- ⌘ Making his 14th start and appearance and seventh home start of 2023...also his 108th career appearance (all starts) in his sixth major league season (Miami - 2018-22).
- ⌘ Facing Milwaukee for the sixth time in his career; is 1-1, 3.19 ERA (31.0 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 33 strikeouts in five previous starts against the Brewers.
- ⌘ Acquired by the Twins from Miami on January 20, 2023, along with infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez.

LAST TIME OUT: Went 7.0 innings and allowed only one run but took a no-decision in the Twins' 2-1 defeat against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field on June 7...allowed five hits (1 HR), issued one walk and struck out six batters...pitched opposite Shawn Armstrong who fired 2.0 scoreless innings as an opener...allowed a solo home run to third baseman Isaac Paredes to lead off the second inning, then retired 17 of the final 21 batters he faced from the second through the seventh inning...was relieved by Brock Stewart to begin the eighth inning with Minnesota trailing 1-0; Twins tied the game on an RBI single from third baseman Royce Lewis in the top of the ninth inning, but Jhoan Duran allowed a walkoff solo home run to designated hitter Randy Arozarena in the bottom of the ninth.

- ⌘ Marked just the fourth time in his career that his team lost when he worked at least 7.0 innings and allowed one-or-fewer runs (9-4 team record in 13 career starts under those parameters).
- ⌘ Picked off shortstop Wander Franco in the third inning; was his third pickoff of the season (2 at Miami on April 5), tied with KC's Taylor Clarke for the most in the American League this year.
- ⌘ Through 13 starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (92 - T-3rd), innings pitched (78.1 - 10th), pitches-per-inning (15.4 - 14th) and FIP (3.75 - 15th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 7-6 win over the Cleveland Guardians on June 1 at Target Field...opposed rookie Tanner Bibee, who also took a no-decision...pitched 5.2 innings, allowing a season-high-tying six runs and eight hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...retired the side in order in the first inning for the first time since Opening Day on March 30 at Kansas City...allowed one run in the second inning on an RBI single from rightfielder Will Brennan...allowed five runs on six singles and one walk in the top of the sixth inning...was relieved by Emilio Pagan with two outs in the sixth and Minnesota trailing 6-3...Twins overcame the three-run deficit and won on a walk-off sacrifice fly from leftfielder Willi Castro in the ninth inning.

- ⌘ His five runs allowed in the top of the sixth inning marked the most runs he has allowed in an inning since he allowed seven runs in the top of the fourth inning on September 10, 2022 vs. New York-NL.
- ⌘ His 76.1 strike percentage vs. Cleveland was the second-highest strike percentage of his career, trailing only his 78.3 strike percentage (83 pitches, 65 strikes) on July 11, 2021 vs. Atlanta.

LÓPEZ VS. MILWAUKEE: Facing the Brewers for the sixth time in his career tonight...in five previous starts vs. Milwaukee, all with Miami, he went 1-1, 3.19 ERA (31.0 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 33 strikeouts; Marlins went 2-3 in those starts...went 0-0, 0.64 ERA (14.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and 18 strikeouts in two starts against the Brewers last season; set his career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 innings vs. Milwaukee on May 13, 2022 and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings at American Family Field on October 2, 2022...looking for his first win against the Brewers since June 4, 2019; pitched 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts in a 16-0 Marlins win in Milwaukee.

- ⌘ López has limited the 11 current Brewers hitters who have faced him previously to a .163 (7-for-43) batting average with 20 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Making his seventh home start of 2023 to begin the Twins' 10-game homestand...has gone 2-1 with a 6.11 ERA (35.1 IP, 24 ER), 12 walks and 42 strikeouts in his first six home outings...despite López having the third-highest home ERA among qualified pitchers in the American League, the Twins have gone 5-1 in his six home starts as the offense has provided him with an average of 6.11 runs of support at Target Field, the 12th-highest run support average at home in the AL (min. 5 home GS)...in seven road starts this year, he is 1-2 with a 2.72 ERA (43.0 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks and 50 strikeouts; Minnesota owns a 2-5 record in his seven starts away from Target Field in 2023, with López receiving only 1.67 runs of support on average.

