THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game homestand with a record of 6-4 (1-2 against the Nationals, 2-1 against the Yankees and 3-1 against the Royals), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a loss to the White Sox in Chicago last night...tonight, they will continue the trip with the second of three games on the South Side...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale at Guaranteed Rate Field, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to play three against the Guardians over the weekend...the Twins have gone 10-6 at Target Field and 7-7 on the road. A win tonight would give Rocco Baldelli 306 career managerial victories, which would place him in sole possession of fifth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)...list lower right.

TWINS DROP OPENER IN EXTRAS: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings, making them 2-2 in extras this season and 3-6 in one-run games...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...Jorge López blew his second-consecutive save, allowing a two-run homer to Eloy Jiménez in the seventh inning...it marked López's first earned runs allowed of the season and first home run since September 19, 2022 at Cleveland (Luke Maile)...Minnesota scored their two runs on a Trevor Larnach sacrifice fly and a Nick Gordon pinch hit solo home run (1)...the offense struck out 11 times and went 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position.

TWINS CALL ON LOU: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Tyler Mahle on the 15-day Injured List with a right arm posterior impingement and flexor pronator strain (retroactive to April 30)...Mahle was removed from his start on April 27 vs. Kansas City with the injury, after completing 4.0 innings and allowing one run on two hits while striking out six batters in a 7-1 Twins win...to replace Mahle on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Louie Varland from Triple-A St. Paul...this is Varland's second stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from April 14-15 and starting on April 14 at New York-AL, an outing in which he yielded three runs on six hits (3 home runs), with one walk and eight strikeouts in a 6.0-inning no-decision...the 25-year-old has gone 2-0, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER), with four walks and 25 strikeouts in three starts for the Saints this season.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli needs one win to pass Paul Molitor and move into sole possession of fifth on the Twins all-time managerial wins list...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered in a season-long 14-straight games, since April 18...since that date, they have hit 23 home runs, tied with Boston and San Francisco for the second most in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (25)...the current streak is the second longest of 2023, trailing the Rays' stretch of 22 straight to begin the season (March 30-April 23)...the streak is tied for fifth longest in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901):

BUX FRESH SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .278 (68-for-245) with 20 doubles, one triple, 16 home runs, 39 RBI, 46 runs scored and an .888 OPS in 71 career games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 23 (June 30, 2019-present):

ALSO: Byron Buxton has 16 career home runs and 39 RBI against the Sox (his most against any opponent), including nine homers and 16 RBI in his last 16 games.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the fifth of 13 meetings this season...Twins are 2-2 vs. the Sox this season, going 2-1 at Target Field from April 10-12, followed by a loss last night...since 2015, the Twins have gone 80-57 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

Since 2019, no opponent has homered in this ballpark more than the Twins, with 71 (next is Kansas City with 42).

Christian Vázquez is hitting .345 (38-for-110) with five doubles, one home run, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .395 on-base percentage and an .813 OPS in 35 career games vs. the Sox...Vázquez is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with a .959 OPS in 18 career games at Guaranteed Rate...in his last 12 games here, he has reached base 22 times in 39 plate appearances (.564 OBP)...two of his six four-hit games (career high) have come in this ballpark.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .318 (27-for-85) with three doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.016 OPS in his last 22 games on the South Side...Polanco's 14 career homers and 41 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

BUCK TRUCK HORN STARTING TO MAKE NOISE: Byron Buxton has hit safely in a season-long six-straight games and in 10 of his last 11, since April 19...in that span, he is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with five doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, five walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .767 slugging percentage and a 1.142 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Francisco Liriano threw the fifth no-hitter in Twins history and first no-hitter of the MLB season as the Twins beat the White Sox, 1-0...Jason Kubel's solo homer in the fourth inning off Edwin Jackson was the game's only run...in 2013, Justin Morneau recorded his 800th career RBI in a Twins 7-6 loss at Cleveland...Morneau finished his Twins career with 860 RBI which stands as the sixth most in club history.

LAST MLB OUTING: Recorded his first career quality start in his 2023 Twins debut, taking a no-decision in a 4-3 Twins victory against the New York Yankees at Yankee Stadium, opposite Nestor Cortes...marked two career highs by pitching 6.0 innings and recording eight strikeouts...allowed three runs on six hits and walked one batter, with all three runs allowed via solo home runs...allowed back-to-back home runs for the first time in his career to infielder Anthony Volpe and outfielder Aaron Judge in the bottom of the first inning; Volpe's homer was also the first leadoff home run Varland has allowed in his career...yielded another home run in the bottom of the sixth inning to designated hitter Giancarlo Stanton...relieved by Emilio Pagán in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...Twins scored once in the seventh and twice in the eighth on a two-run double from shortstop Carlos Correa to record the come-from-behind victory.

