RUN THE JULS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on Saturday, Edouard Julien is hitting .429 (6-for-14) with four doubles, four walks, a .556 on-base percentage and a 1.270 OPS in four games...

SOLANO SMOKING: Donovan Solano has reached safely in each of his last five games, hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, five walks, a .545 on-base percentage and a 1.251 OPS in that span...

- Owns the lowest FIP (2.39) among all qualified American League pitchers...also ranks third in ERA (2.25) and fourth in WAR (2.7).
Making his 261st career appearance and 252nd career start...also his 14th start/appearance this season.
Facing Detroit for the first time this season and ninth in his career (including seven starts); is 4-1, 2.47 ERA (43.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 45 strikeouts in his eight previous appearances...currently owns a three-game win streak against the Tigers, dating back to July 24, 2020.
Making his eighth start at home this season; is 7-3, 2.30 ERA (109.2 IP, 28 ER) with 34 walks and 128 strikeouts in 20 home games since joining the Twins.
Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 9 at Toronto, opposite Yusei Kikuchi...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed one run on five hits, with two walks and five strikeouts in the 10-inning 3-2 Twins victory...tossed only 76 pitches, marked a season low...retired nine of the first 11 batters he faced...yielded his only run in the fifth inning via an RBI single to shortstop Bo Bichette...relieved in the sixth inning by Jovani Moran who was replaced by Brock Stewart after allowing a single to Santiago Espinal...Stewart allowed an RBI double to outfielder George Springer to tie the game...Griffin Jax (1.0 IP) and Jhoan Duran (2.0 IP) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings to close the game...the Twins took the lead in the 10th inning with a sacrifice fly by Michael A. Taylor.

Marked his 13th consecutive game of allowing three-or-fewer earned runs...tied the longest streak of his career (also, August 4, 2019-August 3, 2020 and August 7, 2018-April 17, 2019).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his first loss of the season on June 3 vs. Cleveland and was handed his first decision since April 30 vs. Kansas City...pitched 6.2 innings and allowed three runs on 10 hits, with no walks and two strikeouts...outfielder Will Brennan drove in all three runs against Gray, on an RBI fielder's choice in the second inning and a two-run home run in the seventh...marked his first home run allowed this season and snapped the longest homerless start streak in Twins' history (since 1961, 11 starts)...marked the fourth time in his career allowing 10-or-more hits (10 on August 6, 2014 vs. Tampa Bay, 11 on April 17, 2015 at Kansas City and 11 on May 3, 2016 vs. Seattle)...relieved by Jovani Moran in the seventh inning after Gray allowed two consecutive single to Steven Kwan and Tyler Freeman; Moran pitched 1.0 scoreless inning...Jorge Lopez entered in the eighth inning and allowed a home run to Steven Kwan in the ninth.

Marked the first time a Twin allowed 10-or-more hits and three-or-fewer earned runs since Jose Berrios on July 1, 2021 at Chicago-AL.

AGAINST DETROIT: Gray is facing the Tigers for the ninth time in his career, going 4-1, 2.47 ERA (43.2 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 45 strikeouts in his eight previous appearances (7 starts)...last faced Detroit on July 24, 2022 at Comerica Park, earned the 9-1 Twins win after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing one run on two hits, issuing one walk and striking out seven...faced the minimum through the first three innings...allowed his lone blemish on an RBI single to leftfielder Eric Haase in the fourth inning...relieved by Griffin Jax in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings.

Currently owns a three-game win streak against the Tigers, dating back to July 24, 2020; is 3-0, 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks and 26 strikeouts in the three-game span...has not taken a loss against the Tigers since April 27, 2016 as a member of the Oakland Athletics.
Owns the second-lowest ERA against the Tigers since 2020 (min. 15.0 IP), trailing Triston McKenzie (0.93)...also tied for the least earned runs allowed, alongside Emmanuel Clase and Cristian Javier.

BULLSEYE: Gray is making his eighth home start of the season tonight; is 3-1, 1.71 ERA (42.0 IP, 8 ER) with nine walks and 50 strikeouts in his seven prior home outings...is 53-39, 3.73 ERA (770.1 IP, 319 ER) with 256 walks and 751 strikeouts in 136 career home appearances, including 132 starts.

Is 7-3, 2.30 ERA (109.2 IP, 28 ER) with 34 walks and 128 strikeouts in 20 home starts since becoming a Twin...has the most strikeouts and lowest ERA through a pitcher's first 20 home games in Twins' history (since 1961, min. 100.0 IP).

Currently holds the fifth-lowest home ERA in baseball this season (min. 40.0 IP), trailing Arizona's Zac Gallen (0.96) and Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (1.64).

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...uses his curveball and fastball the most at 20.9 percent and 20.7 percent respectively...only tossed 10 curveballs in his last start on June 9...primarily uses his curveball (161 pitches) and changeup (77 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (164 pitches), sinker (195 pitches) and sweeper (168 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

Owns the 18th-lowest opponent batting average (min. 30 PA) against a cutter and ranks 12th against a sweeper...also owns the ninth-lowest opponent batting average against a changeup (min. 1000 pitches).
His 30 strikeouts on his sweeper are the thirdmost in the majors, behind Shohei Ohtani (51) and Justin Lawrence (34).

YOU SPIN ME ROUND: Currently, Gray's fastball has a 2524 spin rate, placing him in the 96th percentile in all of baseball, according to Baseball Savant...marks the third-highest fastball spin rate of his career (2540 in 2022 and 2526 in 2019)...has the highest fastball spin rate on the Twins staff and the second highest curveball spin (2685), trailing Jhoan Duran (2698).

TIMER VIOLATIONS: In Statcast's new pitch timer violation leaderboard, Gray is tied for the third-most violations this season at five, alongside CWS's Lucas Giolito and MIA's Braxton Garrett; all violations for Gray have been pitcher violations...averages 237 pitches-per-violation.

The Twins are tied with seven other teams for the eighth-most violations this season: 13 against pitchers, seven against batters and two catcher violations.

Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
Named to Baseball America's 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Baseball America Triple-A All-Star.
Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

THIS IS THE (RIGHT) WAY: Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to left-handed hitters this season...Gray has held righties to a .208 (32-for-154) batting average with 55 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are batting .271 (32-for-118) with 21 strikeouts...since becoming a Twin, lefties are slashing .227/.272/.336 against him while righties are batting .230/.311/.337.

Owns the 14th-lowest opponent batting average against righties among qualified American League pitchers...is tied for the 10th-most strikeouts against righties in the AL and is tied for 18th most in all of baseball.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2023 SEASON: 7-3, 2.90 ERA // CAREER: 22-12, 3.40 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to start in the second game of the four-game series against the Detroit Tigers at Target Field tomorrow night...did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 10 against Toronto, a 9-4 Twins victory at Rogers Centre...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits, with one walk and four strikeouts...facing Detroit for the sixth time in his career, is 4-0, 2.54 ERA (28.1 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 38 strikeouts in his five previous appearances...currently owns a four-game win streak, dating back to April 27, 2022; has a 0.76 ERA (23.3 IP, 2 ER) with three walks and 33 strikeouts in that span...last faced Detroit on September 30, 2022 at Comerica Park (6.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R/ER, 1 BB, 8 K).
