TWINS GONE FISHIN' IN FINALE: The Twins beat the Royals on Sunday afternoon by a score of 8-4, scoring seven runs in the third inning and taking the four-game series three games to one...Sonny Gray (4-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched...Jhoan Duran earned his sixth save (7 chances) with 0.1 inning, the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-3 with three RBI, a double (6) and a home run (7)...Buxton's homer traveled an estimated distance of 453 feet, the longest for a Twin this season, besting Michael A. Taylor's 444-foot shot on April 23 vs. Washington.

BIG THREE: Sonny Gray, Joe Ryan and Pablo López all made their case for AL Pitcher of the Month for March/April...below are their numbers last month and AL ranks among starters:

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE: The Twins are playing a series against an AL Central opponent for the fourth time this season...in their previous three AL Central series, they swept the Royals in three games (March 30-April 2), took two of three from Chicago (April 10-12) and took three of four from KC (April 27-30).

After three games in Cleveland this weekend, they will not play another team within the division until hosting the Guardians for four games from June 1-4.

DEEP DISH: Twins and White Sox are playing the fourth of 13 meetings this season...these two played a three-game series at Target Field from April 10-12 as the Twins won the second and third games...since 2015, the Twins have gone 80-66 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Joey Gallo is hitting 324 (11-for-34) with four home runs, seven walks, and a 1.115 OPS in his last nine games vs. the Sox — all at Guaranteed Rate Field.

♣ Byron Buxton has 16 career home runs and 39 RBI against the Sox (his most against any opponent), including nine homers and 16 RBI in his last 15 games.

♣ Buxton is hitting 370 (27-for-73) with four doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 17 RBI, an 822 slugging percentage and a 1.225 OPS in his last 19 games vs. the Sox.

♣ Christian Vázquez is hitting .358 (38-for-106) with five doubles, one home run, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .409 on-base percentage and an .843 OPS in 34 career games vs. the Sox.

BUT THERE'S NO GUARANTEE ON THE BOX: The Twins went 4-5 at Guaranteed Rate Field last season and outscored the Sox 45-44...since 2019, no opponent has homered in this ballpark more than the Twins, with 70 (next is Kansas City with 42).

◆ Jorge Polanco is hitting, 329 (27-for-82) with three doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.045 OPS in his last 21 games on the South Side...Polo's 14 career homers and 41 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

◆ Christian Vázquez is hitting. 431 (22-for-51) with a 1.031 OPS in 17 career games at Guaranteed Rate...in his last 11 games here, he has reached base 22 times in 35 plate appearances (.629 OBP)...two of his six four-hit games (career high) have come in this ballpark.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered in a season-long 13-straight games, since

April 18... since that date, they have hit 22 home runs, the third most in baseball in that span, trailing Tampa Bay (24) and San Francisco
(23)....the current streak is the second longest of 2023, trailing the Rays' stretch of 22-straight to begin the season (March 30-April 23).

Their current stretch is the club's longest since May 20-June 5, 2021, when they homered in 16 straight...in fact, the lwins/Senators franchise record (since 1901) is 16, done four times: 2021, 2017 (2x) and 1979.

Byron Buxton gave the Twins their ninth three-run homer of the season on Sunday afternoon...the nine three-run jimmy jacks are second most in baseball, trailing lexas (10)...Joey Gallo and Buxton each have three, tied fourth others for most in baseball (Rooker, Bichette, Maton and Heim)...for context, the Twins have 19 solo shots and 10 two-run homers.

BUCK TRUCK HORN STARTING TO MAKE NOISE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in a season-long five-straight games and in nine of his last 10, since April 19...in that span, he is hitting .308 (12-for-39) with five doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, a .372 on-base percentage, an .821 slugging percentage and a 1.193 OPS...in the last 10 days (since April 22), only Brent Rooker has as many homers as Buxton (5).

DOWN ON THE FARM: Infielder Kyle Farmer began his rehab assignment today with Triple-A St. Paul at CHS Field against Nashville...Farmer went 0-for-3 and played seven innings at second base...Farmer went on the 10-day Injured List on April 13 and has missed the club's last 17 games with a facial laceration, an injury he sustained on April 12 vs. the White Sox after getting struck in the face by a pitch from Lucas Giolito.

FIVE IN A ROW: Ryan has won his first five starts of the 2023 season, becoming just the seventh pitcher in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) to accomplish the feat and the first since Jerry Koosman went 5-0 in his first five starts of the 1979 season. LAST TIME OUT: Won his fifth-straight start of the 2023 season and his eighth-consecutive decision in the Twins 6-2 victory vs. the New York Yankees at Target Field on April 25...went 7.0 innings for the second time this year, allowing a season-high seven hits but only two runs (1 earned) with no walks and seven strikeouts...opposed left-hander Nestor Cortes, who took his first loss of the season...Ryan yielded a RBI single to infielder DJ LeMahieu in the top of the first inning, his first run allowed in the first inning in 2023 and marking the first time he pitched with the Twins trailing this year...allowed an unearned run in the fifth inning when first baseman Donovan Solano committed an error on a potential inning-ending double play...recorded seven strikeouts without issuing a walk in a start of at least 7.0 innings for the second time in his career, the only other being his previous start vs. New York-AL on April 13, 2023 at Yankee Stadium (7.0 IP, 0 BB, 10 K)...received six runs of support and currently leads baseball with 38 runs of support in his five starts.

