THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, going 1-2 at Chicago-AL, followed by a win in Cleveland last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with game two of this three-game weekend series at Progressive Field against the Guardians...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel to Minneapolis to enjoy an off-day on Monday, then begin a six-game Interleague homestand with three against the San Diego Padres (May 9-11) and three against the Chicago Cubs (May 12-14)...the Twins have gone 10-6 at Target Field and 9-8 on the road.

◆ Twins are looking to win their third-straight road game, which would mark their longest since winning four straight to start the season (March 30-April 3).

◆ A victory tonight would secure the sixth series win of the season for the Twins...the Twins have gone 5-4-1 through their first 10 series this season (series results lower right).

LOVE IS A BATTENFIELD: The Twins shut out the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 2-0, marking their third shutout this season (3/30 at KC & 4/1 at KC)...Bailey Ober (2-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, falling one out short of tying his career high for innings pitched (7.1, 9/27/22 vs. CWS)... Guards starter Peyton Battenfield retired his first 17 batters until a two-out Christian Vázquez single, followed by Max Kepler two-run homer in the sixth inning, proving to be all the scoring on the night...Jorge Polanco had the third hit for the Twins as the three hits marked their fewest in a victory since a 2-1 win at Boston on September 5, 2019, when they had two hits.

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the second of 13 times in 2023...since the start of 2022, 15 of the 20 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and nine by one run.

♣ A win tonight would give the Twins their first series victory vs. the Guardians since taking two of three games from May 13-15, 2022 at Target Field...Twins have gone 0-4-0 in head-to-head series play against them since...their last series win at Progressive Field came September 6-9, 2021, taking three of four.

♣ The Twins have hit 33 home runs at Cleveland since the start of 2021, tied with their total at Guaranteed Rate Field for the most outside of Target Field in that span.

♣ Since 2019, Carlos Correa is hitting .325 (37-for-114) with four doubles, eight home runs, 16 RBI, 20 runs scored, 14 walks, a .430 on-base percentage and a .973 OPS in 30 games vs. Cleveland...he slashed .324/.452/.500 at Cleveland in 2023, reaching base 19 times (11 hits, 7 walks, 1 HBP), the most for any opponent in this park.

MAD MAX, FURY ROAD: For his career, Max Kepler has 44 hits, 15 home runs, 31 runs scored and 33 RBI at Progressive Field (48 games), all his most in any opposing ballpark...his homers are tied with Nelson Cruz (15) for the second most for any active visiting player, behind Miguel Cabrera (26).

♣ Kepler hit three home runs in a game here twice in his career: August 1, 2016, and June 6, 2019...according to *Elias*, he is the only active player with more than one three-homer game as a visitor at any venue...the last visiting player to do this at any ballpark was Albert Pujols at Wrigley Field (2004 and 2010).

ELAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered in a season-long 17-straight games, since April 18, setting an all-time franchise record (since 1901)...since that date, they have hit 27 home runs, the third most in baseball in that span, trailing Tampa Bay (32) and Atlanta (31)...the current streak is the second longest of 2023, trailing the Rays' stretch of 22 straight to begin the season (March 30-April 23).

LOW ON LEFTIES: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for just the sixth time this season the previous five being Jesús Luzardo on April 5 at Miami (5-2 loss), Nestor Cortes on April 14 at New York-AL (4-3 win), Chris Sale on April 18 at Boston (5-4 loss), Patrick Corbin on April 23 vs. Washington (3-1 win) and Cortes again on April 25 (6-2 win)...the Twins have the fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at just 206.

◆ Twins are slashing just .194/.273/.359 vs. lefties, compared to .232/.310/.405 vs. righties.

**SHINING STARTS:** Twins starters have combined to go 14-8, 3.13 ERA (186.2 IP, 65 ER) with 45 walks, 210 strikeouts and a .220 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in all of baseball:

THE NASTY BOYS: The bullpen has combined to post a .281 w0BA this season, the fifth best in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-AL (.259), Tampa Bay (.268), Texas (.270) and Seattle (.275)...additionally, the 'pen has allowed the fifth-fewest hits in baseball with 90, trailing New York-AL (86), Chicago-NL (87), Texas (87) and Houston (88).

The Twins bullpen has averaged 94.2 mph on fastballs, the seventh-hardest-throwing 'pen in baseball...however, they have thrown just 846 fastballs, second fewest in the majors...they have thrown 360 offspeed pitches, second most in baseball.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: On this day in 2021, Nick Gordon made his major league debut vs. Texas, batting seventh and playing second base...he went 1-for-2 with a single, a walk, a strikeout and two stolen bases...Gordon is hitting .294 (5-for-17) with one double, one triple, two home runs, five RBI and just one strikeout with a 1.118 OPS in his last six games.

