THE TWINS: Began their 10-game homestand with a two-game series sweep over the Brewers with wins on Tuesday night and Wednesday afternoon...tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of four games against the Tigers through the weekend...after this series, the Twins will welcome the Red Sox to Target Field for four games from Monday-Thursday... the Twins have gone 20-14 at home and 15-19 on the road.

4 The Twins are on game three of a 16 games in 16 days stretch, their next off-day being in Baltimore two weeks from today on June 29...the Twins have 23 games in 25 days leading up to the All-Star Break (July 10-13).

**BREWS GET THE BROOMS:** The Twins beat the Brewers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-2, sweeping Milwaukee, their second sweep this season and first over the Brewers since 2017 (also 2 games)...Bailey Ober (4-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and seven strikeouts...Brock Stewart (1.0 IP) and Jhoan Duran (1.0 IP) each earned a hold while Griffin Jax pitched a scoreless ninth inning to record his second career save...the offense recorded just five hits, but walked seven times and only struck out seven times...Carlos Correa highlighted the offense, going 1-for-3 with a two-run triple in the third inning.

**WELCOME BACK BUCK:** The Twins have reinstated outfielder Byron Buxton from the 10-day Injured List... Buxton has missed the Twins' last 10 games after being placed on the Injured List on June 6 with a left rib contusion...he sustained the injury after being hit by a pitch by Cleveland's Tanner Bibee on June 1 at Target Field...in 50 games for the Twins this season, Buxton has hit. 220 (40-for-182) with nine doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 23 RBI, 26 walks and 31 runs scored...to make room for Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned outfielder Trevor Larnach to Triple-A St. Paul...Larnach went 4-for-22 with one double, one home run, four RBI, three runs scored and three walks in eight games during his most recent stint with the Twins from June 6-14.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the first of 13 meetings in 2023...Twins went 11-8 against Detroit last season, going 7-2 at Target Field and 4-6 at Comerica Park.

◆ Seven of the Twins next 11 games will be against Detroit as they will travel to Michigan for a three-game series next weekend to kick-off a nine-game roadtrip.

◆ Twins pitchers struck out 171 Tigers last season, their most vs. any opponent in 2022...also the second-most they ve ever recorded in a season vs. Detroit (191 in 2019).

◆ Twins pitchers posted a 2.69 ERA (167.0 IP, 50 ER) against Detroit last season with Tiger batters hitting .206 (127-for-616) with a .574 OPS.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with four doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and a .969 OPS in his last 12 games vs. the Tigers.

◆ Michael A. Taylor is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with a .931 OPS in his last 11 games vs. Detroit.

CHECK YOUR WATCH, C4 ABOUT TO IGNITE: Carlos Correa hit a go-ahead grand slam on Saturday at Toronto, a walk-off home run Tuesday night against Milwaukee and the game-tying triple yesterday afternoon vs. Milwaukee...he has hit safely in each of his last six games, hitting .333 (8-for-24) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .407 on-base percentage, an .875 slugging percentage and a 1.282 OPS in that span...since May 10, he has raised his batting average 33 points, from .185 to .218 in 26 games...below are his first 32 games and last 26 games (since May 10) by comparison:

**FOR THE RECORD:** The Twins are 12-15 in their last 27 games since May 15 after starting 23-18 through games of May 14...below are their records when scoring a certain amount of runs: 1+ 2+ 3+ 4+ 5+ 6+ 7+

PITCHING-IN IN 2023: Twins starters have averaged 5.7 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022...they have pitched 6.0-plus innings 39 times this season, which matches their total from last season...by June 15, 2022, they had reached 6.0-plus just 16 times.

◆ Additionally, they have struck out 407 hitters and are on-pace to fan 969 batters, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967.

THE LEFTORIUM: Tonight marks the 13th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter...Twins are 6-6 when a left-hander is the opposing starter...the last lefty starter to face the Twins was Yusei Kikuchi on June 9 at Toronto as the Twins won 3-2 in 10 innings.

◆ The Twins have the fourth-fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at just 472...also the second-fewest hits with 105.

◆ Twins are slashing .222/.299/.377 with 16 homers vs. lefties, compared to .235/.317/.410 with 72 homers vs. righties.

RUN THE JULS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on Saturday, Edouard Julien is hitting .429 (6-for-14) with four doubles, four walks, a .556 on-base percentage and a 1.270 DPS in four games...in his last 11 major league games (which dates back to May 24), he is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with six doubles, two home runs, four RBI, nine walks, a .440 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.065 DPS.