☞ Has tossed at least 5.0 innings in all six of his career starts and allowed three-or-fewer runs in five of those six starts.

WITH THE SAINTS: In his three starts with Triple-A Saint Paul this season, Varland is 2-0, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts...in his last start on April 27, earned the win in a 5-1 Saints victory at Rochester...pitched 5.1 innings, allowed one run on four hits, walked one batter and fanned eight...his lone blemish came from an RBI single to infielder Darren Baker...relieved by Cole Sands in the sixth inning after walking infielder Travis Blankenhorn...leads the Saints in strikeouts and is tied for 14th in the International League.

AGAINST THE SOUTHSIDERS: Facing Chicago-AL for the third time in his career...last faced the White Sox in the final game of the 2022 season on October 5 at Guaranteed Rate Field...earned his first career victory after pitching 5.0 innings scoreless innings and allowing four hits with zero walks and five strikeouts...was the first scoreless outing of his career...received 10 runs of support, including a six-run first inning by the Twins...relieved by Cole Sands, who recorded his first career save to secure the Twins 10-1 victory.

☞ Is 1-0, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER) with two walks and eight strikeouts in his career against Chicago-AL...tied with Kevin Tapani for fourth-lowest ERA against the White Sox in his first two career games against Chicago-AL (min 10.0 IP).

BACK ON THE ROAD: Tonight is Varland's fifth career start on the road and second this season...is 1-1, 3.80 ERA (21.1 IP, 9 ER) with four walks and 23 strikeouts in his four career starts on the road...in two career home starts, he is 0-1, 4.22 ERA (10.2 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts...his 3.52 road ERA last season ranked third among Twins rookie pitchers and sixth on the entire Twins pitching staff (min. 10.0 IP).

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Left-handed hitters batted .333 (3-for-9) with four strikeouts and righties hit .200 (3-for-15) with four strikeouts against Varland in his first start...allowed all three of his runs to right-handed hitters via solo home runs...historically, Varland has posted similar numbers against both left- and right-handed hitters but had a slight edge on lefties...last season, lefties posted a .262/.296/.405 slash line (11-for-42) with three doubles, one home run, two walks, nine strikeouts and a .700 OPS...righties slashed .263/.323/.491 (15-for-57) with an .814 OPS, two doubles, three home runs, four walks and 12 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland used a four-pitch mix in his first MLB start of 2023 on April 14 vs. New York-AL, including a four-seam fastball, slider, cutter and changeup according to Baseball Savant...utilized his cutter the most after only throwing the pitch 18.5 percent of the time in five starts with Minnesota last year...below is a look at his repertoire:

☞ Threw a 98.3 mph fastball to New York-AL outfielder Oswaldo Cabrera in the second inning of his last start on April 14, the fastest pitch of his MLB career.

MINNESOTA MADE: Varland was born and raised in St. Paul, Minnesota and attended North St. Paul High School, where he was an All-Metro East Conference performer and letterwinner in three sports (baseball, wrestling and football)...continued his academic and athletic career at Division II Concordia University in St. Paul, Minnesota, where his 1.41 ERA as a sophomore in 2018 was second best in school history and fourth best in the nation by a DH pitcher...was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft.

☞ With his MLB debut on September 7, 2022, became the eighth Minnesota-born player to make a start for the Twins...is one of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins (1961-present).

☞ Varland, Caleb Thielbar (Northfield, MN) and Matt Wallner (Forest Lake, MN) became the first three Minnesota-born Twins teammates since Joe Mauer (St. Paul, MN), Glen Perkins (St. Paul, MN) and Thielbar in 2015.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 2-2, 4.00 ERA // CAREER: 30-33, 3.94 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is due to start the three-game series finale vs. the Chicago White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field on Thursday afternoon...earned the win in his last start April 28 vs. Kansas City in the Twins 8-6 victory over the Royals at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing a season-high six earned runs on eight hits with one walk and seven strikeouts...facing Chicago-AL for the second time this season and second time in his career...took a no-decision in his last start vs. the White Sox April 11 at Target Field, going 7.2 innings and allowing two runs on three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts...retired the final 23 batters he faced after allowing two runs in the first inning...Twins won 4-3 in 10 innings when Willi Castro scored on a bunt single and throwing error.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 - was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
- In 2019, made his professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton...made three appearances, including one start...struck out 10 batters in 8.2 innings pitched.
- Selected by Twins in 15th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.
- Debuted wearing uniform number 49, but switched to 37 during 2022-23 offseason when the Twins acquired Pablo López from Miami.
