ANOTHER TOUGH LATE LOSS ON THE SOUTH SIDE: The Twins lost to the White Sox last nigh at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of $6-4$, losing the three-game series, making them 5-4-1 in series play in 2023, including 1-3-1 on the road...Louie Varland made his second start of homer to Luis Robert Jr. in the first inning...Griffin Jax (1-3) was dealt the loss, allowing an RBI-single to Eloy Jiménez in the sevent eight hits and tied their season-high with six walks...they went 3 -for- 8 with runners in scoring position, but left the bases loaded in the seventh inning with nobody out as Carlos Correa and Byron Buxton each grounded into a fielder's choice, followed by a frevor Larnach strikeout.

LEFT/RIGHT: López has limited right-handed hitters to a 228 (18-for-79) batting average this sea-son...left-handed hitters are batting at a . 241 (13-for-54) clip...his 28 strikeouts against righties are tied for ninth most in the American League....ver his career, López has better numbers against right-handed hitters (. 665 OPS) than left-handed hitters (. 740 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: López has used a five-pitch mix in his first six starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has exclusively used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball when facing left-handed hitters...allowed four hits against his curveball on April 28 vs. Kansas City after allowing only three hits off the pitch in his first five starts combined... here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:
