third base for the Twins, the fourth most in club history, trailing Gary Gaetti (1311), Rich Rollins (771) and Corey Koskie (762)...he still ranks near the top of several offensive categories in Target Field's history (since 2010), placing fourth in doubles (87), fifth in home runs (55), sixth in RBI (188) and walks (109), and seventh in runs scored (174).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in the Twins 4-3 victory in 11 innings vs. the San Diego Padres at Target Field on May 10...pitched opposite of right-hander Seth Lugo, who also did not factor into the decision...López went 6.1 innings, allowing one earned run and two hits, issuing a season-high four walks and striking out eight batters...issued one walk in each of his first three innings but held the Padres scoreless through his first 6.0 innings of work...allowed his first hit in the top of the fifth inning when shortstop Xander Bogaerts reached on an infield single...benefitted from two double plays, a 7-3 DP in the first inning and a 3-unassisted DP in the fourth...yielded a solo home run to leftfielder Juan Soto to lead off the seventh inning...was relieved by Brock Stewart with one out in the seventh and Minnesota leading 2-1 after López struck out Bogaerts to end his outing...San Diego evened the score at 2-2 in the eighth inning via third baseman Manny Machado's sacrifice fly off Jorge López...each team scored once in the 10th inning, and the Twins won in the 11th on a walk-off RBI single by leftfielder Alex Kirilloff.

Has recorded six-or-more strikeouts in each of his last nine starts, since October 4, 2022,

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 7-3, 12-inning win at Guaranteed Rate Field on May 4 against the Chicago White Sox...pitched 7.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on six hits with one walk and eight strikeouts...allowed a two-run home run to designated hitter Eloy Jiménez in the bottom of the third inning...stranded two runners in scoring position in the sixth inning by inducing an inning-ending groundout from infielder Elvis Andrus...retired the side in order in the seventh inning and was relieved by Jorge López in the bottom of the eighth after the Twins tied the score 2-2 on a Byron Buxton solo home run in the top of the eighth...Minnesota scored five runs in the 12th inning and five Twins relievers limited the White Sox to one unearned run over 5.0 innings pitched to close out the victory.

LOS ANGELES-NL: Facing the Dodgers for the fourth time in his career and the first time with Minnesota... is 1-0, 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts in three previous starts vs. Los Angeles-NL, all with Miami...last faced the Dodgers on August 29, 2022 at loanDepot Park, taking a no-decision in a 3-2 Marlins loss; recorded a quality start, going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on five hits, with three walks and six strikeouts...pitching at Dodger Stadium for the second time in his career; earned the win on May 16, 2021 in a 3-2 Marlins victory, pitching 5.0 innings with two runs and seven hits allowed one walk and three strikeouts. innings with two runs and seven hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts.

STARTING THE ROADTRIP: Tonight is López's fifth road start of the year...Minnesota has gone 2-2 in his four road starts this year, with López going 1-1, 1.78 ERA (25.1 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 31 strikeouts...in his four home starts this season, López has gone 1-1, 5.25 ERA (24.0 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks and 31 strikeouts, with the Twins winning three of those four starts...over his career, López is 15-17, 4.26 ERA (251.1 IP, 119 ER) with 69 walks and 252 strikeouts in 48 road starts...in 54 home starts, he is 15-16, 3.59 ERA (308.0 IP, 123 ER) with 87 walks and 299 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: López has limited left-handed hitters to a .214 (15-for-70) batting average this season... right-handed hitters are batting at a .222 (24-for-108) clip...his 40 strikeouts against righties are sixth most in the American League...overall, opposing hitters are batting .219 (39-for-178) vs. López this year, the 14th-lowest opponent batting average among qualified American League pitchers... his .220 (135-for-615) opponent batting average against right-handed hitters since the start of 2021 is 15th best in baseball (min. 600 at-bats)...over his career, he has better numbers against right handed hitters (.522 005) than loft handed hitters (.732 005) right-handed hitters (.663 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.739 OPS)

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first eight starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has exclusively used his sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball when facing left-handed hitters...threw 10 sweepers to left-handed hitters in his last start on May 10 vs. San Diego after not throwing any sweepers to lefties in his first seven starts...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

LUCRATIVE IN-VEST-MENT: López spearheaded the Twins' latest home run celebration by purchasing a fishing vest from a sporting goods store on April 29 along with a Paw Patrol kids fishing pole... since the "Land of 10,000 Rakes" vest and fishing pole first appeared in the Twins dugout on April 30, the Twins have hit 18 home runs in 13 games, including at least one homer in 10 of those 13... the 18 home runs since April 30 ranks tied for fifth in the American League.
