THE TWINS: After completing their roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (1-2 at Dodger Stadium and 1-2 at Angel Stadium), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive losses to the Giants the last two nights...today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against San Francisco...they will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then welcome the Blue Jays for three games over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-10 at Target Field and 11-14 on the road.

TWINS DROP ANOTHER CLOSE ONE: The Twins lost to the Giants last night at Target Field by a score of 4-3, dropping their second series at home (6-2-0)...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Jorge López (1-2) was dealt the loss, allowing a two run-homer to Michael Conforto in the seventh inning, losing the 3-2 lead...the offense recorded just six hits, two from Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-4 with a two-run homer, his 10th of the season...Michael A. Taylor also added a home run, his sixth of the season.

JOE CY-AN: Through eight starts, Joe Ryan has gone 6-1, 2.25 ERA (56.0 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks and 66 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .203 (42-for-207) batting average...below are his ranks among AL starting pitchers in a few notable categories:

GOLDEN JOE: Joe Ryan was born and raised in Marin County, CA and played prep ball at Sir Francis Drake High School...he was a die-hard Giants fan growing up...the Giants invited him for a pre-draft workout in 2014 but did not take him high enough in the draft (39th round), so Joe decided to attend California State University, Northridge and was eventually drafted in the seventh round of the 2018 draft by Tampa Bay...Joe recently met and took a picture with 49ers legend Joe Montana in front of the team hotel on Sunday morning in Anaheim prior to getting on the team bus.

MY GIANT: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 21st time in their history today...the Twins are 9-11 all-time against San Francisco, going 3-2 at Target Field, 5-7 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to 2017, the Twins have won five of their last eight over the Giants...Twins are looking to avoid losing a series to the Giants for the first time since May 23-25, 2014, when they were swept in three at Oracle Park...the Twins are 3-3-0 all time in series play against San Francisco.

50 FIRST DATES: The Twins are playing in their 50th game of the season today, below are the yearly hitting and pitching comparisons (since 2019) for the first 50:

SERIES FINALE: The Twins lost their seventh series of the season last night, making them 7-7-1 in series play in 2023...they have gone 1-6-1 in eight road series this season and 6-2-0 at home (results to the right)...Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the first time this season...they faced a potential sweep once after losing the first two to Washington from April 21-22, but won the third game on April 23...last time they were swept was by Cleveland in three games at Target Field from September 9-11, 2022.

NATIONAL TREASURES: The Twins have gone 7-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL and 0-2 vs. San Francisco...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Brewers for two games at Target Field from June 13-14...the Twins are 10-6 (.625) against the AL Central and 15-18 (.455) against the rest of the league this season...no other division leader is below .500 in non-divisional games.

CREATING SPACE: The Twins have played 14 one-run games this season, going 4-10 in such instances, tied for the fourth-most losses in baseball...they have played 35 games within two runs, going 21-14 in those games, eighth-most wins in baseball...they have played 24 games within three runs, going 14-10 in those.

ALL ARMS AND LEGS: Byron Buxton went 2-for-4 with a two-run homer and a stolen base last night...last night marked his eighth career game with a homer and a stolen base, 11th most in Twins history; Torii Hunter has the most, with 19...Buck extended his on-base streak to a career-long 23-straight games, since April 25...Buxton's current streak is the longest for a Twin since Jorge Polanco reached safely in 37-straight from May 13-June 25, 2019.

IN HIS LAST EIGHT GAMES, Buxton is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with four walks, two doubles, two home runs, four RBI, four walks, nine runs scored, three stolen bases, a .429 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.029 OPS.

DONNIE BARRELS: Donovan Solano is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, six walks and a .404 on-base percentage in 19 games at Target Field this season...Solano has reached base safely in nine of his last 10 games overall (home and road), posting a .420 on-base percentage in that span...Donnie played three seasons with the Giants from 2019-21, hitting .308 (219-for-712) with 45 doubles, 14 home runs, 83 RBI and 84 runs scored in 236 games and won a Louisville Silver Slugger Award in 2020...Solano believes his nickname "Donnie Barrels" came from Giants teammate Mike Yastrzemski who started calling him "Donnie Ballgame"...then, some teammates started asking how he got the barrel of the bat on the ball, and somehow the name became "Donnie Barrels."

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/YAZ HISTORY: On May 24, 1966 at Fenway Park, Mike Yastrzemski's grandpa homered off Twins starting pitcher Camilo Pascual in the bottom of the first...on May 24, 1968 at Met Stadium, Yaz took Dave Boswell deep in the top of the first.