**GIVE HIM A HAND:** Gray appeared on MLB Network Thursday morning to receive the April Pitch Hand award from Robert Flores...in the month of April, Gray went 4-0, 0.77 ERA (35.0 IP, 3 ER) with 12 walks and 41 strikeouts...here is how his April numbers rank across the American League and all of baseball:

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his fourth win of the season in the series finale against the Kansas City Royals on April 30 at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins victory, opposite Brady Singer...marked the third time this season he has pitched at least 6.0 innings (also pitched 7.0 innings vs. Houston on April 7 and 7.0 vs. New York-AL on April 24)...yielded his only run on a RBI groundout by Edward Olivares...relieved by Emilio Pagán in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings while allowing three runs

- Pagán in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 innings while allowing three runs (two earned)...one run scored on an error by Jorge Polanco in the seventh...Josh Winder allowed a two-RBI single to Vinnie Pasquantino in the ninth.

  Brought his ERA to 0.77, the fourth lowest in Twins/Senators history in ERA through a pitcher's first six starts of a season (since 1913, min. 30.0 IP), trailing Walter Johnson (0.23 in 1913), Eddie Matteson (0.55 in 1918) and Ervin Santana (0.66, 2017).

  Has allowed one-or-fewer runs and tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his six starts this season, tied with Ervin Santana (April 3- May 2, 2017) for the longest such streak to start the season in Twins/Senators history since 1913.

  The start was Gray's 30th in a Twins uniform...has a 2.56 ERA through his first 30 starts with the Twins, the third lowest ERA within a pitcher's first 30 career games as a Twin (min. 150.0 IP), behind Scott Erickson (2.31 ERA from June 25, 1990-June 2, 1991) and Dean Chance (2.52 ERA from April 13-August 22 (1), 1967).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Earned the 6-1 Twins win in the series opener against New York-AL on April 24 at Target Field, opposite Jhony Brito...pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, issued two walks and struck out eight batters...marked the second time Gray has pitched at least 7.0 innings this season (also 7.0 IP on April 7 vs. Houston)...was relieved by Griffin Jax in the eighth inning followed by Jovani Moran in the ninth...the lone run allowed by the bullpen was an RBI groundout to Oswaldo Cabrera in the ninth inning...threw 107 pitches, the most pitches Gray has thrown since August 14, 2020 against Pittsburgh when he tossed 110 pitches.

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Gray is facing the Guardians for the 16th time in his career, going 6-4, 3.53 ERA (81.2 IP, 32 ER) with 31 walks and 83 strikeouts in his 15 previous appearances...last faced Cleveland on September 19, 2022 at Progressive Field, taking the 11-4 loss after allowing four runs on five hits (1 HR) with one walk and one strikeout in 2.0 innings; was removed from the game with a right hamstring strain that ended his season...was relieved in the third inning by Ronny Henriquez, as the bullpen combined to pitch 6.0 innings.

♣ Has had four starts against the Guardians since becoming a Twin in 2022...is 1-1, 4.67 ERA (17.1 IP, 9 ER) with six walks and 16 strikeouts in that span, including, 1-1, 4.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks, four strikeouts and a .250 (8-for-32) opponent batting average in two starts at Progressive Field.

♣ His .290 batting average against the Guardians since 2022 is his fourth highest against any opponent since becoming a Twin.

♣ In the six games between his last two losses against the Guardians (August 3, 2017 and September 19, 2022), Gray went 3-0, 2.84 ERA (31.2 IP, 10 ER) with 11 walks and 36 strikeouts.

♣ Gray is also 6-1, 1.76 ERA (41.0 IP, 8 ER) with 12 walks, 41 strikeouts and a .193 (29-for-150) opponent batting average in his last eight starts against the American League Central division, since July 24, 2022; Twins are 6-2 in those games.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Gray is making his third road start of the season tonight, going 1-0, 0.90 ERA (10.0 IP, 1 ER) with six walks, eight strikeouts and a .250 (10-for-40) opponent batting average in his two prior road outings, on April 1 at Kansas City (W, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 4 BB, 1 K) and April 18 at Boston (ND, 5.0 IP, 7 H, 1 RVER, 2 BB, 7 K)...went 4-3, 3.63 ERA (52.0 IP, 21 ER) with 11 walks and 39 strikeouts in 11 road starts in 2022 and is 41-39, 3.22 ERA (668.2 IP, 239 ER) with 248 walks and 645 strikeouts in 120 career road appearances, including 115 starts.

© Is 3-1, 3.11 ERA (37.2 IP, 13 ER) with 13 walks and 35 strikeouts in his last eight road starts, since July 24, 2022.

THIS IS THE (RIGHT) WAY: So far this season, Gray has seen similar success against lefties and righties with a slight edge against right-handers...Gray has held righties to a .190 (15-for-79) batting average with six doubles and 31 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are batting .208 (10-for-48) with four doubles and 10 strikeouts.

◆ Ranks 15th among American League pitchers in opponent batting average against righties... also owns the eighth-most strikeouts against righties.

**THE ARSENAL:** Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...continues to use his curveball the most at 25.4 percent...primarily uses his curveball (90 pitches) and changeup (41 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (93 pitches), sinker (92 pitches) and sweeper (83 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:
