THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 2-4 (0-3 at Tampa Bay and 2-1 at Toronto), the Twins began their 10-game homestand with a win over the Brewers last night...this afternoon, they will play the second of two against Milwaukee...tomorrow night, the Twins will continue the homestand with the first of four against the Tigers through Sunday, before hosting the Red Sox for four games from June 19-22...the Twins have gone 19-14 at home and 15-19 on the road.

SAY CHEESE, IT'S C4 TIME: The Twins beat the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score of 7-5...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts — one short of his season high...the offense recorded 12 hits, led by Edouard Julien, who went 2-for-4 with a walk...Carlos Correa went 1-for-5 and drove in three runs, including a walk-off two-run homer off Devin Williams with nobody out in the bottom of the ninth, capping a four-run inning...it marked Correa's 10th career regular season walk-off plate appearance, ninth career walk-off hit and first home run.

CHECK YOUR WATCH, C4 ABOUT TO IGNITE: Carlos Correa hit a go-ahead grand slam on Saturday at Toronto and a walk-off home run last night against Milwaukee...he has hit safely in each of his last five games, going 7-for-21 (.333) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and two walks in that span...since May 10, he has raised his batting average 32 points, from .185 to .217 in 25 games...below are his first 32 games and last 25 games (since May 10) by comparison:

GOING FOR A SWEEP AND SERIES W AT ONE TIME: The Twins are seeking their 10th series victory this season...they are 9-10-2 in series play this season, going 6-3-1 at home and 3-7-1 on the road...their last series win over the Brewers came August 27-29, 2021, taking two of three at Target Field.

A win today would give the Twins their second sweep of the season, the other being a sweep of the Royals to open the season from March 30-April 2...they are seeking their first sweep of the Brewers since taking two games at American Family Field from August 9-10, 2017.

NATIONAL TREASURES: The Twins have gone 9-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco and 1-0 vs. Milwaukee...nine wins already passes their 2022 total of eight...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Braves for three games at Truist Park from June 26-28.

BEERFEST: The Twins are 241-231 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 68-57 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...Twins are 12-8 in their last 20 against the Brewers...Twins are 7-3 at Target Field vs. the Brewers in their last 10. Willi Castro is hitting .520 (13-for-25) with one double, two triples, five RBI and a 1.239 OPS in nine career games vs. the Brewers.

Max Kepler is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with three doubles, one triple, five RBI, four walks and a .941 OPS in his last nine games vs. the Brewers.

Christian Vázquez is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with three doubles, two RBI, three walks and a 1.135 OPS in six career games vs. the Brew Crew.

FOR THE RECORD: The Twins are 11-15 in their last 26 games since May 15 after starting 23-18 through games of May 14...below are their records when scoring a certain amount of runs:

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 88 times this season, fourth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball...Twins are 28-19 when they homer at least once in a game, 20-6 when they homer at least twice and 9-1 when homering at least thrice.

The Twins have homered in nine-straight Interleague games, totaling 21 homers in that span...it marks the fourth longest IL homer streak in club history.

ROYCE OF SUMMER: Royce Lewis has hits in eight of his last 11 at-bats, including seven-straight singles from Friday to Sunday...he is now hitting .318 (14-for-44) with nine RBI and a .795 OPS in 11 games for the Twins this season.

Lewis is hitting .316 (6-for-19) against breaking pitches and .500 (3-for-6) against off-speed pitches.

RUN THE JULS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on Saturday, Edouard Julien is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with three doubles, three walks, a .571 on-base percentage and a 1.299 OPS in three games...in his last 10 major league games (which dates back to May 24), he is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with five doubles, two home runs, four RBI, eight walks, a .435 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.056 OPS.

MICHAEL A. TATER: Michael A. Taylor has homered three times in his last five games...he hit his 10th home run last night, tied with Byron Buxton for second most on the club this season, trailing Joey Gallo (11)...Taylor is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with three doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, nine runs scored, two walks, five stolen bases, a .359 on-base percentage, a .750 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in his last 12 games.

THIEVERY CORPORATION: Twins have stolen 35 bases in 41 attempts this season, for a 85.4 success rate, second best in the AL and third best in baseball...since May 15, they have successfully stolen a club-record 25 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski)...their previous successful stolen base streak was 21, from September 25, 2006-April 21, 2007 (Elias)...the longest streak in baseball this season is Tampa Bay's streak of 35, which was snapped on Sunday afternoon.

MIC DROPS: Milwaukee related info on Bally Sports North analysts Justin Morneau and Trevor Plouffe: Morneau hit his second career home run against the Brewers on June 22, 2003 at Miller Park, a solo shot that hit the top of the scoreboard...Morneau hit .322 (73-for-227) with 17 doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 48 RBI and a .904 OPS in 61 career games vs. the Brewers...he had six three-hit games against the Brewers in his career.

One of Trevor Plouffe's three multi-homer games came against the Brewers on June 15, 2012 at Target Field, both solo shots off Yovani Gallardo...that same season, Plouffe hit nine home runs in Interleague Play, tied with Mitch Garver (2019) for most in Twins history for a single season.

2023 PCF HOME RUN CHALLENGE: The Twins organization has made a \$50,000 contribution to the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) in support of the 2023 PCF Home Run Challenge...since 2013 alone, the organization has now donated \$931,000 to fund research and advocacy efforts...fans can join in the fight against prostate cancer and pledge their own donation by visiting www.homerunchallenge.org.

- ☞ Facing the Brewers for the first time in his career...is 2-1, 4.06 ERA (31.0 IP, 14 ER) with 10 walks and 26 strikeouts when facing an opponent for the first time.
- ☞ Began season with Triple-A St. Paul and was recalled when Kenta Maeda landed on the IL on April 29...since being inserted into the rotation, the Twins have gone 5-4 in his nine starts.
- ☞ Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST START: Took his third loss of the season in a 4-2 Twins defeat against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field on June 8, opposite Yonny Chirinos...pitched 5.1 innings and allowed four runs (3 earned) on three hits, issued two walks and tied a season high with seven strikeouts...tossed 3.0 perfect innings before issuing a walk in the fourth inning to outfielder Randy Arozarena who scored on an RBI triple by first baseman Luke Raley...also yielded a two-run home run to designated hitter Harold Ramirez...relieved in the sixth inning by Griffin Jax after allowing a single and a walk...shortstop Wander Franco crossed home on a throwing error by Jax after stealing third base...José De León closed the game by pitching 2.0 scoreless innings as the Twins were swept in three games.

- ☞ Brought his career strikeout total to 194...owns the fourth-most strikeouts through a pitcher's first 40 games in Twins history, trailing Joe Ryan (238), Bert Blyleven (220) and Francisco Liriano (199).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start, in a 1-0 Twins victory against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field on June 2...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed four hits, no walks and three strikeouts, opposite Aaron Civale...pitched 3.2 hitless innings until first baseman Josh Naylor singled in the fourth inning...marked his second-lowest single-game strikeout total this season (2 K vs. San Francisco on May 22)...joined Detroit's Eduardo Rodríguez as the only pitchers to record two starts against Cleveland this year with 6.0-or-more scoreless innings...relieved by Jovani Moran in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins scored their lone run on a Jorge Polanco RBI double in the seventh inning...marked the fourth shutout victory for the Twins this season (also, back-to-back shutouts on March 30 and April 1 at Kansas City, and May 5 at Cleveland).

OBER VS. MILWAUKEE: Facing the Brewers for the first time in his career...making his fifth Inter-league start this season...is 2-1, 3.57 ERA (22.2 IP, 9 ER) with seven walks and 18 strikeouts in his four previous starts...Milwaukee will be the 17th team he has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021...in 16 career starts when facing a new opponent for the first time, Ober is 2-4, 4.21 ERA (77.0 IP, 36 ER) with 20 walks and 75 strikeouts...has only faced designated hitter Jesse Winker and infielder Owen Miller previously.

BACK HOME: Ober is making his seventh home start this season, 22nd of his career...in his six previous home starts this season, Ober is 1-2, 2.97 ERA (33.2 IP, 11 ER) with nine walks and 28 strikeouts...is 5-3, 3.59 ERA (105.1 IP, 42 ER) with 26 walks and 105 strikeouts in 21 career home starts...Twins have gone 13-8 in his road starts.

- ☞ Owns the fourth-most strikeouts through a pitcher's first 21 home games in Twins history, trailing Joe Ryan (132), José Berríos (114) and Francisco Liriano (112).

EQUAL OPPORTUNIST: Left-handed hitters are batting .196 (20-for-102) with 23 strikeouts and nine walks against Ober after nine starts this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .205 (17-for-83) with 24 strikeouts and four walks...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .254/.317/.416 with 81 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .219/.243/.409 with 112 strikeouts off him.

- ☞ Owns the seventh-lowest batting average against lefties in the American League (min. 50.0 IP)...14th in all of baseball.
- ☞ Tied for the ninth-lowest opponent batting average against righties in the American league...tied for 13th in all of baseball (min 50.0 IP).
- ☞ Tied for the 19th-lowest opponent batting average against righties in the American League since 2021 (min 200.0 IP).

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his nine starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...five out of the seven strikeouts he recorded in his last start came from fastballs, the other two off changeups...also allowed his fourth home run of the year on a slider...mostly uses his slider (147 pitches) against righties while relying on his changeup (149 pitches) and curveball (53 pitches) against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

☞ Owns the fifth-lowest opponent batting average against a curveball in the American League (min. 750 pitches)...also tied with Wandy Peralta for the ninth-lowest opponent batting average against a changeup (min. 50 PA).

CHASE U: According to Baseball Savant, Ober owns a 33.7 chase percentage this season, ranking in the 91st percentile in baseball...ranks third on the Twin's pitching staff, trailing Joe Ryan (36.5) and Pablo López (34.9).

DAYGLOW: Ober is making his second-consecutive day start today, his sixth of the season; previous was getaway day at Tampa Bay on June 8...is 1-2, 3.25 ERA (27.2 IP, 10 ER) with eight walks and 30 strikeouts in his five previous day starts this season...is 3-4, 3.86 ERA (84.0 IP, 36 ER) with 22 walks and 78 strikeouts in 17 career day starts...looking for his first win in a day game since his first start of the season on April 23 vs. Washington (5.2 IP, 3 H, 1R/ER, 3 BB, 4 K).

CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