- ⌘ In 56 career home starts, he is 16-16, 3.75 ERA (319.1 IP, 133 ER) with 91 walks and 310 strikeouts...is 15-18, 4.25 ERA (269.0 IP, 127 ER) with 73 walks and 271 strikeouts in 51 career road starts.

RIGHT ON: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .211 (35-for-166) batting average this season...his 59 strikeouts against righties are the fourth most in the American League this year, trailing only TB's Shane Bieber (79), HOU's Framber Valdez (77) and TOR's Kevin Gausman (70)...his .211 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks 11th in the AL (min. 10 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting at a .256 (32-for-125) clip against him in 2023...over his career, he has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.665 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.709 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first 13 starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...threw his first sinker of the season to a left-handed hitter in his last start on June 7 at Tampa Bay, as shortstop Wander Franco grounded into a fielder's choice on the pitch; also allowed his first home run on a sinker this year in his last outing (Isaac Paredes, 2nd inning)...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

- ⌘ López's changeup has accumulated a run value of -7 this year, tied with teammate Jovani Moran for the fifth-best run value on a changeup in baseball, according to Baseball Savant.
- ⌘ In his first 13 starts this year, López has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph, a 2.1 mph increase from last season and the largest year-to-year jump of his career.

CUTTING TO THE CHASE: Through 13 starts, López has a career-high 35.1 chase percentage, placing him in the 95th percentile in all of baseball, according to Baseball Savant...his chase rate ranks second on the Twins staff (Joe Ryan - 36.5) and 19th in the majors...also has a career-best 52.4 percent swing rate and 29.7 percent whiff rate in 2023.

INTERLEAGUE NUMBERS: In 17 career Interleague appearances (all starts), López is 4-6, 3.45 ERA (94.0 IP, 36 ER) with 23 walks and 103 strikeouts...13 of those starts were against American League opponents with Miami from 2018-22, and he has made four starts vs. National League teams as a Twin this year (April 5 at Miami, April 22 vs. Washington, May 10 vs. San Diego and May 15 at Los Angeles-NL)...in his four Interleague starts this season, López is 0-1, 4.91 ERA (22.0 IP, 12 ER) with seven walks and 26 strikeouts...seeking his first Interleague win since August 23, 2022 at Oakland (6.0 IP, 0 R/ER, 4 H, 2 BB, 5 K).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2023: 3-3, 2.61 ERA // CAREER: 8-9, 3.51 ERA)

Bailey Ober is set to start the two-game series finale against the Milwaukee Brewers at Target Field tomorrow afternoon...lost his last start on June 8 at Tampa Bay in the Twins 4-2 defeat; went 5.1 innings, allowing four runs (3 earned) on three hits, with two walks and a season-high-tying seven strikeouts...retired the first 11 batters he faced, including striking out six consecutive hitters in the second and third innings, but allowed three runs in the fourth inning and one in the sixth...facing the Brewers for the first time in his career; Milwaukee will become the 17th team he has faced in the majors...in 16 previous starts when facing a new opponent, he is 2-4, 4.21 ERA (77.0 IP, 36 ER) with 20 walks and 75 strikeouts...is 1-2, 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER) in five daytime starts this year.

CAREER NOTES

- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
- Spent 2017 season at High-A level in Seattle and Miami organizations.
- Went 6-1, 1.88 ERA (71.2 IP, 15 ER) in 17 appearances (13 starts) for Low-A Clinton (Seattle) in 2016.
- Missed 2014 season following Tommy John surgery on November 11, 2013.
- Made professional debut with Venezuelan Summer League Mariners on May 23, 2013.
- Originally signed by Seattle as international free agent on July 4, 2012.
