THE TWINS: Completed their roadtrip yesterday afternoon with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 at Dodger Stadium from Monday-Wednesday and 1-2 at Angel Stadium over the weekend... starting tonight, Minnesota will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the San Francisco Giants through Wednesday, followed by an off-day on Thursday, then three against the Toronto Blue Jays over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-8 at Target Field and 11-14 on the road.

SHO TIME SPOILS PABLO DAY IN FINALE: The Twins lost to the Angels yesterday in Anaheim by a score of 4-2, making them 1-6-1 in road series play this season...Pablo Lopez (2-3) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0-plus innings, with three walks and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, three from Willi Castro...Carlos Correa had the club's first RBI with a third-inning double and Alex Kirilloff drove in the second run with a solo home run in the eighth inning, his third home run this season.

WE WERE GIANTS: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 19th time in their history tonight...the Twins are 9-9 all-time against San Francisco, going 3-0 at Target Field, 5-7 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to 2017, the Twins have won five of their last six over the Giants.

ROCCO BALDELLI AND GABE KAPLER: These two teams last met for a three-game series at Target Field from August 26-28, 2022 as the Twins swept the series, outscoring San Francisco 20-5...entering that series, the Giants were the last of the 29 major league opponents to appear at the Twins' ballpark, which opened in 2010.

ROCCO BALDELLI AND GABE KAPLER: The 18 games played against the Giants are tied with Colorado for the Twins' fewest against any major league opponent in their history (since 1961).

ROCCO BALDELLI AND GABE KAPLER: Rocco Baldelli and Gabe Kapler were teammates for the Tampa Bay Rays in 2010. Donovan Solano played three seasons with the Giants from 2019-21, hitting .308 (219-for-712) with 45 doubles, 14 home runs, 83 RBI and 84 runs scored in 236 games and won a Louisville Silver Slugger Award in 2020...Solano believes his nickname "Donnie Barrels" came from Giants teammate Mike Yastrzemski who started calling him "Donnie Ballgame"...then, some teammates started asking how he got the barrel of the bat on the ball, and somehow the name became "Donnie Barrels."

ROGER THAT: Giants reliever Taylor Rogers was drafted by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft...Rog played parts of six seasons with the Twins from 2016-21 and was named an AL All-Star in 2021 in his hometown of Denver, Colorado...in 319 games as a twin, he posted a 3.15 ERA, saved 50 games and recorded 77 holds...he ranks fifth on the club's all-time list in holds and 11th in saves...he and Eddie Guardado are the only pitchers in club history with at least 50 career saves and at least 50 career holds.

THE OTHER GUYS: The Twins have gone 7-8 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL and 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL...they have gone 6-4 in their last 10 vs. the NL after starting the season 1-4...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Brewers for two games at Target Field from June 13-14. Twins have the seventh most wins in Interleague Play history, at 257 (list lower right).

GETTING OFFENSIVE: The Twins have 88 hits in their last seven games (11 H/G), 36 going for extra-bases (.523 SLG)...below are the Twins first 39 games from March 30-May 12 and their last eight games since May 13:

NOTE: Since May 13, the Twins lead baseball in OPS (.894), on-base percentage (.371) and slugging percentage (.523), rank second in hits (88) and third in batting average (.293).

AK NOT JUST OK: Alex Kirilloff has reached base safely in eight-straight games since May 13, hitting .355 (11-for-31) with a .394 on-base percentage in that span...it marks the third longest on-base streak of his career, having previously reached in 12-straight (June 4-18, 2021) and nine-straight twice (July 10-24, 2022 and April 26-May 22, 2021)...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Kirilloff has hit .341 (15-for-44) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI, six walks, a .442 on-base percentage and a 1.056 OPS in 14 games.

C4 STARTING TO FEEL IT: Carlos Correa has reached safely in each of his last 11 games, hitting just .268 (11-for-41) in that span, but has a .400 on-base percentage (11 hits & 9 walks) with five doubles, one home run and nine RBI...Correa's long for an on-base streak in 2023 is 11, from May 10-21...his career-long is 27, from June 10-July 15, 2017 with Houston.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: Twins have homered in eight-straight games (since May 13), hitting 16 in that span...it marks their second-longest streak of the season after homering in a franchise-record 18-straight from April 18-May 6...they have 63 home runs on the season, tied with Texas for seventh most in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (91), Atlanta (77), Los Angeles-NL (76), New York-AL (73), St. Louis (67) and San Francisco (65).

BUCK TRUCK REVVING THE ENGINE: Byron Buxton has reached safely in a career-long 21-straight games, since April 25...Buxton's current streak is the longest for a twin since Jorge Polanco reached safely in 37-straight from May 13-June 25, 2019.

WILLI GOIN' WILD: Willi Castro has hit safely in 10 consecutive starts, a streak that goes back to April 30...in that span, he is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with three doubles, one home run, four RBI and five stolen bases (1 caught)...at the start of the streak, he was hitting .115 and now sits at .250, raising his batting average 135 points.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2009, Michael Cuddyer hit for the cycle vs. Milwaukee as the Twins won 11-3, in the first day of Interleague play that season...he became the 10th of 11 Twins to ever hit for the cycle...Cuddyer homered in his first at-bat, doubled in his second at-bat, singled in his third at-bat, and tripled in his fourth at-bat...since Cuddy's cycle, Jorge Polanco has the last one, doing so on April 5, 2019 at Philadelphia.

