but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Jhoan Duran (2-2) pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief and earned the win...Duran stranded six runners in the outing, leaving the bases full of Jays in the ninth inning and leaving two men on in the 10th inning, all while throwing a season-high 38 pitches (2 short of his career-high (all singles)....Michael A. Taylor added his ninth home run of the season and drove in all three of Minnesota's runs.
