THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game homestand with a record of 6-4 (1-2 against the Nationals, 2-1 against the Yankees and 3-1 against the Royals), the Twins began their six-game roadtrip with a series loss on the South Side against the White Sox this week...

THE OL' FIVE-RUN 12TH, EXACTLY HOW YOU DRAW IT UP: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon in Chicago by a score of 7-3 in 12 innings, avoiding the three-game sweep... Pablo Lopez was the starter but did not factor into the decision...

"SOMEHOW I MANAGE" BY MICHAEL SCOTT ROCCO BALDELLI: Yesterday's win in Chicago gave Rocco Baldelli his 306th career managerial win, passing Paul Molitor and moving into sole possession of fifth place on the Twins all-time managerial wins list...

NOTE: Rocco's .529 winning percentage ranks second on the Twins all-time managerial wins list (min. 500 games), trailing only Sam Mele (.548).

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the first of 13 times in 2023... the Twins went 6-13 against the Guardians last season, going 3-6 at Target Field and 3-7 at Progressive Field...

Carlos Correa hit .387 (24-for-62) with one double, five home runs, 10 RBI, seven walks, a .457 on-base percentage, a .645 slugging percentage and a 1.102 OPS in 16 games vs. Cleveland last season... he slashed .324/.452/.500 at Cleveland in 2023, reaching base 19 times (11 hits, 7 walks, 1 HBP), the most for any opponent in this park.

For his career, Max Kepler has 43 hits, 14 home runs, 30 runs scored and 31 RBI at Progressive Field (47 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark. The Twins have hit 32 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, their second-most outside of Target Field in that span... they have hit 33 at Guaranteed Rate Field in that span.

TROUBLE GUARDING LEADS: Of the 19 games against the Guardians last season, the Twins held a lead then lost in seven of those, the most by any opponent last season... in fact, five of those seven losses took place between June 21-30... below are the Twins starting pitcher numbers vs. Cleveland last season, compared to the bullpen numbers:

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered in a season-long 16 straight games, since April 18, tying the all-time franchise record (since 1901)... since that date, they have hit 26 home runs, the third most in baseball in that span, trailing Atlanta (30) and Tampa Bay (30)... the current streak is the second longest of 2023, trailing the Rays' stretch of 22 straight to begin the season (March 30-April 23).

NOTE: Twins have scored an AL-leading 47.6 percent of their runs via homers this season.

BUCK TRUCK ROLLIN' UP: Byron Buxton has hit safely in a season-long eight-straight games and in 12 of his last 13, since April 19... his eight-game streak is the third-longest of his career, trailing his 12-gamer (August 10-21, 2017) and his 10-gamer (April 1-20, 2021)... in his last 13, since April 19, he is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with six doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, nine walks, a .414 on-base percentage, a .796 slugging percentage and a 1.210 OPS... below are his first 16 compared to his last 13:

ALSO: Buck has reached base multiple times in six-straight, the longest stretch of his career... it is the longest streak for a Twin since Josh Donaldson reached multiple times in seven straight from August 24-30, 2021.

iTWINS: Tonight's game will be on Apple TV+, marking the Twins' first time on that viewing format this season... they will also play on Apple TV+ next Friday night, May 12 against the Chicago Cubs at Target Field.

SAINT PAUL K-AINTS: Triple-A St. Paul pitchers set a franchise record with 19 strikeouts last night in a 10-8 10-inning loss to Nashville... it surpassed the previous record of 17, done on May 8, 2022 vs. Iowa... Brent Headrick (3.2 IP) fanned nine, Cody Laweryson (3.0 IP) fanned five, Oliver Ortega (1.0 IP) had one, Kody Funderburk (0.2 IP) had two and Connor Sadzeck (1.1 IP) had two.

🍌🍌🍌🍌 : Low-A Fort Myers catcher/first baseman Andrew Cossetti has been named Florida State League Player of the Month for April, as announced yesterday by Minor League Baseball... Cossetti, 23, batted .395/.474/.678 and led the league in average, home runs (4), doubles (8), RBI (20), on-base percentage (.474), slugging percentage (.678) and OPS (1.152)... he was second in total bases (40) and sixth in hits (20).

