THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 vs. the Giants and 1-2 vs. the Blue Jays), the Twins traveled to Houston for a short three-game roadtrip and took two of three from the Astros this week, winning games one and three...

LOUIE V. SO MUCH MONEY: The Twins beat the Astros last night at Minute Maid Park by a score of 8-2, winning their eighth series of the season (8-9-1), including their second on the road (2-6-1), first since opening the season with a three-game sweep at Kansas City...

WELCOME BACK, POLO: The Twins have reinstated infielder Jorge Polanco from the 10-day Injured List...Polanco, who was placed on the Injured List on May 20 with a strained left hamstring, has played in 23 games for the Twins this season, hitting .284 (27-for-95) with seven doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, 10 runs scored, six walks and an .811 OPS...

STARTER STRENGTH: Twins starters have averaged 5.6 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in all of baseball:

ADDITIONALLY: The Twins' 267 strikeouts in May set a club record for the month after setting a club record for any month in April with 274...below are the club's all-time strikeout totals for May:

TWINS-GUARDS: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the fourth of 13 times in 2023...these two last met for a three-game series at Progressive Field from May 5-7, as the Twins won the first of the three games...Twins were outscored 6-5 in the series.

Since the start of 2022, 17 of the 22 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and 10 by one run.

The Twins have hit 58 home runs against Cleveland pitching since the start of 2021, their most vs. any opponent in that span...next is Kansas City (56) and Chicago-AL (55).

Since 2019, Carlos Correa is hitting .311 (38-for-122) with four doubles, nine home runs, 17 RBI, 21 runs scored, 14 walks, a .387 on-base percentage and a .952 OPS in 32 games vs. Cleveland...however, he is just 1-for-12 this season with no walks and one home run (off Stephan on May 6).

Max Kepler hit two home runs during the three-run series at Progressive Field in May, one off Peyton Battenfield and one off Logan Allen...since 2016, nobody in baseball has more home runs vs. Cleveland pitching than Kepler's 22 (chart in the right margin).

FEELING MINNESOTA: The Twins are 16-12 at home, compared to 13-15 on the road...they have a run differential at home of +27 (135-108) and +19 on the road (121-102)...the offense at home has hit .246 (228-for-927) with 50 doubles, 40 home runs, a .768 OPS and 4.82 runs-per-game...on the road they have hit .221 (214-for-970) with 37 doubles, 34 home runs, a .674 OPS and 4.32 runs-per-game.

AK'S PAs AND ABS: Alex Kirilloff has reached base safely in 11 of his last 14 plate appearances and in 16 of his last 24 PAs...in his last five games he has posted a .652 on-base percentage, drawing seven walks and recording seven hits (1 HBP)...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Kirilloff has hit .314 (22-for-70) with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, 14 walks, a .448 on-base percentage and a .934 OPS in 23 games...among players with at least 75 PAs in May, his .448 OBP ranked sixth best in baseball. He is hitting .415 (17-for-41) with four extra-base hits off fastballs this season.

LOU GEHRIG DAY: The Twins, in partnership with local chapters of the ALS Association and I AM ALS, will host Lou Gehrig Day today at Target Field, as the club hosts Cleveland...pregame ceremonies and club social media posts will raise awareness of, and funds for, ALS research by honoring the strength and courage of individuals and families living with the disease...Lynn Giovannelli of St. Louis Park, MN, who was diagnosed with ALS in July 2020, and her family will be honored on the field prior to the game; since her diagnosis, Lynn, her husband and her three sons have become fierce ambassadors for the fight to find a cure, while showing everyone what it looks like to say "yes" as often as possible - to travel, to live music, to social gatherings, and to not missing their sons' music and sporting events... additionally, the club will acknowledge two Twins legends who both lost a parent to ALS (Kent Hrbek and Terry Steinbach), will encourage participation in local ALS Association fundraising events, and will celebrate club partner Carrier, who makes a financial donation to the ALS Association through the Strike Out ALS campaign for every strikeout a Twins pitcher records at Target Field...the Twins are also hosting 300 members of the ALS community for an evening at the ballpark.

- ⚡ Facing Cleveland for the second time in his career and first since April 23, 2019 with Miami at Progressive Field (W; 6.1 IP, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- ⚡ Acquired by the Twins from Miami on January 20, 2023, along with infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his first win of May in the Twins 9-7 victory over the Toronto Blue Jays at Target Field on May 27...pitched opposite Chris Bassitt, who took the loss...went 5.2 innings, allowing four runs on five hits, with three walks and six strikeouts...allowed two home runs, a solo shot from shortstop Bo Bichette in the first inning and another solo homer to second baseman Cavan Biggio in the fourth; marked his second start this year in which he allowed multiple homers (3 on May 15 at Los Angeles-NL)...was relieved with two outs in the top of the sixth by Jovani Moran, who stranded one inherited runner...marked just the second win of his career allowing four-or-more runs, also doing so on April 28 vs. Kansas City (6 R).

- ⚡ Marked his 10th start of 2023 in which he recorded six-or-more strikeouts; is tied with TB's Shane McCannahan and PIT's Mitch Keller for the second-most such starts in baseball this year, trailing only ATL's Spencer Strider (11).
- ⚡ Through 11 starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (81 - 4th), innings pitched (65.2 - 13th), pitches-per-inning (15.7 - 13th) and WHIP (1.13 - 15th).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took the loss despite recording a quality start against the Los Angeles Angels on May 21 at Angel Stadium, a 4-2 Twins loss...faced right-hander Shohei Ohtani, who did not factor into the decision...went 6.0 innings, allowed two runs on five hits, with three walks and nine strikeouts...allowed a sacrifice fly to infielder Gio Urshela in the bottom of the fourth inning...walked pinch hitter Matt Thaiss to start the bottom of the seventh and was relieved by Jorge López, who allowed two runs to score in the inning...Twins dropped the finale to lose the three-game series two games to one.

- ⚡ Struck out nine batters, his second-highest total of the season (10 on April 11 vs. Chicago-AL).

**ON GUARD:** Facing the Guardians for the second time in his career and first since April 23, 2019 with Miami; earned the win at Progressive Field, going 6.1 innings and allowing one unearned run on two hits with two walks and six strikeouts in a 3-1 Marlins victory...marked his first career start vs. an American League Central opponent and the coldest temperature at first pitch (56 degrees) in his career; has since started two games in which the gametime temperature was under 50 degrees, both at Target Field in 2023 (35 degrees - April 22 vs. Washington and 48 degrees - April 28 vs. Kansas City).

- ⚡ Has faced five current Cleveland hitters in his career, with infielder Josh Bell owning the most experience against López (3-for-13 in 17 plate appearances).
- ⚡ In six career starts vs. AL Central opponents (KC - 3, CWS - 2, CLE - 1), he is 3-1, 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER) with eight walks and 45 strikeouts...Twins have gone 4-0 in his four starts against the AL Central this season, with López going 2-0, 3.46 ERA (26.0 IP, 10 ER).

**BACK AT TARGET:** Today is López's sixth home start of the year...Minnesota has won four of his five home starts, with López going 2-1, 5.46 ERA (29.2 IP, 18 ER) with 11 walks and 37 strikeouts...in his six road starts this season, López has gone 1-2, 3.00 ERA (36.0 IP, 12 ER) with nine walks and 44 strikeouts, with the Twins going 2-4 those six games...over his career, López is 16-16, 3.64 ERA (313.2 IP, 127 ER) with 90 walks and 305 strikeouts in 55 home starts...in 50 road starts, he is 15-18, 4.33 ERA (262.0 IP, 126 ER) with 72 walks and 265 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Looking for back-to-back home wins for the third time in his career and first time since beating Philadelphia on April 15, 2022 and St. Louis on April 21, 2022 in consecutive starts at loanDepot Park with Miami.

**LEFT/RIGHT:** López has limited right-handed hitters to a .214 (31-for-145) batting average this season...left-handed hitters are batting at a .240 (23-for-96) clip...his 53 strikeouts against righties are the third most in the American League this year, trailing only HOU's Framber Valdez (68) and TB's Shane McCannahan (73)...overall, opposing hitters are batting .224 (54-for-241) vs. López this year, the 16th-lowest opponent batting average among qualified American League pitchers...over his career, he has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.662 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.747 OPS).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Used a five-pitch mix in his first 11 starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has exclusively used his sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball when facing left-handed hitters...recorded three strikeouts with his sweeper in his last start on May 27 vs. Toronto; ranks tied for seventh in baseball in strikeouts on sweepers in 2023...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

- ⚡ López's changeup has accumulated a run value of -6 this year, tied with four other pitchers for the fourth-best run value on a changeup in baseball, according to Baseball Savant.
- ⚡ Threw a 97.2 mph four-seam fastball to shortstop Bo Bichette in the first inning of his last start, the sixth-fastest pitch of his career, according to Statcast...in his first 11 starts this year, López has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph, a 2.1 mph increase from last season and the largest year-to-year jump of his career.

**SHAKY STARTS, THEN SMOOTH SAILING:** López allowed a solo home run to shortstop Bo Bichette in the first inning of his last start vs. Toronto on May 27; marked the seventh time in his 11 starts this year that he allowed one-or-more runs in the first inning...10 of López's 30 runs allowed (33.3 percent) and 18 of his 54 hits (also 33.3 percent) allowed this season have come in the first inning...here are his numbers in the first inning compared to all other innings combined this season:

**HEATING UP:** In 14 career starts during the month of June, López is 7-3, 3.64 ERA (81.2 IP, 33 ER) with 17 walks and 85 strikeouts...his seven wins are the most in any month of his career...last season, he went 1-2 with a 5.34 ERA (28.2 IP, 17 ER), nine walks and 27 strikeouts in five June starts for Miami; marked his highest ERA in any month last year.

- ⚡ Recorded 35 strikeouts this May, second most among Twins pitchers (Joe Ryan - 40), to help Minnesota strike out 267 hitters last month, the most in May in team history (since 1961).

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2023: 3-2, 2.68 ERA // CAREER: 8-8, 3.58 ERA)**

Bailey Ober is set to start the second game of the four-game series against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field tomorrow night...lost his second-straight start in his last outing on May 28 vs. Toronto, a 3-0 Twins defeat; pitched 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...both runs came on a two-run single to catcher Alejandro Kirk in the second inning which had an exit velocity of 78.3 mph and expected batting average of .040, per Baseball Savant...facing the Guardians for the second time this season and fifth time in his career...is 1-1, 1.64 ERA (22.0 IP, 4 ER) with two walks and 18 strikeouts in five previous starts vs. Cleveland...earned win after firing 7.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts on May 5 in Twins 2-0 victory over the Guardians.

- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Braynan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
- Spent 2017 season at High-A level in Seattle and Miami organizations.
- Went 6-1, 1.88 ERA (71.2 IP, 15 ER) in 17 appearances (13 starts) for Low-A Clinton (Seattle) in 2016.
- Missed 2014 season following Tommy John surgery on November 11, 2013.
