FIRST TIME ON THE SOUTH SIDE: Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this season after taking a no-decision vs. the White Sox in a 4-3 Minnesota win on April 11 at Target Field...pitched 7.2 innings, allowing two runs and three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts...allowed the first four batters to reach in the first inning before retiring the final 23 hitters he faced, the third-most batters sent down in succession in Twins history, per *Elias*...recorded 10 strikeouts for the third time in his career, falling one short of his career high of 11, done twice previously with Miami (May 13, 2022 vs. Milwaukee; July 26, 2022 at Cincinnat)...his last start vs. the White Sox marked his Target Field debut and his first career start against Chicago-AL.

NEW BALLPARK: Today is López's fourth road start of the year and first career start at Guaranteed Rate Field...marks his fourth new ballpark of the season (Kauffman Stadium, Target Field, Yankee Stadium) and 24th of his career...in 23 career starts at a new venue, López is 10-5 with a 3.54 ERA (129.2 IP, 51 ER), 33 walks and 134 strikeouts...the Twins have gone 1-2 in his first three road starts of 2023, with López going 1-1, 1.47 ERA (18.1 IP, 3 ER) with five walks and 23 strikeouts...over his career, López is 15-17, 4.31 ERA (244.1 IP, 117 ER) with 68 walks and 244 strikeouts...over his career, López is 15-17, 4.31 ERA (244.1 IP, 117 ER) with 68 walks and 244 strikeouts... over starts...in 53 home starts, he is 15-16, 3.64 ERA (301.2 IP, 122 ER) with 83 walks and 291 strikeouts.