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in a 3-2 Twins defeat against the Kansas City Royals at Target Field on April 29, opposite Brad Keller...pitched 5.2 innings, allowed one run, walked two batters, and fanned six...marked Ober's most strikeouts since September 27, 2022 when he fanned a career-high 10 batters against Chicago-AL...his lone blemish came in the fifth inning when he yielded a game-tying RBI single to Nicky Lopez...lifted from the game in the sixth inning with two outs after allowing a single to Nick Pratto...relieved by Caleb Thielbar, followed by Griffin Jax, Jorge López and Jhoan Duran...López allowed a RBI single to the first batter he faced, Salvador Perez, in the eighth inning...the winning run scored on Duran's first wild pitch of the season in the ninth.

TWO STARTS AGO: Won his first major league start of 2023 on April 23 vs. Washington in the Twins 3-1 victory...went 5.2 innings, allowing one run on three hits, with three walks and four strikeouts in his first career start vs. the Nationals...marked his first MLB victory since September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...allowed his only run in the first inning on an RBI double by catcher Keibert Ruiz, then retired 13 of the final 16 batters he faced...the three walks issued tied his career high, done once before on June 30, 2021 at Chicago-AL...opposed left-hander Patrick Corbin, who took the loss...Twins left-hander Caleb Thielbar relieved Ober with two outs in the sixth inning and retired infielder CJ Abrams to end the frame.

OBER VS. CLEVELAND: Tonight is Ober's fourth career start against the Guardians, having faced Cleveland twice in 2021 and one time in 2022...is seeking his first win vs. the Guardians after going 0-1 with a 2.40 ERA (15.0 IP, 4 ER), one walk and 12 strikeouts in his three previous starts...last faced Cleveland on September 16, 2022 at Progressive Field after being reinstated from the 60-day Injured List with a right groin strain...did not factor into the Twins 4-3 loss after pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with just one walk, one hit allowed and five strikeouts.

RETURN TO THE ROAD: Ober is making his first road start of the season...last season, he went 0-3, 3.09 ERA (32.0 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and 23 strikeouts in six road starts...owns two career starts at Progressive Field, going 0-0, 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 1 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts in those outings.

☞ Ober is 1-5, 3.77 ERA (76.1 IP, 32 ER) with 13 walks and 70 strikeouts in 16 career starts on the road...Twins have gone 8-8 in his road starts...ranks 12th for the most strikeouts in their first 16 road starts with the Twins, 15th in lowest ERA and fifth in lowest earned runs allowed (min. 75.0 IP).

THE RIGHT WAY: Right-handed hitters are batting just .111 (2-for-18) with seven strikeouts against Ober after his first two starts of the season...left-handed hitters are hitting .238 (5-for-21) with three strikeouts...all five of Ober's walks issued this season have been to left-handed hitters.

☞ In his career, right-handed hitters are batting .217/.237/.411 with 12 doubles and 96 strikeouts against Ober...lefties are slashing .275/.341/.441 with 16 doubles and 61 strikeouts off him.

ARSENAL: Ober used a four-pitch mix in his first two starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...three of Ober's four strikeouts in his last start on April 29 came from his fastball...also threw 50 fastballs in his last start...mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

OBER THE MOON: Tonight is Ober's first night start this season, 20th of his career...went 1-2, 3.47 ERA (36.1 IP, 14 ER) with five walks and 37 strikeouts in seven night starts last year...is 3-4, 3.62 ERA (92.0 IP, 37 ER) with 16 walks and 99 strikeouts in 19 night starts in his career.

☞ Tied for second with Bert Blyleven for the most strikeouts in their first 19 career night games with the Twins, trailing Joe Ryan (117); ranks eighth in lowest ERA (min. 65.0 IP).

☞ Ranked third in lowest night ERA among the Twins pitching staff last year (min. 35.0 IP), trailing Sonny Gray (3.03) and Caleb Thielbar (3.22)...ranked second in lowest WHIP (0.991) behind Thielbar (0.853).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
