TWINS MISS OUT ON HAT TRICK IN TORONTO: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays on Sunday afternoon at Rogers Centre by a score of 7-6, failing to record their second sweep of the season... Louie Varland was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 4.2 innings pitched...Emilio Pagán (3-1) was dealt the loss, allowing a three-run homer to Cavan Biggio in the eighth inning, trying to protect a 6-4 lead...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Royce Lewis, who drove in two runs...Carlos Correa had two hits, both doubles, the 199th and 200th of his career...Donovan Solano went 1-for-2, walked a career-high-tying three times and hit his first home run of the season.

GALLANT RETURN: The Twins have returned outfielder/first baseman Joey Gallo from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Gallo, who has missed the Twins' last nine games with a left hamstring strain, played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 2-for-8 with two home runs, five RBI, two walks and two runs scored...prior to being placed on the IL, Gallo played in 46 games for the Twins, hitting .188 (26-for-138) with five doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 23 RBI, 25 walks, 21 runs scored, a .321 on-base percentage, a .478 slugging percentage and a .799 OPS...to make room for Gallo on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Kyle Garlick to Triple-A St. Paul...Garlick, who was recalled by the Twins on June 3, played in six games during his most recent stint with Minnesota, going 1-for-11 with five strikeouts.

◆ Gallo has posted a 12.55 at-bat-per-home run ratio this season, the fourth-best in the AL (minimum of 150 plate appearances)...he also leads the club with 11 home runs and a .478 slugging percentage.

START ME UP: Twins starters have averaged 5.7 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022... they have also struck out 363 hitters and are on-pace to fan 959 batters, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in the AL:

CC CREEPS: Carlos Correa has hit safely in each of his last four games, going 6-for-16 (.375) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI and two walks in that span...since May 10, he has raised his batting average 32 points, from .185 to .217 in 24 games...below are his first 32 games and last 24 games (since May 10) by comparison:

NATIONAL TREASURES: The Twins have gone 8-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL and 1-2 vs. San Francisco...eight wins already matches their 2022 total...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Braves for three games at Truist Park from June 26-28.

♣ This season the Twins are playing each of the 15 National League teams...Minnesota's remaining 2023 Interleague home schedule includes Target Field visits from the Brewers this week, Diamondbacks (August 4-6), Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September 8-10)...the Twins will also play road games at the Braves (June 26-28), Cardinals (August 1-3), Phillies (August 11-13), Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies (September 29-October 1).

BORDER BATTLE: The Twins are 240-231 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 67-57 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...Twins are 11-8 in their last 19 against the Brewers...Twins are 6-3 at Target Field vs. the Brewers in their last nine.

◆ Willi Castro is hitting .520 (13-for-25) with one double, two triples, five RBI and a 1.239 OPS in eight career games vs. the Brewers.

★ Max Kepler is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with three doubles, one triple, five RBI, three walks and a .923 OPS in his last eight games vs. the Brewers.

★ Christian Vázquez is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with three doubles, two RBI, three walks and a .1.135 OPS in five career games vs. the

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 85 times this season, tied for fourth most in the AL and tied for seventh most in baseball... Twins are 27-19 when they homer at least once in a game, 19-6 when they homer at least twice and 8-1 when homering at least thrice.

➡ The Twins have homered in eight-straight Interleague games, totaling 18 homers in that span.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis has hits in seven of his last eight at-bats, including seven-straight singles from Friday to Sunday... he is now hitting .317 (13-for-41) with nine RBI and an .805 OPS in 10 games for the Twins this season.

◆ Lewis is hitting .353 (6-for-17) against breaking pitches and .500 (3-for-6) against off-speed pitches.

I'LL TAKE OBP FOR 400, ALEX: Alex Kirilloff has reached base safely in 26 of his last 57 plate appearances since May 27, posting an on-base percentage of .456 in that span...since that date, he has 14 hits, 10 walks and two hit-by-pitch...in 32 games for the Twins, he has posted a .413 on-base percentage, which leads the AL among players with a minimum of 115 plate appearances.

THIEVERY CORPORATION: Twins have stolen 34 bases in 40 attempts this season, for a 85.0 success rate, second best in the AL and fourth best in baseball...since May 15, they have successfully stolen a club-record 24 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski)...their previous successful stolen base streak was 21, from September 25, 2006-April 21, 2007 (*Elias*)...the longest streak in baseball this season is Tampa Bay's streak of 35, which was snapped on Sunday afternoon.

BATS ON STRIKE: The Twins have struck out an MLB-most 678 times this season...when they strike out 10 times-or-fewer, they have a record of 23-13, compared to 10-20 when they strike out at least 11 times...they have struck out 536 times vs. right-handed pitching (1,759 at-bats) and 142 times vs. left-handed pitching (467 at-bats).

◆ The Twins have a 29.1 swing and miss percentage this season, the highest in baseball after ranking 11th last season at 25.0%.

2023 PCF HOME RUN CHALLENGE: The Twins organization has made a \$50,000 contribution to the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) in support of the 2023 PCF Home Run Challenge...since 2013 alone, the organization has now donated \$931,000 to fund research and advocacy efforts...fans can join in the fight against prostate cancer and pledge their own donation by visiting www.homerunchallenge.org.

LAST TIME OUT: Went 7.0 innings and allowed only one run but took a no-decision in the Twins' 2-1 defeat against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field on June 7...allowed five hits (1 HR), issued one walk and struck out six batters...pitched opposite Shawn Armstrong who fired 2.0 scoreless innings as an opener...allowed a solo home run to third baseman Isaac Paredes to lead off the second inning, then retired 17 of the final 21 batters he faced from the second through the seventh inning...was relieved by Brock Stewart to begin the eighth inning with Minnesota trailing 1-0; Twins tied the game on an RBI single from third baseman Royce Lewis in the top of the ninth inning, but Jhoan Duran allowed a walkoff solo home run to designated hitter Randy Arozarena in the bottom of the ninth.

**Marked just the fourth time in his career that his team lost when he worked at least 7.0 innings and allowed one-or-fewer runs (9-4 team record in 13 career starts under those parameters).

**Picked off shortstop Wander Franco in the third inning; was his third pickoff of the season (2 at Miami on April 5), tied with KC's Taylor Clarke for the most in the American League this year.

**Through 13 starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (92 - 1-3rd), innings pitched (78.1 - 10th), pitches-per-inning (15.4 - 14th) and FIP (3.75 - 15th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins' 7-6 win over the Cleveland Guardians on June 1 at Target Field...opposed rookie Tanner Bibee, who also took a no-decision...pitched 5.2 innings, allowing a season-high-tying six runs and eight hits, with one walk and five strikeouts... retired the side in order in the first inning for the first time since Opening Day on March 30 at Kansas City...allowed one run in the second inning on an RBI single from rightfielder Will Brennan...allowed five runs on six singles and one walk in the top of the sixth inning...was relieved by Emilio Pagán with two outs in the sixth and Minnesota trailing 6-3...Twins overcame the three-run deficit and won on a walk-off sacrifice fly from leftfielder Willi Castro in the ninth inning.

4 His five runs allowed in the top of the sixth inning marked the most runs he has allowed in an inning since he allowed seven runs in the top of the fourth inning on September 10, 2022 vs. New York-NL.

4 His 76.1 strike percentage vs. Cleveland was the second-highest strike percentage of his career, trailing only his 78.3 strike percentage (83 pitches, 65 strikes) on July 11, 2021 vs. Atlanta.

LÓPEZ VS. MILWAUKEE: Facing the Brewers for the sixth time in his career tonight...in five previous starts vs. Milwaukee, all with Miami, he went 1-1, 3.19 ERA (31.0 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 33 strikeouts; Marlins went 2-3 in those starts...went 0-0, 0.64 ERA (14.0 IP, 1 ER) with three walks and 18 strikeouts in two starts against the Brewers last season; set his career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 innings vs. Milwaukee on May 13, 2022 and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings at American Family Field on October 2, 2022...looking for his first win against the Brewers since June 4, 2019; pitched 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts in a 16-0 Marlins win in Milwaukee.

© López has limited the 11 current Brewers hitters who have faced him previously to a .163 (7-for-43) batting average with 20 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: Making his seventh home start of 2023 to begin the Twins' 10-game homestand... has gone 2-1 with a 6.11 ERA (35.1 IP, 24 ER), 12 walks and 42 strikeouts in his first six home outings...despite López having the third-highest home ERA among qualified pitchers in the American League, the Twins have gone 5-1 in his six home starts as the offense has provided him with an average of 6.11 runs of support at Target Field, the 12th-highest run support average at home in the AL (min. 5 home GS)...in seven road starts this year, he is 1-2 with a 2.72 ERA (43.0 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks and 50 strikeouts; Minnesota owns a 2-5 record in his seven starts away from Target Field in 2023, with López receiving only 1.67 runs of support on average.

© In 56 career home starts, he is 16-16, 3.75 ERA (319.1 IP, 133 ER) with 91 walks and 310 strikeouts...is 15-18, 4.25 ERA (269.0 IP, 127 ER) with 73 walks and 271 strikeouts in 51 career road starts.
