HOWDY PARTNER, TWINS EVEN UP COUNTRY WEEKEND IN ANAHEIM: The Twins beat the Angels last night by a score of 6-2...Louie Varland (2-0) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and four strikeouts...the bullpen combined for 4.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Kyle Farmer, who drove in one run and scored twice... Joey Gallo hit his team-leading 11th home run in the sixth inning.

SEEING RED: Today marks the third of six meetings with the Angels this season...these two teams will continue the season series at Target Field for three games from September 22-24... Twins are just 5-10 vs. the Angels since the start of 2021, including 3-5 at Angel Stadium.

◆ Since 2021, the Angels have won 10 of 15 games vs. the Twins, including five of eight in Angels in Angels and the Angels have won 10 of 15 games vs.

Carlos Correa is hitting 302 (104-for-344) with 24 doubles, 17 home runs, 68 RBI, a .383 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and a .903 OPS in 93 career games against the Angels...the 68 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 20)...additionally, his 68 RBI are tied for fifth most among actives.

The Twins have faced Shohei Ohtani twice in his career...the first was on May 13, 2018 as the Angels won 2-1...the lineup that day was Brian Dozier - 2B, Max Kepler - CF, Eduardo Escobar - 3B, Eddie Rosario - LF, Mitch Garver - DH, Logan Morrison - 1B, Robbie Grossman - RF, Gregorio Petit - SS, Bobby Wilson - C // Fernando Romero - P...the second was on September 23, 2022 at Target Field as the Angels won 4-2...the Twins lineup that day was: Luis Arraez - DH, Jose Miranda - 1B, Nick Gordon - 2B, Gio Urshela - 3B, Jake Cave - LF, Gary Sánchez - C, Matt Wallner - RF, Mark Contreras - CF, Jermaine Palacios - SS // Louie Varland - P.

TOUCHING BASE WITH 'LOS: After drawing three more walks last night, Carlos Correa has now walked six times in nine plate appearances this series...Correa has reached safely in each of his last 10 games, posting a .413 on-base percentage in that span (9 walks and 9 hits).

KIRILLOFF THE HOOK: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Alex Kirilloff has hit 350 (14-for-40) with six walks, a .458 on-base percentage and an 1.033 OPS in 13 games.

♣ Kirilloff is back in the starting lineup today for the first time since Wednesday afternoon at Dodger Stadium...against right-handed pitching this season (with Minnesota), he is hitting .394 (13-for-33) with six walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.167 OPS... against lefties, he is hitting .143 (1-for-7).

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: After hitting one home run last night, the Twins have now hit 15 homers in their last seven games...they have homered 62 times on the season, the third most in the AL and seventh most in baseball...52 of their home runs have come in their last 34 games since April 13, tied for fourth in baseball since that date.

Today's starter, Pablo López, is the man behind the "Land of 10,000 Rakes" home run celebration fishing vest and pole...López went to a sporting goods store after a day game on April 29, buying the vest along with a Paw Patrol kids fishing pole...the next day the Twins won over the Royals 8-4 as Byron Buxton hit a 453-foot homer, becoming the first to wear the new celebration attire....Twins have hit 25 home runs since the vest's debut, homering in all but three games. homering in all but three games.

SERIES FINALE: The Twins are looking to win their eighth series of the season today, going 7-6-1 in series play in 2023 (results to the right)...they have gone 1-5-1 in seven road series this season; their one win was a three-game sweep of Kansas City to open the season...a victory today would mark the Twins' first series victory over the Angels since a three-game sweep in Anaheim from May 20-23, 2019, going 0-4-0 since.

JOEY LONGBALLS: Joey Gallo hit his team-leading 10th home run of the season last night...he has a hard hit percentage of 60.6%, third best in baseball, trailing Matt Chapman (62.7%) and Aaron Judge (61.1%)...additionally, he ranks eighth in baseball in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage at 12.1% and ninth in average exit velocity at 93.7 mph.

◆ Gallo has a .976 OPS against right-handed pitching, compared to .642 vs. lefties.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Blayne Enlow and High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Kala'i Rosario as the minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

◆ Enlow, 24, made one start for the Wind Surge on Thursday vs. Arkansas, allowing one run on six hits in 5.1 innings pitched with no walks and 10 strikeouts...the Sorrento, Louisiana native was selected by the Twins in the third round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Amant High School in St. Amant, LA.

◆ Rosario, 20, hit .538 with one double and two home runs this week for the Kernels...the Papaikou, Hawaii native was selected by the Twins in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Waiakea High School in Waiakea, HI.

HAPPY HRBIE DAY!: Twins Hall of Famer Kent Hrbek is celebrating his 63rd birthday today...he played eight games on his birthday during his 14-year career with Minnesota, hitting .240 (6-for-25) with two doubles, one home run and two RBI...Hrbek had a 38.6 BWAR for his career, second-best of any player born on May 21, behind Hall of Famer Earl Averill (51.1)...he shares a birthday with National Baseball Hall of Famer Bobby Cox (82), Al Franken (72) and Mr. T (71).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 9-8 defeat in 12 innings vs. the Los Angeles Dodgers on May 15 at Dodger Stadium, opposite Noah Syndergaard; marked his third-straight no-decision...pitched 4.2 innings, allowing five earned runs on five hits, with no walks and four strikeouts...allowed a career-high-tying three home runs, a two-run shot by catcher Will Smith in the first inning and two homers from infielder Max Muncy (solo homer in the first inning, two-run homer in the third)...was relieved by Brock Stewart with two outs in the bottom of the fifth inning and the Twins trailing 5-2; marked his second-shortest start of 2023 (4.0 innings pitched vs. Washington on April 22)...Twins scored five runs in the final three innings to force extras; both teams scored one run in the 10th and failed to score in the 11th, but the Twins fell in the 12th inning when Jorge López issued a bases-loaded walk to designated hitter Trayec Thompson.

© Did not issue a walk for the first time in a start this year; last start in which he did not issue a walk was on September 27, 2022 at New York-NL.

© Tied his career-high with three home runs allowed, for the fourth time and first since May 24, 2022 at Tampa Bay.

© Through nine starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (66 - T-5th), WHIP (1.07 - 13th), WAR (1.0 - 16th) and FIP (3.83 - 17th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision in the Twins 4-3 victory in 11 innings vs. the San Diego Padres at Target Field on May 10...pitched opposite right-hander Seth Lugo, who also did not factor into the decision...López went 6.1 innings, allowing one earned run and two hits, issuing a season-high four walks and striking out eight batters...issued one walk in each of his first three innings but held the Padres scoreless through his first 6.0 innings of work...allowed his first hit in the top of the fifth inning when shortstop Xander Bogaerts reached on an infield single...benefitted from two double plays, a 7-3 DP in the first inning and a 3-unassisted DP in the fourth...yielded a solo home run to lettfielder Juan Soto to lead off the seventh inning...was relieved by Brock Stewart with one out in the seventh and Minnesota leading 2-1 after López struck out Bogaerts to end his outing...San Diego evened the score at 2-2 in the eighth inning via third baseman Manny Machado's sacrifice fly off Jorge López...each team scored once in the 10th inning, and the Twins won in the 11th on a walk-off RBI single by leftfielder Alex Kirilloff.

• Recorded six-or-more strikeouts in nine-straight starts from October 4, 2022 - May 10, 2023, the longest streak of his career...his eight-start streak from March 30 - May 10, 2023 is the second longest in baseball this season, trailing only Atlanta's Spencer Strider (9).

CALLING ALL ANGELS: Facing Los Angeles-AL for the first time in his career; Angels will become the 26th team he has faced since he debuted in 2018 and his third new opponent of the season (April 5 at Miami and April 11 vs. Chicago-AL); yet to face Detroit, Boston, Seattle and Minnesota in his career...in 25 previous starts when facing an opponent for the first time, López is 9-6, 3.33 ERA (146.0 IP, 54 ER) with 30 walks and 142 strikeouts; since the start of 2020, he is 4-1, 2.42 ERA (52.0 IP, 14 ER) with 13 walks and 58 strikeouts in nine starts against new teams.

© In three career starts vs. American League West opponents, López has gone 1-1, 4.11 ERA (15.1 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts; started at Houston, vs. Texas and at Oakland during the 2022 season with Miami.

WRAPPING UP THE ROADTRIP: Tonight is López's sixth road start of the year...Minnesota has gone 2-3 in his five road starts, with López going 1-1, 3.00 ERA (30.0 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 35 strikeouts...in his four home starts this season, López has gone 1-1, 5.25 ERA (24.0 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks and 31 strikeouts, with the livins winning three of those four starts...over his career, López is 15-17, 4.36 ERA (256.0 IP, 124 ER) with 69 walks and 256 strikeouts in 49 road starts...in 54 home starts, he is 15-16, 3.59 ERA (308.0 IP, 123 ER) with 87 walks and 299 strikeouts.

◆ Looking for his first road win since earning the Opening Day victory at Kansas City on March 30 (5.1 IP, 0 R/ER, 2 H, 3 BB, 8 K).

◆ Pitching at Angel Stadium for the first time in his career; will become the 25th ballpark he has appeared at since debuting in 2018...is 10-5, 3.49 ERA (136.2 IP, 53 ER) with 34 walks and 142 strikeouts in 24 previous starts at a new venue.

LEFT/RIGHT: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .217 (26-for-120) batting average this season...left-handed hitters are batting at a .231 (18-for-78) clip...his 43 strikeouts against righties are eighth most in the American League...overall, opposing hitters are batting .222 (44-for-198) vs. López this year, tied for the 15th-lowest opponent batting average among qualified American League pitchers...over his career, he has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.662 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.745 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first nine starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has exclusively used his sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball when facing left-handed hitters...recorded three strikeouts with his four-seam fastball and one strikeout with his sweeper in his last start on May 15 at Los Angeles-NL...here is a look at
