THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing back-to-back lefties here in Anaheim (Detmers last night), marking their first time facing two southpaws in a series since September 30-October 2, 2022 at Detroit...

BUCK TRUCK REVVING THE ENGINE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in five-straight games, hitting .364 (8-for-22) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, two walks, seven runs scored, two stolen bases...

WILLI GOIN' WILD: Willi Castro has hit safely in eight consecutive starts, a streak that goes back to April 30... in that span, he is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and five stolen bases...

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis went 3-for-4 with two solo home runs yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul at Columbus... he is now hitting .444 (8-for-18) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI and three stolen bases...

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season and his first career win at Target Field in a 16-3 Twins victory against the Chicago Cubs on May 14, opposite Marcus Stroman...pitched a career-high 6.1 innings, allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...permitted his first run on a solo home run to outfielder Christopher Morel in the top of the fourth inning...allowed a solo home run to outfielder Seiya Suzuki in the top of the seventh inning and was lifted from the game after walking Irey Mancini with one out in the frame...relieved by Emilio Pagán, who allowed the inherited runner to score on infielder Nick Madrigal's RBI single; Twins bullpen pitched the final 2.2 innings without allowing a run of its own...Varland received a season-high eight runs of support, the second most he has received in his career (10 at Chicago-AL on October 5, 2022)...threw a career-high 97 pitches...Twins offense set season highs with 16 runs and 18 hits in the victory.

⌘ Varland has recorded at least six strikeouts in each of his first four starts of the season... tied with Johan Santana's 2002 season for the fourth-longest streak of starts with six-or-more strikeouts to start a season in Twins history (1961-present), trailing Pablo López's streak of eight from March 30 to May 10 of this year and two other Santana streaks (8 in 2005, 6 in 2007).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision despite recording his second career quality start in a 6-1 Twins loss against the San Diego Padres at Target Field on May 9, opposite Michael Wacha...allowed only one run on five hits, walked two batters and struck out six over 6.0 innings of work...retired nine of the first 12 batters he faced...yielded his only run via a RBI single by designated hitter Matt Carpenter in the top of the fourth inning to score outfielder Juan Soto...relieved by Griffin Jax in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings while allowing five runs...Jax permitted the first two runs in the seventh inning; catcher Austin Nola brought in the first run via a sacrifice bunt, Jax then issued a bases-loaded walk to Jake Cronenworth...Jorge Alcala yielded the last three runs via a three-run homer from infielder Manny Machado.

STRIKEOUTS THROUGH NINE: Varland has recorded 48 strikeouts in 49.0 innings pitched through his first nine major league starts...his 48 strikeouts are the third most in Twins history (since 1961) through a pitcher's first nine games of his career, trailing Bert Blyleven (50 in 1970) and Joe Ryan (55 from 2021-22)...he has also recorded three-or-more strikeouts in each of his nine career games, the third-longest streak by a Twins pitcher to begin his career (Jim Merritt, 10 games in 1965; Joe Ryan, 15 games from 2021-22).

LOUIE VS. LAA: Facing the Angels for the second time in his career...last faced Los Angeles-AL on September 23, 2022 at Target Field, taking the loss in a 4-2 Twins defeat; pitched 5.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...allowed two solo home runs to outfielder Taylor Ward and a RBI single to outfielder Mike Trout...held 2022 American League MVP runner-up Shohei Ohtani without a hit in three at-bats...was relieved by Trevor Megill with two outs in the sixth inning and the Twins trailing 3-1...the one run of support was the second lowest for Varland in 2022 (0 R on September 17, 2022 at Cleveland).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Following two-straight home starts, Varland is making his third road start of the season and sixth of his career...is 0-0, 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 14 strikeouts in two road starts this year, with the Twins going 1-1 in those games...last pitched on the road May 3 at Chicago-AL, taking a no-decision in a 6-4 Twins defeat; went 4.2 innings, allowing four earned runs on seven hits, with two walks and six strikeouts...seeking his first road win since earning his first career victory on October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 0 R/ER, 4 H, 0 BB, 5 K)...in his five career road starts, Varland is 1-1, 4.50 ERA (26.0 IP, 13 ER) with six walks and 29 strikeouts...by comparison, is 1-1, 3.52 ERA (23.0 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 19 strikeouts in four career starts at Target Field.

⌘ Making his first career appearance and start at Angel Stadium, marking the fifth ballpark he has pitched at in his career and the first time he has pitched at a new venue this season...is 1-2, 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts in four previous starts when pitching at a new ballpark...also marks his first career appearance and start in the Pacific Time Zone.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Through his first four starts this season, left-handed hitters are batting .300 (9-for-30) with 10 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are hitting .220 (13-for-59) with 17 strikeouts...all of his six home runs allowed this year and nine of his ten homers allowed in his career have been to right-handed hitters...while righties have posted a lower batting average (.241) against Varland in his career than lefties (.278), right-handers have hit for more power (three doubles, one triple, nine home runs, .517 slugging percentage) than left-handers (four doubles, one home run, .375 slugging percentage).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland has used a four-pitch mix in his first four starts of 2023, including a four-seam fastball, cutter, changeup and slider, according to Baseball Savant...threw 48 four-seam fastballs in his last start on May 14 vs. Chicago-NL, his most in a start this year...also recorded a strikeout with three of his pitch types in his last start (four-seam fastball - 4, cutter - 2, changeup - 1)...below is a look at his repertoire:

⌘ Opposing hitters are batting just .063 (1-for-16) against Varland's slider this year, tied for the fifth-lowest batting average against a slider in baseball (min. 15 plate appearances)...has averaged 10.5 inches of horizontal movement on his slider this season, tied with Bailey Ober for the most slider horizontal movement on the Twins staff in 2023, according to Baseball Savant.

WITH THE SAINTS: In his three starts with Triple-A Saint Paul this season, Varland went 2-0, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 27, earned the win in a 5-1 Saint Paul victory at Rochester...pitched 5.1 innings, allowed one run on four hits, walked one batter and fanned eight...is 20-10, 2.70 ERA (253.0 IP, 76 ER) with 80 walks and 323 strikeouts in 50 career minor league appearances (45 starts).

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 - was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
- In 2019, made his professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton...made three appearances, including one start...struck out 10 batters in 8.2 innings pitched.
- Selected by Twins in 15th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.
- Debuted wearing uniform number 49, but switched to 37 during 2022-23 offseason when the Twins acquired Pablo López from Miami.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 2-2, 4.00 ERA // CAREER: 30-33, 3.94 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is scheduled to start the three-game series finale vs. the Los Angeles Angels tomorrow afternoon at Angel Stadium...did not factor into the decision in his last start May 15 at Los Angeles-NL, a 9-8 Twins defeat in 12 innings; pitched 4.2 innings and allowed five runs on five hits (3 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts, the fewest strikeouts he has recorded since also striking out four on August 12, 2022 vs. Atlanta...facing Los Angeles-AL for the first time in his career; will be the 26th team López has faced since his debut in 2018...is 9-6, 3.33 ERA (146.0 IP, 54 ER) with 30 walks and 142 strikeouts in 25 career starts when facing an opponent for the first time...is 1-1, 4.11 ERA (15.1 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts in three previous starts against the American League West; pitched at Houston, vs. Texas and at Oakland during the 2022 season with Miami.