◆Julien has recorded at least one double and one walk in each of his last four games, tying Joe Mauer (May 5-8, 2013) for the longest such streak in Twins history (since 1961)...also became the first Canadian-born Twins hitter with an extra-base hit in four-straight games since Justin Morneau from June 27-30, 2013.

**SOLANO SMOKING:** Donovan Solano has reached safely in each of his last five games, hitting .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, five walks, a .545 on-base percentage and a 1.251 OPS in that span. **◆** He is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with eight doubles and an .829 OPS against lefties this season.

**T-PAIN, T-NIGHT:** GRAMMY Award-winning international music icon T-Pain will perform a postgame concert following tonight's game... the concert will begin approximately 15 minutes after the conclusion of the night's game and feature a full, 75-minute set.

**ICYMI:** The Twins acquired Milwaukee minor league right-handed pitcher Taylor Floyd as the player to be named later, to complete the Trevor Megill trade from April 30...Floyd has pitched in 15 games for High-A Wisconsin this season, going 1-2, 3.04 ERA (23.2 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 32 strikeouts and a 0.97 WHIP.

**HAPPY PLOUFFE DAY:** Trevor Plouffe is celebrating his 37th birthday today...Plouffe is one of two players in Twins history (1961-present) with a multi-homer game on his birthday, the other being Justin Morneau (who did it twice, in 2007 & 2009).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his first loss of the season on June 3 vs. Cleveland and was handed his first decision since April 30 vs. Kansas City...pitched 6.2 innings and allowed three runs on 10 hits, with no walks and two strikeouts...outfielder Will Brennan drove in all three runs against Gray, on an RBI fielder's choice in the second inning and a two-run home run in the seventh...marked his first home run allowed this season and snapped the longest homerless start streak in Twins' history (since 1961, 11 starts)...marked the fourth time in his career allowing 10-or-more hits (10 on August 6, 2014 vs. Tampa Bay, 11 on April 17, 2015 at Kansas City and 11 on May 3, 2016 vs. Seattle)...relieved by Jovani Moran in the seventh inning after Gray allowed two consecutive single to Steven Kwan and Tyler Freeman; Moran pitched 1.0 scoreless inning...Jorge López entered in the eighth inning and allowed a home run to Steven Kwan in the ninth.

AGAINST DETROIT: Gray is facing the Tigers for the ninth time in his career, going 4-1, 2.47 ERA (43.2 IP 12 ER) with 12 walks and 45 strikeouts in his eight previous appearances (7 starts)...last faced Detroit on July 24, 2022 at Comerica Park, earned the 9-1 Twins win after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing one run on two hits, issuing one walk and striking out seven...faced the minimum through the first three innings...allowed his lone blemish on an RBI single to leftfield by Eric Haase in the fourth inning... relieved by Griffin Jax in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings. 
♣ Currently owns a three-game win streak against the Tigers, dating back to July 24, 2020; is 3-0, 0.95 ERA (19.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks and 26 strikeouts in the three-game span...has not taken a lost against the Tigers since April 27, 2016 as a member of the Oakland Athletics. 
♣ Owns the second-lowest ERA against the Tigers since 2020 (min. 15.0 IP), trailing Triston McKenzie (0.93)...also tied for the least earned runs allowed, alongside Emmanuel Clase and Cristian layier.

BULLSEYE: Gray is making his eighth home start of the season tonight; is 3-1, 1.71 ERA (42.0 IP, 8 ER) with nine walks and 50 strikeouts in his seven prior home outings...is 53-39, 3.73 ERA (770.1 IP, 319 ER) with 256 walks and 751 strikeouts in 136 career home appearances, including 132 starts.

© Is 7-3, 2.30 ERA (109.2 IP, 28 ER) with 34 walks and 128 strikeouts in 20 home starts since becoming a Twin...has the most strikeouts and lowest ERA through a pitcher's first 20 home games in Twins' history (since 1961, min. 100.0 IP)

© Currently holds the fifth-lowest home ERA in baseball this season (min. 40.0 IP), trailing Arizona's Zac Gallen (0.96) and Tampa Bay's Shane McClanahan (1.64).

**THE ARSENAL:** Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...uses his curveball and fastball the most at 20.9 percent and 20.7 percent respectively...only tossed 10 curveballs in his last start on June 9...primarily uses his curveball (161 pitches) and changeup (77 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (164 pitches), sinker (195 pitches) and sweeper (168 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his reperfoire so far:
