THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their six-game, seven-day roadtrip, going 1-2 at Dodger Stadium this week followed by a loss last night at Angel Stadium...tonight, the Iwins will continue the trip/series with the second of three in Anaheim...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Giants from Monday-Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then three against the Blue Jays next weekend... the Iwins have gone 14-8 at Target Field and 10-13 on the road.

♣ Twins are looking to avoid going 1-6-1 in road series this season... they are tied with the White Sox for the second-worst road series record in baseball, trailing Oakland (1-5-0).

TWINS HIT DET END, BREAK THRU, THEN LOSE LATE: The Twins lost to Reid Detmers and the Angels last night at Angel Stadium by a score of 5-4... Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, walked four times and struck out 16 times...the 16 strikeouts tied their season high done previously on April 18 at Boston... Kyle Farmer, playing in his 500th career game, went 2-for-4 with one RBI...Carlos Correa tied his career high with three walks...Willi Castro went 1-for-4 with a solo homer.

TWINS GET FRENCH: The Twins have placed infielder Jorge Polanco on the 10-day Injured List with a left hamstring strain...Polanco has played in 23 games for the Twins this season, hitting .284 (27-for-95) with seven doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .327 on-base percentage and an .811 OPS...this marks Polanco's second stint on the Injured List in 2023 after missing the club's first 19 games of the season with left knee inflammation...to replace Polanco on the 26-man roster, the Iwins have recalled infielder Edouard Julien from Triple-A St. Paul... Julien played in 22 games during his most recent stint with the Saints from April 21-May 19, hitting .286 (22-for-77) with seven doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, 17 runs scored, 20 walks, a .450 on-base percentage and a .905 OPS...this marks the 24-year-old's second stint with the Twins this season, after playing in eight games from April 12-21, hitting .222 (6-for-27) with two home runs and four RBI, including making his major league debut on April 12 vs. the Chicago White Sox.

April 12 vs. the Chicago White Sox. **BEACH BALL:** Tonight marks the second of six meetings with the Angels this season...after this weekend, the Iwins will host the Angels for three games from September 22-24...Twins are just 4-10 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including 2-5 at Angel Stadium.

♣ The Angels have won all four series with the Iwins since 2021, taking 10 of 14 games, including five of seven in Anaheim...the Twins scored four-or-more runs in all four of their wins but were held to three runs-or-less in nine of the 10 losses.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (103-for-342) with 24 doubles, 17 home runs, 68 RBI, a .378 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and an .898 OPS in 92 career games against the Angels...the 68 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 68 RBI are tied for fifth most among actives.

♣ Willi Castro extended his hitting streak against the Angels to 10 games last night...he has exactly one hit in all 10 games..he also has three home runs in that stretch.

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing back-to-back lefties here in Anaheim (Detmers last night), marking their first time facing two southpaws in a series since September 30-October 2, 2022 at Detroit (Tyler Alexander and Joey Wentz)...the last time they faced lefties in back-to-back games was September 24-25, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-AL (Reid Detmers and José Suárez).. tonight marks the 10th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter...Twins are 4-5 when a left-hander is the opposing starter...the Twins' last win over a left-handed starter was on Tuesday at Dodger Stadium, a 5-1 victory over Clayton Kershaw.

♣ The Iwins have the sixth-fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at just 344.

♣ Twins are slashing .228/.288/.369 with 12 homers vs. lefties, compared to .233/.314/.416 with 49 homers vs. righties.

♣ In his last 42 games against left-handed pitching (since August 9, 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .309 (25-for-81) with six doubles, one triple, six home runs. 15 RBI, 15 walks, a .404 on-base percentage, a .630 slugging percentage and a 1.034 OPS.

BUCK TRUCK REVVING THE ENGINE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in five-straight games, hitting .364 (8-for-22) with two doubles, one home run, two RBI, two walks, seven runs scored, two stolen bases, a .417 on-base percentage, a .691 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS in that span...he has a career-best 20-game on-base streak, dating back to April 25.

\$\Phi\$ Through four games on this trip, he has gone 6-for-17 and has reached base eight times in 19 plate appearances (.421 OBP).

WILLI GOIN' WILD: Willi Castro has hit safely in eight consecutive starts, a streak that goes back to April 30...in that span, he is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and five stolen bases (1 caught)...vs. lefties in that stretch, he is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with a .977 OPS.

♣ On the season, he is slashing .242/.342/.394 as a right-handed batter vs. lefties, compared to .200/.243/.343 as a left-handed batter vs. righties.

**ROYCE ROLLS:** Royce Lewis went 3-for-4 with two solo home runs yesterday for Triple-A St. Paul at Columbus...he is now hitting .444 (8-for-18) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI and three stolen bases in five rehab games between St. Paul and Double-A Wichita...he has played two games at third base and three games at shortstop...Lewis was originally placed on Minnesota's injured list on May 30, 2022 and underwent right knee surgery last June.

ANALYST ANALYSIS: Below are some highlights of Bally Sports North analysts Trevor Plouffe and Justin Morneau against the Angels:

♣ Hometown boy, Trevor Plouffe, homered in his second career game at Angel Stadium on September 2, 2011, a solo shot off Tyler Chatwood...it was the first of three home runs in this ballpark, the other two came in back-to-back games here on July 23, 2015 (off Garrett Richards) and June 13, 2016 (off Jered Weaver).

♣ Justin Morneau homered in his fourth career game in this park on August 28, 2004, a solo shot off Kelvim Escoba one of his 20 career multi-homer games here on July 26, 2009, going deep off Ervin Santana and Shane Loux.

THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1970, Hall of Famer Rod Carew hit for the first cycle in Twins history in a 10-5 win in Kansas City...he went 4-for-5 and sealed the cycle with an eighth-inning triple...in 1989, Randy Bush tied a team record with eight RBI in a 19-3 rout against the Texas Rangers...he collected three-run home runs in back-to-back innings, while current Twins broadcaster Dan Gladden tied a major league record with seven plate appearances in the game, going 1-for-7 with an RBI and run scored...in 2005, Carlos Silva threw a 74-pitch complete game in a 7-1 victory over the Brewers at home...in 2011, the Twins were fortunate enough to be playing in Arizona and were able to attend the funeral of Twins legend Harmon Killebrew, who had passed a few days prior.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season and his first career win at Target Field in a 16-3 Twins victory against the Chicago Cubs on May 14, opposite Marcus Stroman...pitched a career-high 6.1 innings, allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...permitted his first run on a solo home run to outfielder Christopher Morel in the top of the fourth inning...allowed a solo home run to outfielder Seiya Suzuki in the top of the seventh inning and was lifted from the game after walking Trey Mancini with one out in the frame...relieved by Emilio Pagán, who allowed the inherited runner to score on infielder Nick Madrigal's RBI single; Twins bullpen pitched the final 2.2 innings without allowing a run of its own...Varland received a season-high eight runs of support, the second most he has received in his career (10 at Chicago-AL on October 5, 2022)...threw a career-high 97 pitches...Twins offense set season highs with 16 runs and 18 hits in the victory.

© Varland has recorded at least six strikeouts in each of his first four starts of the season... tied with Johan Santana's 2002 season for the fourth-longest streak of starts with six-ormore strikeouts to start a season in Twins history (1961-present), trailing Pablo López's streak of eight from March 30 to May 10 of this year and two other Santana streaks (8 in 2005, 6 in 2007).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took a no-decision despite recording his second career quality start in a 6-1 Twins loss against the San Diego Padres at Target Field on May 9, opposite Michael Wacha...allowed only one run on five hits, walked two batters and struck out six over 6.0 innings of work...retired nine of the first 12 batters he faced...yielded his only run via a RBI single by designated hitter Matt Carpenter in the top of the fourth inning to score outfielder Juan Soto...relieved by Griffin Jax in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings while allowing five runs...Jax permitted the first two runs in the seventh inning; catcher Austin Nola brought in the first run via a sacrifice bunt, Jax then issued a bases-loaded walk to Jake Cronenworth...Jorge Alcala yielded the last three runs via a three-run homer from infielder Manny Machado.

STRIKEOUTS THROUGH NINE: Varland has recorded 48 strikeouts in 49.0 innings pitched through his first nine major league starts...his 48 strikeouts are the third most in Twins history (since 1961) through a pitcher's first nine games of his career, trailing Bert Blyleven (50 in 1970) and Joe Ryan (55 from 2021-22)...he has also recorded three-or-more strikeouts in each of his nine career games, the third-longest streak by a Twins pitcher to begin his career (Jim Merritt, 10 games in 1965; Joe Ryan, 15 games from 2021-22).

**LOUIE VS. LAA:** Facing the Angels for the second time in his career...last faced Los Angeles-AL on September 23, 2022 at Target Field, taking the loss in a 4-2 Twins defeat; pitched 5.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits, with one walk and three strikeouts...allowed two solo home runs to outfielder Taylor Ward and a RBI single to outfielder Mike Trout...held 2022 American League MVP runner-up Shohei Ohtani without a hit in three at-bats...was relieved by Trevor Megill with two outs in the sixth inning and the Twins trailing 3-1...the one run of support was the second lowest for Varland in 2022 (0 R on September 17, 2022 at Cleveland).

**LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES:** Through his first four starts this season, left-handed hitters are batting .300 (9-for-30) with 10 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are hitting .220 (13-for 59) with 17 strikeouts...alll of his six home runs allowed this year and nine of his ten homers allowed in his career have been to right-handed hitters...while righties have posted a lower batting average (.241) against Varland in his career than lefties (.278), right-handers have hit for more power (three doubles, one triple, nine home runs, .517 slugging percentage) than left-handers (four doubles, one home run, .375 slugging percentage).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Variand has used a four-pitch mix in his first four starts of 2023, including a four-seam fastball, cutter, changeup and slider, according to Baseball Savant...threw 48 four-seam fastballs in his last start on May 14 vs. Chicago-NL, his most in a start this year...also recorded a strikeout with three of his pitch types in his last start (four-seam fastball - 4, cutter - 2, changeup - 1)...below is a look at his repertoire:

**WITH THE SAINTS:** In his three starts with Triple-A Saint Paul this season, Varland went 2-0, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 27, earned the win in a 5-1 Saint Paul victory at Rochester...pitched 5.1 innings, allowed one run on four hits, walked one batter and fanned eight...is 20-10, 2.70 ERA (253.0 IP, 76 ER) with 80 walks and 323 strikeouts in 50 career minor league appearances (45 starts).