#OLDFRIEND: Former Twins catcher A.J. Pierzynski is on the call for Fox Sports 1 tonight...A.J. was drafted by the Twins in the third round (71st overall) of the 1994 First-Year Player Draft out of Dr. Phillips High School in Orlando, Florida and played parts of six seasons with the Twins from 1998-2003, hitting .301 (430-for-1428) with 106 doubles, 26 home runs and 193 RBI in 430 games...Pierzynski ranks eighth on the club's all-time list in games caught with 416...he was traded to the Giants on November 14, 2003 with cash, in exchange for right-handed pitchers Boof Bonser and Joe Nathan, and left-handed pitcher Francisco Liriano.

LAST START: Earned his third win of the season in a 5-1 Twins victory against the Los Angeles Dodgers on May 16 at Dodger Stadium; his third-consecutive quality start of the season...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on six hits, with one walk and six strikeouts, opposite Clayton Kershaw...tossed a career-high 102 pitches...yielded his lone run via an RBI single by infielder Freddie Freeman in the fifth inning...relieved by Brock Stewart in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...marked the first Twins victory at Dodger Stadium since June 11, 2005 in a 5-3 win.

☞ Fanned six batters in four-straight starts, the longest streak of his career.

☞ Brought his career strikeout total to 175...owns the fifth-most strikeouts through a pitcher's first 36 games in Twins history (1961-present), behind Joe Ryan (210), Bert Blyleven (192), Francisco Liriano (184) and Boof Bonser (179).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in a 5-3 Twins victory against the San Diego Padres on May 11 at Target Field, despite recording his second quality start of the season...pitched 6.0 innings, allowed a season-high three runs on six hits, with no walks and six strikeouts opposite Yu Darvish...marked the first time Ober recorded back-to-back quality starts in his career...allowed his second leadoff home run of his career to outfielder Fernando Tatis Jr. on the first pitch of the game, yielded an RBI double to outfielder Juan Soto in the fourth inning and permitted a solo home run to infielder Rougned Odor in the fifth inning...relieved by Emilio Pagan in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins came from behind in the seventh inning to secure the win with an RBI groundout by Max Kepler off Brent Honeywell and a two-RBI double by Carlos Correa off Steven Wilson.

OBER VS. SAN FRANCISCO: Facing the Giants for the first time in his career...making his sixth career Interleague start, fourth this season...is 2-0, 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks and 16 strikeouts in three Interleague starts this season (2-0, 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 24 strikeouts in five career Interleague starts)...San Francisco will be the 15th team he has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021...in 14 career starts when facing an opponent for the first time, Ober is 2-2, 3.92 ERA (66.2 IP, 29 ER) with 15 walks and 66 strikeouts...San Francisco outfielder Mitch Haniger is the only active Giants hitter to previously face Ober...Haniger is 2-for-4 with one home run and two strikeouts across two games against Ober as a member of the Seattle Mariners.

☞ Ranks 12th for the lowest ERA in Interleague games this season (min. 15.0 IP).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Ober is making his fourth home start of the season, 19th of his career...in three home starts is season, Ober is 1-0, 2.60 ERA (17.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 16 strikeouts...is 5-1, 3.63 ERA (89.1 IP, 36 ER) with 22 walks and 93 strikeouts in 18 career home starts...Twins have gone 12-6 in his home starts.

☞ Currently holding a four-game win streak at Target Field, dating back to September 24, 2021...is 4-0, 2.89 ERA (46.2 IP, 15 ER) with 11 walks and 50 strikeouts in the nine-game span...took his last loss at home on August 17, 2021 vs. Cleveland.

THE RIGHT STUFF: Right-handed hitters are batting .180 (9-for-50) with 15 strikeouts and one RBI against Ober after five starts this season...left-handed hitters are hitting .220 (13-for-59) with 13 strikeouts and five RBI...in his career, right-handed hitters are batting .217/.238/.410 with 104 strikeouts against Ober...lefties are hitting .266/.328/.435 with 71 strikeouts off him.

☞ Tied for ninth for the lowest opponent batting average against righties in the American League (min. 14.0 IP)...his .196 opponent OBP against righties is tied for sixth lowest in all of baseball.

ARSENAL: Ober used a four-pitch mix in his five starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...three of Ober's six strikeouts in his last start on May 16 came from his changeup...threw 49 fastballs in his last start...mostly uses his slider (85 pitches) against righties while relying on his changeup (82 pitches) and curveball (39 pitches) against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

☞ Ober ranks 13th for the lowest opponent batting average against a fastball in the American League (min. 400 pitches).

ACROSS THE RIVER: In his four starts with Triple-A Saint Paul this season, Ober went 2-1, 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 18, earned the win in 6-0 Saint Paul victory versus Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one batter and fanned six.

NIGHT SHIFT: Ober is making his third night start of the season tonight...is 2-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts in his two previous night starts this season...is 5-4, 3.26 ERA (105.0 IP, 38 ER) with 18 walks and 111 strikeouts in 21 career night starts...ranks third for the most strikeouts through their first 21 night games with the Twins (min. 100.0 IP), trailing Joe Ryan (135) and Bert Blyleven (113).

☞ Ranks fifth in the American League for the lowest night ERA this season, ninth in all of baseball (min. 10 IP).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
