THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game homestand with a record of 6-4 (1-2 against the Nationals, 2-1 against the Yankees and 3-1 against the Royals), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with consecutive losses to the White Sox in Chicago the last two nights... today, they will continue the trip with the three-game series finale on the South Side...after today's game against the White Sox, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to play three against the Guardians over the weekend...the Twins have gone 10-6 at Target Field and 7-8 on the road. **Ⓢ** The Twins are looking to avoid losing their third straight game, which would match their season-long, done twice previously: April 15-18 and April 20-22.

ANOTHER TOUGH LATE LOSS ON THE SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 6-4, losing the three-game series, making them 5-4-1 in series play in 2023, including 1-3-1 on the road...Louie Varland made his second start of the season, allowing four runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings pitched, including a three-run homer to Luis Robert Jr. in the first inning...Griffin Jax (1-3) was dealt the loss, allowing an RBI-single to Eloy Jiménez in the seventh inning, breaking a 4-4 tie...the offense recorded eight hits and tied their season-high with six walks...they went 3-for-8 with runners in scoring position, but left the bases loaded in the seventh inning with nobody out as Carlos Correa and Byron Buxton each grounded into a fielder's choice, followed by a Trevor Larnach strikeout.

ITWINS: Tomorrow night's game in Cleveland will be on Apple TV+, marking the Twins' first time on that viewing format this season...they will also play on Apple TV+ next Friday night, May 12 against the Chicago Cubs at Target Field.

LEAVE THE BROOMS ALONE: Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the first time this season...they faced a potential sweep once this season after losing the first two to Washington from April 21-22, but won the third game...last time they were swept was in three games at Kansas City from September 20-22, 2022...the last time the Twins were swept by the White Sox was in three games at GRF from June 29-July 1, 2021...Minnesota was swept seven times in 2022.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered in a season-long 15-straight games, since April 18, one game shy of tying the all-time franchise record (since 1901) of 16 consecutive (accomplished four times previously, last in 2021)...since that date, they have hit 24 home runs, tied for fourth most in baseball in that span...the current streak is the second longest of 2023, trailing the Rays' stretch of 22 straight to begin the season (March 30-April 23).

BUCK TRUCK ALL TUNED UP: Byron Buxton has hit safely in a season-long seven-straight games and in 11 of his last 12, since April 19...in that span, he is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with six doubles, five home runs, 12 RBI, seven walks, a .404 on-base percentage, a .778 slugging percentage and a 1.182 OPS...below are his first 16 compared to his last 12:

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the sixth of 13 meetings this season...these two will meet for two more series' this season, a three-gamer at Target Field from July 21-23 and a four-gamer back in Chicago from September 14-17...since 2015, the Twins have gone 80-68 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

Ⓢ Since 2019, no opponent has homered in this ballpark more than the Twins, with 72 (next is Kansas City with 42).

Ⓢ Christian Vázquez is hitting .345 (38-for-110) with five doubles, one home run, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .395 on-base percentage and an .813 OPS in 35 career games vs. the Sox... Vázquez is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with a .959 OPS in 18 career games at Guaranteed Rate...in his last 12 games here, he has reached base 22 times in 39 plate appearances (.564 OBP)...two of his six four-hit games (career high) have come in this ballpark.

Ⓢ Jorge Polanco is hitting .326 (29-for-89) with three doubles, seven home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.020 OPS in his last 23 games on the South Side...Polo's 14 career homers and 41 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

Ⓢ Byron Buxton is hitting .360 (32-for-89) with eight doubles, nine home runs, 19 RBI, a .402 on-base percentage, a .775 slugging percentage and a 1.177 OPS in his last 24 games vs. the White Sox...Buxton's 16 career home runs and 40 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...he has nine homers and 17 RBI in his last 17 games.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE MONTHLYS: Low-A Fort Myers catcher Andrew Cossetti and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher David Festa have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for April.

Ⓢ Cossetti, 23, played in 19 games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .339 (20-for-59) with eight doubles, four home runs, 20 RBI, 11 walks, a .474 on-base percentage and a 1.152 OPS...the Eagleville, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of St. Joseph's University in Philadelphia.

Ⓢ Festa, 23, made four starts for the Wind Surge, going 1-1, 3.79 ERA (19.0 IP, 8 ER), with five walks and 27 strikeouts...the Verona, New Jersey native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University.