Ryan became the first five-game winner in baseball this year and is joined by New York-AL's Gerrit Cole, Los Angeles-NL's Clayton Kershaw and Tampa Bay's Shane McClanahan as the only pitchers with five victories in 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Extended his career-long winning streak to seven games, earning the victory in the Twins 10-4 win at the Boston Red Sox on April 19...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, issuing one walk with three strikeouts...allowed one run in the third, fifth and sixth innings, including a solo home run to infielder Kiké Hernández in the sixth...opposed right-hander Corey Kluber, who took the loss...10 runs of support were the second most of Ryan's career, trailing only his previous start on April 13 at New York-AL (11)...his three strikeouts tied six other starts for the second fewest in his career and is the lowest total in his 15 career quality starts.

LEAGUE LEADER: Ryan's numbers in April support his case to be considered for American League Pitcher of the Month, along with his rotation mates Sonny Gray and Pablo López...here are some relevant statistics from his first five starts and where he ranks among qualifying American League starters through April 30.

WIN STREAK BY THE NUMBERS: In his last nine starts dating back to September 13, 2022, Ryan is 8-0, 2.06 ERA (56.2 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks and 63 strikeouts...opponents are slashing .169/.223/.254 against Ryan during the win streak, and his .477 opponent OPS is the second lowest in baseball in that stretch among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings pitched (Shohei Ohtani - .398)...the span marks the longest win streak of Ryan's career and is the longest win streak by a Twins starter since Michael Pineda went 8-0 in a 16-start stretch from July 21, 2019-April 15, 2021.

20 GAME WINNER: Ryan recorded his 20th career win in his 37th career start on April 25 vs. New York-AL, becoming the fourth pitcher in franchise history (since 1901) to win 20 games in the first 37 games of his career and the first since Scott Erickson went 21-7 through his first 37 games from June 25, 1990 to July 20, 1991...Ryan's 217 strikeouts are the most in franchise history through the first 37 games of a career, and his 3.50 ERA ranks 16th under those same parameters (since 1913).

LIGHTLY WORN SOX: Tonight is Ryan's second career start vs. Chicago-AL and his first start vs. the White Sox since July 6, 2022 at Guaranteed Rate Field...pitched four innings, allowing five hits and three runs (2 earned) with two walks and three strikeouts...allowed a solo home run to Eloy Jiménez in the bottom of the fourth inning...at the time was just his third career start of 4.0 innings-or-fewer and is now tied with four other starts for the shortest start of his career...Chicago-AL is the only American League Central division team he has yet to defeat, with Ryan going 12-0, 1.70 ERA (90.0 IP, 17 ER) with 18 walks and 96 strikeouts in 15 starts against the other three AL Central teams in his career.

RYAN ON THE ROAD: In 17 career road starts, Ryan is 11-4 with a 3.51 ERA (95.0 IP, 37 ER), 22 walks and 95 strikeouts...has similar numbers in 20 home starts, going 9-5, 3.50 ERA (110.2 IP, 43 ER) with 34 walks and 122 strikeouts...this season, he is 3-0 away from Target Field with a 2.37 ERA (19.0 IP, 5 ER), three walks, 19 strikeouts and a .176 opponent batting average...his .222 opponent on-base percentage in road starts is best in baseball among pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched on the road.

The Since his debut in 2021, Ryan has held opposing batters to a .215 (76-for-353) batting average in road starts, the eighth-lowest opponent batting average on the road in the American League during that span (min. 75.0 IP).

LEFT/RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting .155 (9-for-55) against Ryan this year...right-handed hitters are hitting .217 (13-for-60) with 22 strikeouts...his .186 overall opponent batting average ranks ninth in baseball this season (min. 30.0 IP)...over his career, Ryan has slightly better splits against left-handed hitters than righties, with lefties batting just .188 with a .609 OPS since his debut in 2021...right-handed hitters are hitting .214 with a .652 OPS off Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a three-pitch mix in his first five starts of the 2023 season...has used his four-seam fastball the most of his three pitches, throwing it 58.3 percent of the time...threw only four sweepers in last start on April 25 vs. New York-AL after averaging 15 sweepers per game in his first four starts...recorded five of his seven strikeouts with the four-seamer in his last start against the Yankees... here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:
